Thank you very much, Majority Floor Leader. We received a letter dated February 23, 2026, from the Brightgreen Resources Corporation. The subject matters are additional documents. This is a submission of additional documents with respect to the Public Consultation held last February 2, 2026 and in aid of legislation. With this, I would like to respectfully pass a Resolution that this letter and the attachment herewith should form part of the Public Hearing Consultation that we had last February 2, 2026 and this will be part of the Unassigned Business/Privilege Business for today's session. Thank you very much, Mr. Presiding Officer. Next are, if I may continue?

If we can remember, Honorable Presiding Officer, that in one of our sessions, we agreed, that any amendment to the existing House Rules of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan may be through the passage of a Resolution. For today's session and part of the Unassigned Business/Privilege Business, I would like to pass a Resolution with the permission of the Majority Floor Leader and the Members of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan, a Resolution that will amend Section 13 of the House Rules of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan, which now allows a Chairman of a certain Committee who is on Official Business or Official Travel, be the author sponsored despite in his absence during the Second and Third Reading of the legislative measure.

Republic of the Philippines, Province of Surigao del Sur, Tandag City, Provincial Governor's Office. The Honorable Members, Office of the Provincial Council, this Province through Hon. Manuel O. Alameda, Sr., Vice Governor and Presiding Officer.

Sir, greetings! May we request for an urgent passage of a Sangguniang Panlalawigan Resolution authorizing the Provincial Governor to enter into and sign a Deed of Donation with the Office of the President, duly represented by its Senior Executive Secretary, Maria Luwalhati C. Dorotan Tiuseco, for the Special Financial Assistance (SFA) grant in the amount of Fifteen Million Pesos (P15,000,000.00), intended for the victims of Tropical Storm "Basyang" and enhanced rainfall brought about by the Shear line, charged against the Socio-Civic Projects Funds (SCPF). Office of the President Malacanang, Manila, 12 February 2026. Governor Johnny T. Pimentel, Provincial Government of Surigao del Sur. Dear Governor Pimentel, this is a reference to the Special Financial Assistance (SFA) grant to the Provincial Government of Surigao del Sur in the amount of Fifteen Million Pesos (P15,000,000.00), intended for individuals, communities, or group beneficiaries that were severely affected by the combined effects of Tropical Storm "Basyang" and enhanced rainfall brought about by the shear line charged against the Socio-Civic Projects Fund (SCPF).

In relation thereto, the Execution of the Deed of Donation (DOD) between the Office of the President (OP) and your Local Government Unit (LGU) is required. Please accomplish and submit the following documents:

1. Four (4) Original copies of the Deed of Donation duly signed by the LGU Chief and witness, with corresponding notarized acknowledgement for the LGU;
2. Original or Certified True Copy of Sangguniang Panlalawigan Resolution authorizing the LGU Chief to accept the donation.

Kindly submit the aforementioned documents on or before 06 March 2026 addressed to this Office. Office of the Deputy Executive Secretary for Finance and Administration Room 247, Mabini Hall, Jose P. Laurel Street, Malacañang Compound, San Miguel, Manila for your guidance and strict compliance. Very truly yours, signed, Joseph Irvin A. Addressed to All Provincial Governors, HUC/ICC/CC/Municipal Mayors, DILG Regional Directors and All Others Concerned. Subject: Reiteration of DILG Memorandum Circular No. 2018-128 dated August 14, 2018 Titled: "Reactivation of Local Price Coordinating Councils". dated May 6, 2025 National Price Coordinating Council Resolution No. 0,1 Series of 2025 entitled "A Resolution Recommending Measures to Address the Price and Supply Situation of Rice", dated January 14, 2025 recommended the declaration of a food security emergency regarding rice due to the significant increase in rice prices. The Resolution further called for the activation of Local Price Coordinating Councils (LPCCs) to support the Department of Agriculture's "Bantay Presyo Program" in monitoring rice prices and coordinating efforts among member agencies to stabilize both rice prices and supply in Local Government Units nationwide.

In this regard, all Local Chief Executives are highly encouraged to immediately reactivate their respective Local Price Coordinating Councils (LPCCs) pursuant to the provisions of DILG Memorandum Circular No. 2018-128 dated August 14, 2018 titled "Reactivation of Local Price Coordinating Councils" and Joint Memorandum Circular No. 03, Series of 2020, titled "Strengthening the Role of Local Price Coordinating Councils and LGUs in Managing Unreasonable and Excessive Price Increases of Basic Necessities and Prime Commodities".

All DILG Regional Directors and others concerned are hereby directed to ensure the immediate and widest dissemination of this Memorandum Circular within the respective areas of jurisdiction. Further, all the DILG Offices at the Provincial, City and Municipal Levels are directed to facilitate the updating of the list of reactivated Local Price Coordinating Councils (LPCCs), as well as, the status of the adoption of measures to address hoarding and exorbitant, excessive and unreasonable price increases of essential and prime commodities. The required information shall be submitted via the following Google Drive link: <https://tinyurl.com/CY2025LPCCs> on or before June 30, 2025.

Your Honor, the date of the Memorandum Circular was May 6, 2025 few days before the election if I'm not mistaken of last year's election of May 11 Election. So, the Memorandum Circular was issued before the assumption of the new Local Government Administrations like if there are new Mayors, new Governors, and so with the situation right now that there are vast complaints about the sudden spike of prices of rice an important commodity, your honor. I am no longer intending to request for a Sangguniang Panlalawigan investigation on this matter because we can only do so in aid of legislation. But there are already enough legislations, Honorable Presiding Officer, as a matter of fact, based on my research I was able to come up with this DILG Memorandum Circular 2025-044.

So with that, I intend to humbly sponsor a Resolution in Unassigned Business/Privilege Business in today's session requesting our Provincial Governor Johnny T. Pimentel to reactivate if not yet activated to activate the Provincial Price Coordinating Council so that the said Council can monitor the complaints of rising prices of basic commodities especially the price of rice, Honorable Presiding Officer. The said Resolution will be furnished also to the Regional Director of the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG) thru the Provincial Director so that they can also facilitate the activation of Provincial Price Coordinating Council, Honorable Presiding Officer. So, with that, this humble representation is done in the Privilege Hour and the two (2) items be approved in Unassigned Business/Privilege Business in today's session. Thank you very much, Honorable Presiding Officer. Thank you very much, my dear and esteemed colleagues. Once again, good morning.

Thank you, Honorable Presiding Officer. Before I would deliver my Privilege Speech, as I've mentioned earlier, there will be no insertion, however, I would allow an addendum which means that the Honorable Jose Dumagan, Jr. wants to come up with another matter for a Privilege. So, may I ask that he will be recognized to deliver that addendum before this representation will have his piece. Thank you, Honorable Presiding Officer.

HON. PRESIDING OFFICER ALAMEDA, SR.:

Okay, the Honorable Board Member, Atty. Jun-Jun.

HON. DUMAGAN, JR.:

Thank you very much, Atty. Azarcon, the Majority Floor Leader for yielding again the floor to me. Yesterday, we had a visitor, the representatives coming from the Hog Industry of Tandag City and the other neighboring Municipalities of Surigao del Sur. The Hog Raisers raised a point and an alarming situation, Your Honor, considering that a few weeks ago, a month ago, the prevailing price for live pig is P210.00 per kilo. Just recently, because of the introduction of imported meat, the buying price for live hog is P165.00 per kilo yes, price drop. It may be good for the importers of this frozen meat, but it is detrimental to the Hog Industry, not only of Tandag City, not only of Surigao del Sur but I think this is detrimental to the Hog Industry of the whole nation. With this, and after such conversation, I would like to pass a Resolution directing the Committees on Agriculture/Fisheries and Trade, Industry, Investment and SMEs/Local Economic Enterprises and Utilities to conduct a necessary investigation, a necessary study for the possible passage of an Ordinance that will stabilize the price of live hog in the Province of Surigao del Sur. With this, I respectfully pass this in the Unassigned Business/Privilege Business in today's session.

Okay. Thank you for that, again, Board Member, Atty. Jun-Jun.

Now, the Honorable Board Member, Atty. Tony Boy.

HON. AZARCON:

Thank you. Finally. Honorable Presiding Officer and Members of this August Body. I rise in Privilege for a very urgent matter, which I believe has to go on a fast track considering that a delay would cause an economic downfall of a certain LGU, I'm referring to the Annual Investment Program or Plan of the Municipality of Lianga. It could be recalled that sometime in December they submitted their Annual Investment Plan for 2026 to this August Body for review. As practiced we refer this matter to our Provincial Planning and Development Officer who made a thorough review of the AIP for 2026 of the Municipality of Lianga. After the review, they submitted their findings and recommendations and they found that there were several infirmities on the said Annual Investment Plan or Program of the Municipality of Lianga. For which reason, we passed a Resolution returning the said AIP 2026 of the Municipality of Lianga and forthwith they corrected and rectified their AIP and actually passed a Resolution confirming and adopting the rectified Annual Investment Plan 2026 for the Municipality of Lianga. Immediately, they submitted it to this August Body for again, review. Considering that they have rectified said AIP, which was returned to them. In brief, the Provincial Planning and Development Office had also seen the rectified the Program or AIP of the Municipality of Lianga. In fact, they now certified that the same is now finally correct and compliant with the Joint Memorandum of the DBM, COA and DILG. So with this, I don't see any reason why we have to

prolong and to go into the process again of sending it back for a technical review and putting it on a Second Reading and then on the Third Reading considering that it is now compliant, not only as certified by the Provincial Planning and Development Office, but this representation as Chairman of the Committee on Urban Planning and Development, likewise have seen that indeed they have rectified it and now compliant with the Joint Memorandum. So with this, Honorable Presiding Officer, I would like to pull out this matter in the First Reading and Referral to Committee and passing a Resolution confirming the AIP for CY 2026 of the Municipality of Lianga in Unassigned Business/Privilege Business in today's session. So, that will be all, Honorable Presiding Officer and thank you.
