AFFIRMING ORDINANCE NO. 32 DATED MARCH 17, 2026 OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF CARMEN, THIS PROVINCE ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE ESTABLISHMENT AND OPERATION OF PRIVATE TALIPAPA OR MINI-MARKETS WITHIN THE MUNICIPALITY OF CARMEN, PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES", IT BEING WITHIN THE SCOPE OF THE PRESCRIBED POWERS OF THE SANGGUNANG BAYAN CONCERNED TO ENACT SUCH ORDINANCE PURSUANT TO THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE OF 1991

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 32 dated March 17, 2026 of the Municipality of Carmen, this Province entitled "An Ordinance Regulating the Establishment and Operation of Private Talipapa or Mini-Markets Within the Municipality of Carmen, Providing Penalties for Violation Thereof, and for Other Purposes", was submitted to this Body for review and same was referred to the Committee on Trade, Industry, Investment and SMEs/Local Economic Enterprises and Utilities, for appropriate action and technical review;

WHEREAS, after a careful review by the Committee to which the matter was referred to, it was found out that it is within the ambit of the provisions of the Local Government Code of 1991;
