HON. TEMPORARY PRESIDING OFFICER H. PIMENTEL:

Thank you very much, distinguished Majority Floor Leader.

The distinguished Hon. Gines Ricky J. Sayawan, Sr., is hereby recognized to deliver his Privilege Speech.

HON. SAYAWAN, SR.:

Thank you, Hon. Azarcon, and thank you also, Mr. Presiding Officer. Good morning to each and everyone of us. Sir Orlan, ready *na ba ang mga* pictures?

NOTE: (Showing pictures on the screen.)

Mr. Presiding Officer, this humble representation visited the Bislig District Hospital to verify some other concerns by the said Hospital. Mr. Presiding Officer, on that first picture, you can see, one of the main problems now of Bislig District Hospital is that the particular area (pointing out to the screen), Mr. Presiding Officer, has been flooded especially during rainy days and high tide. Then I asked the cause of the flooding, Mr. Presiding Officer, and according to the Chief of Hospital the cause of the flooding is the malfunction of the septic tank. Just imagine a septic tank *tapos mag-overflow* in the hospital. The smell is not good and not healthy especially that it is a hospital. Then, previously we discussed this with the Provincial Administrator because he's the one who informed me that the septic tank of this District Hospital, is a project of I forgot the donors, it was not properly made, supposedly the septic tank should be three to four compartments but unfortunately that particular area the septic tank has been malfunctioning. So, first thing first is that, we will pass a Resolution, this humble representation is contemplating of passing a Resolution first is addressed to the Provincial Engineer's Office to address that problem so that they will make a Program of Work and Detailed Cost of Estimates for the construction or rehabilitation of the septic tank. So as I've said, Mr. Presiding Officer, Program of Work and Detailed Cost of Estimates addressed to the Provincial Engineer's Office and hopefully it will be under Unassigned Business/Privilege Business in today's session.

Second concern, Mr. Presiding Officer is that the Emergency Room can only accumulate two patients, so, other patients for Emergency Room has been placed in the Parking Area. Good thing that there was a tent there named Margarita G. Garay and one is Alexander T. Pimentel. So meaning, Mr. Presiding Officer, they should not be there in that particular area considering that there are emergency cases. So, according to Dra. Vicente, they have already submitted papers or documents to DEPDev - Department of Economy, Planning, and Development formerly NEDA and accordingly the DEPDev has committed an amount of Eight Million Pesos (P8,000,000.00). What we are going to do, Mr. Presiding Officer, is to make a follow-up to DEPDev, so we will pass a Resolution for a tracer of the P8 Million submitted by the Bislig District Hospital for the construction of Emergency Room that would be a two-storey building Mr. Presiding Officer, the worth is P60 Million, Mr. Presiding Officer. Then it would be a construction of two buildings, the second floor will be used for the Doctor's Quarter because the Doctors after their duties they have no room to rest then they will go back again to their duties especially those who are assigned in the Operating Room. So that would be the second Resolution, Mr. Presiding Officer.

Then, the third Resolution, is that the Anesthesia Machine for Operating Room which according to Dra. Vicente they have already submitted documents to PAGCOR. What we are going to do, is to make a follow-up address to PAGCOR, a Resolution requesting PAGCOR for an update or a tracer Anesthesia Machine for the Operating Room for Bislig District Hospital.

NOTE: (Secretariat said there was a MOA already for PAGCOR)

Good thing, Mr. Presiding Officer that according to our Secretariat there was already a Memorandum of Agreement to be signed by Hon. Johnny T. Pimentel. Good thing, Mr. Presiding Officer, according to our Secretariat that the Anesthesia Machine is now ready for delivery after the Memorandum of Agreement will be signed because the name originally was Hon. Johnny T. Pimentel but now it was changed to Hon. Manuel O. Alameda, Sr. considering that he is now the Acting Provincial Governor.

Then another concern, Mr. Presiding Officer, is a land acquisition we can see now the problem in the Adela Serra Ty Memorial Medical Center. The problem is they are going to a high-rise building because they have no lot anymore. In that picture, Mr. Presiding Officer, that particular area at the back is vacant. It's owned by the Garay Family. So, I talked to Madam Margie *dili daw diay ila, lain nga* Garay but the amount Mr. Presiding Officer has already been set, the amount is P2,400.00 per square meter and the total lot is 8,750 square meters. So, the total amount would cost the Provincial Government an amount of P21 Million for the acquisition of that lot. Mr. Presiding Officer. We have acquired lot here in Tandag City and we even distributed it to TESDA and another national agencies, whereas, in that particular area Mr. Presiding Officer, it will be for hospital which is run and maintained by the Provincial Government and the name is for Provincial Government *dili nato ipanghatag na, para gyud na sa* Bislig District Hospital. So, hopefully Mr. Presiding Officer, that will be included in the Annual Investment Program or the AIP for 2027. So that would be the Resolution, to request the Provincial Governor to include the land acquisition in the amount of Twenty One Million Pesos (P21,000,000.00) as additional land for Bislig District Hospital to be included in the AIP for 2027. Again, hopefully, it will be under Unassigned Business/Privilege Business in today's session, Mr. Presiding Officer.

Then, another concern, Mr. Presiding Officer, this is an immediate concern because the Contractor has been given... the one we called the attention in Bislig Session, then they commit that they will turn-over the new building of hospital this coming August 16 per information because Governor Johnny T. Pimentel has already given them an ultimatum up to July 31 but they requested for an extension. But I visited there, Mr. Presiding Officer, I don't think that it would be completed by July or by August 16. But anyway, Mr. Presiding Officer, even if it will be turned-over, Mr. Presiding Officer, that would still not be operational considering that there are still lacking dust and signages, the amount is P1,250,000.00, which this humble representation has requested that it will be included in the 4th SAIP or 4th Supplemental Annual Investment Program wherein the Full Council has met with Hon. Azarcon being the Chairman, and a Member of the Provincial Development Council but per report from Hon. Azarcon, Mr. Presiding Officer, it was not included in the 4th SAIP. So therefore, we will pass a Resolution, Mr. Presiding Officer, that it will be included in the 5th SAIP or 5th Supplemental Annual Investment Program, the amount is P1,250,000.00, the coverage is for dust and signages for the new building to be operationalized, Mr. Presiding Officer.

Then, another concern, Mr. Presiding Officer, is that for the new building consists of 60 bed capacity, 60 beds, Mr. Presiding Officer, but when I looked at the beds of the hospital some other beds are already dilapidated and it's not good. Some of the patients even lay their body in the folding bed, no longer hospital bed, the cost of hospital beds, Mr. Presiding Officer three layers *ni siya nga ma-reclined* and with a side table *para ang pasyente diha na magkaon sa kilid*, the amount is P54,000.00 and then, if we will purchase 100 beds, it would cost us P5.4 Million Pesos.

Then, Mr. Presiding Officer, Bislig District Hospital are overpopulated. So, they need a new building so, *kung ma-transfer na sila* to a new building, *ma-operationalize to siya* with 60 beds. So, definitely, *makabalhin na sila sa* more conducive place. So, an additional of P5.4 Million Pesos for 100 beds. Also, for inclusion in the 5th Supplemental Annual Investment Program.

Then, another is an additional of P16.8 Million for the access road and fencing or access catwalk because the new building, Mr. Presiding Officer, as you can see, it is separated from the other buildings. So, it needs a catwalk in order for the other patients, if they will be transported for operations, so *para maka abut sila sa* Operating Room, *kinahanglan siya isakay sa* stretcher, then *kung mag-ulan basa sila kung walay cover ang* catwalk. So, the cover of catwalk and the fencing will cost an amount of P16.8 Million Pesos. Then, hopefully, it will be for inclusion in the Annual Investment Program for 2027. I hope I did not miss anything, Mr. Presiding Officer, on my concern. That would be the Resolutions I am proposing for Bislig District Hospital. Thank you, Mr. Presiding Officer and once again, good morning.

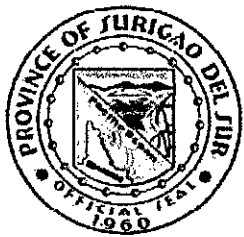
HON. TEMPORARY PRESIDING OFFICER H. PIMENTEL:

Therefore, Honorable Presiding Officer, I have here a Resolution "Inviting Leading Philippines and International Companies to Explore Investment Opportunities in the Province of Surigao del Sur in the Areas of Responsible Mining and Mineral Processing, Agricultural and Agribusiness, Marine Industry, Renewable Energy, Manufacturing, and Other Sustainable Development Projects".

Therefore, to be it resolved, as it is hereby resolved by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Surigao del Sur, to formally invite qualified local and international investors, including but not limited to San Miguel Corporation, Aboitiz Equity Ventures Inc., Nickel Asia Corporation, DMCI Holding Inc., ACEN Corporation, First Gen Corporation, and other Philippine and Foreign Companies interested in sustainable investment.

Resolved Further, that the Provincial Government shall coordinate with the Department of Trade and Industry (DTI), the Board of Investment (BOI), the Philippine Economic Zone Authority (PEZA), the Department of Energy (DOE), the Department of Agriculture (DA), and the Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR), and other concerned agencies to promote investment opportunity in the Province.

So, if there is no objection, Honorable Chair, I would like to pass this Resolution under Unassigned Business/Privilege Business for today's session, Honorable Chair.

HON. TEMPORARY PRESIDING OFFICER H. PIMENTEL:

Thank you very much, your Honor. The very much important concern of the distinguished Chairman of the Committee on Public Works and Infrastructure for the massive economic development of the Province of Surigao del Sur shall be dealt with and sponsored in the Unassigned Business/Privilege Business of today's session. Please take note, Madam Secretary.

At this point, the Honorable Yuri Art Eufy R. Sanchez is hereby recognized to deliver his Privilege Speech. You are recognized, your Honor. Go ahead, please.

HON. SANCHEZ:

Thank you, Honorable Presiding Officer. Honorable Presiding Officer, distinguished colleagues of this Honorable Sangguniang Panlalawigan, ladies and gentlemen, good morning. I rise today on a matter of personal and collective privilege, as Member of this Honorable Body, we have been entrusted with the responsibility of serving the people of Surigao del Sur. Part of the responsibility is to give due attention to the concerns and needs of our municipalities and to act on them with fairness, diligence, and in accordance with our established processes. As someone who calls Barobo home, I recently had the opportunity to speak with our Municipal Mayor, Hon. Ronnie Martizano.

During our conversation, he respectfully requested my assistance in following-up several legislative measures that have already been transmitted to this Honorable Body. Understanding the importance of these measures to the Municipality of Barobo, I deemed it proper to bring them to the attention of my distinguished colleagues with the hope that they may be given due

consideration in accordance with our rules and established processes as they are essential to the Municipality's ongoing programs and development initiatives.

With this, Mr. Presiding Officer, I respectfully call the attention of this Honorable Body to the following measures:

Ordinance No. 08, Series of 2026, "Declaring Certain Programs, Projects, and Activities Under the Calendar Year 2021 to 2025, 20% Development Fund as Abandoned and Making the Corresponding Funds Available for Reprogramming".

Resolution No. 182, Series of 2026, "Approving and Adopting the Calendar Year 2026 Supplemental Annual Investment Program No. 2, and CY 2026 - 2028 Supplemental Local Development Investment Program No. 02". and;

Ordinance No. 9, Series of 2026, "Declaring Certain Programs, Projects, and Activities under the 5% Municipal Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Fund as Abandoned and Making the Corresponding Funds Available for Reprogramming".

These measures have undergone the appropriate processes at the Municipal level and were endorsed through the Municipal Development Council. The consideration by this Honorable Body will enable the Municipality of Barobo to move forward with the reprogramming of funds and implementation of priority programs and projects that respond to the present needs of the community.

With utmost respect to the processes of this Honorable Body, I humbly bring these matters to its attention and respectfully request that they be given due consideration at the earliest possible time in accordance with our rules and established procedures. Thank you, Presiding Officer, and that's all.

HON. TEMPORARY PRESIDING OFFICER H. PIMENTEL:

Thank you very much, Hon. Yuri Art Eufy R. Sanchez. If I'm not mistaken, there are two Ordinances and one Resolution being quote-unquote followed up by the incumbent Municipal Mayor of the Municipality of Barobo. Please take note, Madam Secretary, for those Ordinances and Resolution. If we may request the attention of the Chairman of the Committee on Finance and Appropriations, the distinguished Majority Floor Leader. If I can only ask for myself, so it is now Hon. Yuri Art Eufy R. Sanchez, who is now the confidant of the Mayor of Barobo in this Legislative Council and no longer anymore the Former Mayor and now the distinguished King of Insertion, Hon. Joey S. Pama. Okay, please take note. It's basically a follow-up and please refer the matter to the concerned Chairman of the concerned Committees.

Now, the Former Mayor of the Municipality of Barobo, the distinguished Number 1, Sangguniang Panlalawian Member in the Second District, Hon. Joey S. Pama is now hereby recognized.

HON. PAMA:

Well, thank you, Honorable Temporary Presiding Officer. Actually, Honorable Mayor Ronito L. Martizano had approached me by phone and asking for that Ordinance, (how it does, it goes). Actually, there was a Committee Meeting happened and in that Committee Meeting, I was

not present since the Committee Meeting was on the Committee on Finance and Appropriation. As far as I remember, there was a recommendation from the Committee to return without approval, however, there are such some lines that the Committee, I wanted to change so, *tag-correctionan yadto* for the purpose, after that it would be corrected, the Committee on Finance and Appropriation will be going to approve. So, now the right person who could tell us is the Committee Chairman on Finance and Appropriation, who is Hon. Azarcon to answer and to be more clarified with the issue. Thank you.

HON. TEMPORARY PRESIDING OFFICER H. PIMENTEL:

Your Honor, you are listed here as number four in the Privilege Speech. So, you have any more concerns, Hon. Pama? It's your turn to deliver your Privilege Speech, Your Honor.

HON. PAMA:

That was just a comment from Hon. Sanchez. So, actually, I have taken this Privilege for the Municipality of Barobo and not only from the Municipality of Barobo to include, of course, the Municipality of Tagbina and other neighboring Municipalities which involves on the environment. In which the last, I guess that was more or less one month ago that I have passed a Resolution addressed to the PENRO to investigate on what happened to their apprehensions on the illegal mining in which the allegation that was brought to me, is that there was already a *hulidap*, Honorable Chair, in the implementation of the apprehensions of the illegal miners. As I repeat, the apprehensions, that is why I did not mention any of the agencies, because there was a PNP and other National Agencies who have actually facilitated on the arrest illegal mining, Honorable Chair. So, I told, there was a *hulidap* since it was the report of the people in which, instead *nga dakpon nila ang mga* illegal miners with the motorized water pump, which it cost more or less 30 motor pump was confiscated, but they included the cell phones, the money from the pocket, all of these valuable materials, *bisag unsa na lang pagkaon, manok* or whatever it is, was also included in the confiscation and only five persons was *gidakop nila* and apprehended for more than a hundreds of illegal miners. So, I had a Resolution Honorable Chair, to investigate addressed to the PENRO, that is why, I am now be passing a Resolution Honorable Chair on the Unassigned Business/Privilege Business as far as my Resolution is concerned, to tell us what it resolved on the investigation Honorable Chair, so that we will know Honorable Chair, *kung unsa gyud nahitabo sa* investigation. I am interested with this, Honorable Chair, because the Municipality of Barobo is one of the biggest concern on this matter. So, until now, *naa gihapon mga dakop ug nasundan pa gyud to ug laing dakop* the same thing. Then, somebody shouted from the apprehending officials *nga paldo na sab ta*. So, that is the reason, that is my concern, Honorable Chair.

So, I would like to address that to pass another Resolution addressed to the PENRO, to make a report Honorable Chair on next session. Thank you.

HON. TEMPORARY PRESIDING OFFICER H. PIMENTEL:

Thank you, very much, your Honor. If I may ask, your Honor, this is the second time that you already mentioned this "hulidap" during the Privilege Hour. Right now, the report from the PENRO is still wanting. If I may suggest, your Honor, why not conduct the investigation in the Committee level in the Sangguniang Panlalawigan, addressed it to the Committee on Peace and Order and Public Safety Chaired by Hon. Ruel D. Momo, co-investigated by the Committee on Environmental Protection and Ecology Chaired by the Deputy Majority Floor Leader, Hon. Jose

Dumagan, Jr., so that the representatives of the people, the Members of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan may be apprised directly what is going on right now. You requested for an investigation by the PENRO up to now there is no report. So, if I may suggest, *kita na lang ang mag-investigate* after all we are representatives of the people there is a Committee on Peace and Order and Public Safety, there is also the Committee on Environmental Protection and Ecology. If I may just suggest, your honor.

HON. PAMA:

Thank you, Honorable Chair, I appreciate and well it could be to call another Committee Meeting with the Members of the Committee to investigate on this matter.

HON. TEMPORARY PRESIDING OFFICER H. PIMENTEL:

My concern is that, *basig importante sa imo* but not important to the PENRO. So, maybe you can sponsor a Resolution calling for the investigation in aid of legislation of this matter in the Sangguniang Panlalawigan Committees, your Honor. If I may just suggest, *pareha gani kuman wara pa gani ila* report. If I may remember, *kagan-o pa yadton imo* Privilege Speech, *taud-taud na yadto*, your Honor, up to now there is no report. So, *para* directly *ma-apprise kita*, if I may just suggest, maybe we can conduct an investigation, your Honor, to be handled by a Committee on Peace and Order and Public Safety and Committee on Environmental Protection and Ecology and you as the principal sponsor of the said Resolution and Resource Person as well.

HON. PAMA:

Yes, actually, *tama yadto gayud*, we'll give also chance to the PENRO if they have conducted a report, if they will not do that, that may be the time that we're going to have it. Thank you so much.

HON. TEMPORARY PRESIDING OFFICER H. PIMENTEL:

Okay, thank you very much, Hon. Pama. It's a Resolution asking PENRO to report formally officially to the Sangguniang Panlalawigan. At this point, the just appointed Chairman Committee on Rules, Privileges and Ethics and just appointed by the Temporary Presiding Officer, Deputy Majority Floor Leader, Hon. Jose Dumagan, Jr. is hereby recognized.

HON. DUMAGAN, JR.:

I am in a quandary where in our rules that a Deputy Majority Floor Leader has been mentioned, however, thank you for the confidence, Honorable Presiding Officer but we have only one leader we have a Majority Floor Leader in this House. I am in a possession of two (2) letters coming from the Office of the Governor addressed to the Vice Governor asking for the passage of an urgent Resolution of Authority. First, is a Resolution authorizing the Acting Provincial Governor to enter into and sign for and in behalf of the Provincial Government for a Supplemental Memorandum of Agreement with the Department of Education for the construction, replacement, reconstruction, rehabilitation, repair and improvement of works, which shall be funded under GAA 2026 Basic Education Facilities Program.

Second, is another Resolution, authorizing the Acting Provincial Governor to enter into a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA), with the Philippine Amusement and Gaming Corporation (PAGCOR) for the allocation of funds for the construction of a three-story PAGCOR School Building at Tagbina Central Elementary School, Barangay Poblacion, Tagbina, Surigao del Sur.

With this, I would like to respectfully move that a Resolution of Authority in fact two (2) Resolutions, authorizing the Acting Provincial Governor and will be included in the Unassigned Business/Privilege Business for today's session as instructed by the Chairperson and Acting Presiding Officer for today's session, Hon. Henrich M. Pimentel. Thank you, Honorable Presiding Officer.

HON. TEMPORARY PRESIDING OFFICER H. PIMENTEL:

Thank you very much, Hon. Dumagan, Jr.. The two concerns shall be sponsored in Unassigned Business/Privilege Business in today's session. Please take note, Secretary.

HON. DUMAGAN, JR.:

If I may continue, Honorable Presiding Officer?

HON. TEMPORARY PRESIDING OFFICER H. PIMENTEL:

Please continue, your Honor.

HON. DUMAGAN, JR.:

In 1993, a landmark decision was promulgated by the Supreme Court, in the case of Oposa and Facturan, the Supreme Court said that there is this principle of Inter-generational Responsibility. Inter-generational Responsibility, is a legal doctrine that provides that the present and current generation has a fiduciary obligation to present or preserve a balance and helpful ecology for the succeeding generations. It granted the minors the legal standing to sue on behalf of themselves and the future generation. Intergenerational Responsibility is the moral and legal duty of the present generation to protect the natural resources, manage the environment, sustainable and safeguard the well-being of the future generation *kung sa tinamban na pagka-estorya*, Honorable Presiding Officer, *ang pagprotekta sa kanaiyahan, dili lamang kini limitado sa pagprotektar para sa ato kaugalingon kun dili ato kini protektaran sa atong mga anak, sa atong mga apo, ug sa mga sumusunod sa atong mga apo*, Inter-generational Responsibility.

Last July 28, I was directed by the Office of the Vice Governor to attend in a Community Assembly in Carmen, and there this Community Assembly. Farmers were present, Tribal Leaders were present, Barangay Officials of the eight (8) Barangays of Carmen were there, the Local Government represented by the Mayor and the Vice Mayor and the Sangguniang Bayan Members were also there, and Members of the Church, Civic Organizations, in fact, the good Bishop Dael was there. What was discussed was the application of Amalgamated Mining Corporation which has a pending application with the Mines and Geosciences Bureau to mine parts of the area of Carmen. Because of this application, a series of Resolutions were passed eight (8) Resolutions coming from the eight (8) Barangays, a Resolution coming from the Sangguniang Bayan and in fact, the Tribal Farmers issued similar Resolutions, Resolutions strongly opposing the mining application of Amalgamated Industries in the Municipality of Carmen.

One of the attendees, an old guy, who was a Former employee of Puyat was there. He stood up, he said talking directly to Sir Glenn, the Regional Director of the Mines and Geosciences Bureau, he said that: *Sa among panahon Sir na empleyado pa ako sa Puyat, wa gyud namo ni hilabti na mga kahoy, bisan ang among papel, ang papel sa Puyat nagahatag ug katungod na muputol ug naturally grown, wa gyud namo ni hilabti kay tungod mao kini ang tinubdan sa tubig na gikinahanglan sa Lungsod sa Carmen.* Now, you are giving this application, approving the application of Amalgamated and giving this area to them even without properly consulting the people of Carmen. Why? Because the people of Carmen never knew that there was this application. They only knew because they were instructed by the Mines and Geosciences Bureau XIII, to post notices in conspicuous and public places, *yakadawat ang Mayor pagalang-an siya palihog pagpapilit, gani milaong pa ngani na pagpapilit sa mga Provincial Offices. Milaong ang Mayor no, we don't have that right pero in public places in the Municipality so didto sila yakahibawo na yaon bayay application.*

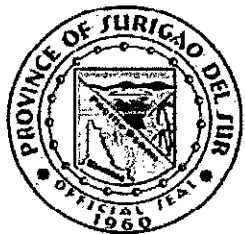
So, with this, series of Resolutions as I said earlier, were passed by the eight (8) Barangays, the Tribal Farmers and even the Municipal Government of Carmen. Now, they are earnestly requesting *naghangyo sila na basin pwede na ang mga Miyembro sa Sangguniang Panlalawigan na mu-suporta sa kawsa sa mga katawhan sa Carmen.* They're asking that we formalize the support by issuing and legislating a Resolution strongly opposing the application of Amalgamated Industry Works in the Municipality of Carmen.

Again, this is very important, why? Because based on the present rules of the Department of Environment and Natural Resources, unlike before, it started with free acceptance of free Local Government Units Barangay, Municipal and Provincial. Then, it became two, any two of the three will do but based on the present Department Administrative Order (DAO) of DENR a single Barangay if directly affected may allow the mining application. That is sufficient, that is very alarming. So my question is, which is important the influx of investment in our province or the protection of our environment and the welfare of the general public? *Bisan unhon nato pag-tinamban pagpili Honorable Presiding Officer, importante sa ako ug kahibawo ako, sayud ako na mas importante sab sa iyo ang kaugmaon nan mga Carmenanon, ang kaugmaon nan taga CarCanMadCarLan sa ila mga anak, sa mga apo ug sa ilang umaabot na mga henerasyon.* This is what we call again, the Inter-generational Responsibility to protect the environment and to protect the children.

With this, I respectfully move that as part of the Unassigned Business/Privilege Business in today's session, we pass unanimously a Resolution, "Strongly Opposing the Application of Amalgamated in the Municipality of Carmen, Surigao del Sur". Thank you and good morning.

HON. TEMPORARY PRESIDING OFFICER H. PIMENTEL:

Thank you very much, your Honor. The discussion shall be continued during the Unassigned Business/Privilege Business, anybody can ask question to the proponent, if I may just add again the Resolution is strongly opposing. If we can review the case being mentioned by the distinguished Chairman of the Committee on Rules, Privileges and Ethics, the Oposa versus Facturan, if i'm not mistaken the name of the Petitioner in that case is Antonio Oposa and the Resolution is opposing, so from Oposa to opposing the application of the Amalgamated.

HON. DUMAGAN, JR.:

In 1993, the Supreme Court promulgated this decision on the Oposa versus Facturan, the case was filed by 43 minors Oposa siblings against the sitting Secretary of the DENR. In the lower Court, Facturan the Respondent said that no they have no personality, why? Because they may or may not be affected by the approval of the Timber Licenses Agreement because these children were seeking for the nullification of previously issued TLA and the suspension of granting. So, based on current Rules of Court, if you are not a real party you cannot file a case, however, the Supreme Court said "no" it may be true that they are not holding or holders of a Timber License Agreement but they are children that may be affected in the degradation of the natural resources of the forest and the watershed. So, this was the first time the Supreme Court said that there is this legal principle which we call Inter-generational Responsibility.

This is a landmark case for the Philippines, your Honor. In fact, this was copied by all legal jurisdictions throughout the world.

HON. TEMPORARY PRESIDING OFFICER H. PIMENTEL:

Very good case. Thank you for reminding that, okay, thank you very much, Hon. Dumagan, Jr..

At this point, the Temporary Presiding Officer will now call and acknowledge the next to deliver his Privilege Speech, Hon. Jimmy I. Guinsod, the pride of Barangay Bagyang, San Miguel, is hereby recognized.

HON. GUINSOD:

Thank you, to our handsome and energetic Presiding Officer, Hon. Henrich M. Pimentel and to all the Members of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan, Secretariat, guests and visitors, good morning. Your Honor, I just have three (3) proposed Resolutions to be passed in Unassigned Business/Privilege Business in today's session and asking favor to the Members of this August Body. The number one in the list, Honorable Chair, is a Resolution "Earnestly Requesting the Department of Tourism Secretary for the Refunding of Calatngan Little Palawan Tourist Potential Site at Gingha River for Concreting in the Amount of One Hundred Twenty Five Million Pesos (P125,000,000.00) Located at Barangay Calatngan, San Miguel, Surigao del Sur". So that's why, we repass our Resolution Honorable Chair and to be included in Unassigned Business/Privilege Business in today's session, Honorable Chair.

Second one, is a Resolution "Earnestly Requesting the Commander of the 4th Infantry Division of the Philippine Army Major General Marion T Angcao to Retain All IP Soldiers in Surigao del Sur Under the 75th Infantry Battalion Who are Now Transferred to Maguindanao Area". We will request this through a Resolution, Honorable Chair because previously before this IP soldiers enlisted it was already our intention to protect all our Ancestral Domain Areas in Caraga especially in the Province of Surigao del Sur. *Bisan tuod ang Army magbalhin-balhin gyud, may amo mga* understanding before that the IP soldiers must be in the Ancestral Domain.

Macasocol for the Hiring of IPed Teacher Applicants Deployed in Elementary School of Living Tradition and Other IP Schools in Areas in the Province of the Surigao del Sur". Honorable Chair, after our Committee Meeting on Committee on Education here led by our distinguished Chairman Hon. Sayawan, Sr., week after almost half of the list of the IP Teacher Applicants were appointed and deployed by our Schools Division Superintendent in different schools under Ancestral Domain areas in our Province. On behalf of the Tribal Leaders and IP Communities in our Province, we would like to thank all Board Members who went to Manila to met and talked with the Assistant Secretary Jerome and all the IP Focal in the National Office of DepEd and we were very happy in our side that the Board Members *gihimo ninyo ang pagtabang gyud nga para sa ato mga IP Communities* and we thank you for that. *Ako gipang-send sa amo GC sa mga IP Teachers ang atong mga gipanghimo* from here in the Committee Level of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan up to Manila, so, *nag-pasalamat gyud ang ato mga Teachers*. So, that's all, Honorable Chair, the three (3) proposed Resolutions to be passed under Unassigned Business/ Privilege Business of today's session. Thank you.

HON. TEMPORARY PRESIDING OFFICER H. PIMENTEL:
