

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The Municipality of Carmen takes pride in the Hubason River Resort and Adventure Trail, a natural treasure that has rapidly become a prime destination for eco-tourism and community recreation. Since its establishment, the area has attracted a growing number of visitors, contributing significantly to the municipality's local economy and promoting the rich environmental and cultural heritage of the community.

However, the increasing popularity of the Hubason River Resort and Adventure Trail and its surrounding areas, especially upstream, has also brought about pressing challenges. Unchecked activities can lead to soil erosion, water pollution, obstruction of natural trails, and degradation of the natural habitat. Moreover, these activities undermine the municipality's tourism planning efforts, creating potential hazards to public safety and diminishing the overall experience for residents and visitors alike.

In view of these concerns, this Ordinance seeks to: Declare the Hubason River Resort and Adventure Trail, including its adjacent areas, as a Tourism and Environmental Protection Zone, thereby ensuring its sustainable use for present and future generations;

Regulate the use, occupation, and development of the identified zone to align with environmental protection and tourism management standards;

Impose a moratorium on constructions and activities incompatible with the environmental, cultural, and tourism objectives of the zone;

Grant authority to the Local Chief Executive to summarily demolish illegal or unauthorized structures within the zone to ensure swift enforcement of protective measures; and provide appropriate penalties for violations to deter future infractions.

By enacting this measure, the Sangguniang Bayan of Carmen affirms its commitment to responsible stewardship of natural resources, balanced tourism development, and the preservation of the Hubason River Resort and Adventure Trail as a community pride and lasting legacy for the people of Carmen.

In light of the foregoing, the immediate passage of this Ordinance is earnestly sought.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Sangguniang Bayan of Carmen, Surigao del Sur, in session duly assembled, that:

SECTION 1. TITLE. This Ordinance shall be known as the "**Hubason River Resort and Adventure Trail Tourism Environmental Protection Zone Ordinance of the Municipality of Carmen, Surigao del Sur.**"

SECTION 2. LEGAL BASES. The following are the legal bases for enacting this ordinance: **Article 51 of PD No. 1067** also known as the **Water Code of the Philippines** provides that the banks of rivers and streams and the shores of the seas and lakes throughout their entire length and within forty (40) meters in forest areas, along their margins are subject to the easement of public use in the interest of recreation, navigation, floatage, fishing and salvage. No person shall be allowed to stay in this zone longer than what is necessary for recreation, navigation, floatage, fishing or salvage or to build structures of any kind.



Presidential Decree 705 also known as the **Revised Forestry Code of the Philippines**, provides a legal basis for this ordinance by emphasizing the protection, rehabilitation, and development of forest lands to ensure their "continuity in productive condition".

Aquino vs. Municipality of Aklan (GR. No. 211356, September 2014) where the Supreme Court decisively affirmed the municipality's authority-via its mayor to order demolition of illegally constructed buildings, even on forestland, provided due process and LGC procedures are observed.

Section 444 (b) (3) (vi) of the Local Code of 1991 provides the local chief executive authority to order demolition or removal of building or structure illegally constructed.

DILG Opinion on Matugas v. Barbers where it provides that even if the event is provincial-led, activities conducted within a municipality must comply with the host LGU'S permitting and regulatory requirements.

Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Surigao Del Sur Ordinance No. 155-25, Series of 2025 (Declaring Hubason Sub-Watershed, Bayoyo-Panaghoyan Sub-Watershed, Suwahid-Daan Sub-Watershed, Agasan-Cadilotan Sub-Watershed, and Buyaan Sub-Watershed as Sub-Watershed Systems in the Municipality of Carmen, Surigao Del Sur) Section 5 par. (d) prohibits undertaking activities or development and expansion of projects without permission of the local authorities.

RA 7586 (NIPAS Act, as amended by RA 11038) Section 20 (Prohibited Acts) bans, among others: poaching or disturbing wildlife; cutting/collecting timber; using destructive fishing/harvesting methods; introducing exotic/invasive species or GMOs; and conducting bioprospecting without prior clearance – direct measures to protect biodiversity inside protected areas.

RA 9275 (Philippine Clean Water Act of 2004) Section 27 (Prohibited Acts) prohibits discharging pollutants that exceed water quality standards and dumping wastes into water bodies, ensuring preservation of water quality.

RA 9003 (Ecological Solid Waste Management Act) Section 48 (Prohibited Acts) It is unlawful to dump, dispose or throw any waste materials in public places such as roads, sidewalks, canals, esteros, parks and other open spaces, or to allow the open burning of solid wastes.

SECTION 3. DECLARATION OF POLICY. It is hereby declared the policy of the Municipality of Carmen to:

- 1) Preserve and protect the natural beauty, ecological balance, and cultural value of the Hubason River Resort and Adventure Trail;
- 2) Promote sustainable tourism and responsible recreational activities; and
- 3) Regulate development in and around the area to prevent environmental degradation and ensure the long-term viability of the site as a tourism and environmental asset.

SECTION 4. COVERAGE. This Ordinance shall apply to the Hubason River Resort and Adventure Trail, including all waters, banks, trails, easements, and adjacent lands within twenty (20) meters for titled lands and forty (40) meters for forestlands, from its demarcated boundaries, as determined by the Municipal Environment and Natural Resources Office and the Municipal Assessors Office.



SECTION 5. DEFINITION OF TERMS. For purposes of this Ordinance:

Core Protection Zone (CPZ) – strictly protected areas within the zone such as riparian forests, springs, recharge areas, critical habitats, and slopes $\geq 50\%$, where no new structures or incompatible activities are allowed.

Easement Buffer Zone (EBZ) – areas measured from the highest ordinary water line of rivers and streams (40m in forest lands, 20m in agricultural lands, and 3m in urban areas) that must remain vegetated and free from permanent structures, consistent with PD 1067, PD 705, and other relevant laws.

Sustainable Use/Multiple-Use Zone (MUZ) – designated areas for low-impact, regulated activities such as eco-tourism, research, recreation, and limited facilities, provided they are consistent with an approved Site Management Plan and compatible with environmental protection.

Tourism and Environmental Protection Zone- An area designated for sustainable tourism development while maintaining ecological balance and protecting biodiversity.

Incompatible Construction – Any permanent or temporary structure, activity, or facility that adversely affects the environmental integrity, scenic value, or tourism potential of the Zone.

Adjacent Areas – Lands bordering or lying within coverage area of this Ordinance.

Notice of Violation (NOV) - A formal written document issued by the Building Official or authorized enforcement officer for violations of the National Building Code of the Philippines (PD 1096), this Ordinance, or related regulations.



SECTION 6. DECLARATION AS TOURISM AND ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION ZONE. The Hubason River Resort and Adventure Trail and its adjacent areas, as defined in Section 4, are hereby declared as a Tourism and Environmental Protection Zone under the management and supervision of the Municipal Government of Carmen, in coordination with concerned national government agencies.

Regulated/Allowed Uses (MUZ only, subject to permits):

Low-impact facilities (e.g., signages, view decks, guard posts, footbridges) using eco-friendly designs;

Adventure trail operations that enhance surveillance and stewardship, with trained guides and visitor caps;

Research, education, and guided tours with prior MENRO/DENR clearance;

Maintenance activities for public safety (e.g., pruning hazardous branches).

Zonation:

Core Protection Zone (CPZ) – riparian forests, springs, recharge areas, critical habitats, and slopes $\geq 50\%$ within the sub-watershed; strict protection, no new structures allowed;

Easement Buffer Zone (EBZ) – measured from the highest ordinary water line: 40m in forest areas, 20m in agricultural areas, 3m in urbanized stretches; to remain vegetated and free of permanent structures, consistent with PD 1067, PD 705, and RA 1273;



Multiple-Use Zone (MUZ) – areas within the zone designated for low-impact, regulated activities such as eco-tourism, research, recreation, and limited facilities consistent with an approved Site Management Plan, ensuring compatibility with environmental protection.

The above zonation declaration shall be integrated into the Municipal Zoning Ordinance and shall form part of the municipality's comprehensive land use framework. This integration ensures consistency with land use policies, strengthens regulatory enforcement, and upholds the municipality's long-term sustainability and environmental protection objectives.

SECTION 7. MORATORIUM ON INCOMPATIBLE CONSTRUCTIONS. No person, natural or juridical, shall construct, install, or operate any building structure, or facility within the Zone that is incompatible with its tourism and environmental protection purposes, including but not limited to:

- 1) Industrial facilities;
- 2) Commercial establishments that obstruct public access to the river;
- 3) Structures that alter the river's natural flow or damage its banks;
- 4) Any structure built within twenty (20) meters for titled lands and forty (40) meters for forestlands of the water easements.
- 5) The moratorium shall remain in effect unless lifted by a Resolution of the Sangguniang Bayan, upon recommendation of the Municipal Tourism Council and the Municipal Environment and Natural Resources Office (MENRO).

 **SECTION 8. REGULATORY ACTS.** Any proposed development, construction, or activity within the Tourism and Environmental Protection Zone shall strictly comply with the following requirements prior to implementation:

- 1) Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA), if applicable, in accordance with DENR and EMB guidelines;
 - 2) Prior clearance from the Municipal Environment and Natural Resources Office (MENRO) and the Municipal Tourism Office;
 - 3) Approval of a Development Permit by the Sangguniang Bayan;
 - 4) Securing a Building Permit from the Office of the Building Official/Engineering Office;
 - 5) Updated Tax Declaration duly issued by the Municipal Assessor's Office (MASSO and PASSO);
 - 6) Alienable and Disposable (A&D) Land Certification or related certification from the Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR), if applicable;
 - 7) Zoning Clearance from the Municipal Planning and Development Coordinator/Zoning Officer;
 - 8) Business Permit from the Municipal Mayor's Office if the proposed development involves commercial operations.
 - 9) No development, construction, or business activity shall commence without full compliance with the foregoing regulatory acts.

SECTION 9. PROHIBITORY ACTS. The following acts are strictly prohibited within the Tourism and Environmental Protection Zone:

- 1) Construction of any cottages, houses, resorts, or other permanent/temporary structures without LGU permit;
- 2) Cutting, gathering, or destruction of trees, shrubs, and other vegetation;
- 3) Dumping of solid waste, sewage, or toxic chemicals;
- 4) Quarrying, mining, or extraction of sand, gravel, and other resources;
- 5) Poaching, hunting, or killing of wildlife;
- 6) Use of destructive fishing practices or alteration of riverbanks;

Any other act that may degrade water quality, endanger biodiversity, or destroy the natural beauty of the area.

SECTION 10. PENALTIES. Any person violating any provision of this Ordinance shall be liable to:

| Third and Subsequent Offenses | - Fine of Two Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (Php2,500.00), demolition/removal of the illegal structure, cancellation of business permit (if applicable), and/or imprisonment of up to six (6) months subject to the discretion of the court. |

The imposition of penalties shall be without prejudice to the filing of criminal, civil, or administrative cases under applicable laws.

SECTION 11. SUMMARY DEMOLITION OF ILLEGAL or UNAUTHORIZED STRUCTURE. In furtherance of the objectives of this Ordinance and pursuant to Section 444(b) (3) (vi) of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the "Local Government Code of 1991", the Local Chief Executive is hereby authorized to order the summary removal and demolition of any structure, improvement, or encroachment.

SECTION 12. PROCEDURE FOR SUMMARY DEMOLITION. The following procedure shall be observed in the enforcement of the authority to summarily demolish illegal or unauthorized structures within the Hubason River Resort and Adventure Trail Tourism and Environmental Protection Zone:

1. **Inspection and Documentation.** The Municipal Engineer, in coordination with the Municipal Environment and Natural Resources Office (MENRO), shall conduct an on-site inspection of the reported structure.

A written inspection report shall be prepared, stating the location, nature, and extent of the violation, and shall be supported by photographs, sketches, or other documentation.

2. **Issuance of Notice of Violation (NOV).** Based on the inspection report, the Local Chief Executive shall cause the issuance of a Notice of Violation to the owner, possessor, or occupant of the structure.

The NOV shall state the nature of the violation, the legal basis for removal, and shall direct the voluntary removal or demolition of the structure within seventy-two (72) hours from receipt.

Service of the NOV shall be personal, whenever possible; otherwise, it shall be served by registered mail and by posting in a conspicuous place on or near the structure.

3. **Voluntary Compliance Period.** The owner or occupant shall be allowed to voluntarily remove the structure within the prescribed period. Failure to comply within the period shall result in the immediate enforcement of demolition.

3. **Issuance of Demolition Order.** Upon lapse of the voluntary compliance period, the Local Chief Executive shall issue a Demolition Order directing the Municipal Engineer and the MENRO to implement the removal of the structure.

The Demolition Order shall specify the date and time of enforcement and shall authorize the use of municipal manpower, equipment, and police assistance.

4. **Implementation of Demolition.** The Municipal Engineer, with the assistance of the Philippine National Police of Carmen, shall implement the demolition in compliance with safety and (PNP) environmental protection protocols. All salvageable materials shall be turned over to the owner or occupant. If unclaimed within thirty (30) days, the Municipality shall dispose of them in accordance with applicable laws.

6. **Special Cases for Immediate Demolition.** No prior NOV or voluntary compliance period shall be required if the structure:

- 1) Poses imminent danger to life, limb, or property; or,
- 2) Causes obstruction to waterways, public paths, or emergency access.

In such cases, the Local Chief Executive may order immediate demolition upon recommendation of the Municipal Engineer and MENRO.

7. **Cost Recovery.** All expenses incurred by the Municipality in the demolition, including labor, hauling, and disposal costs, shall be charged to the owner or occupant. Failure to reimburse such costs within thirty (30) days from billing shall be subject to collection through appropriate legal action.

8. **Record-Keeping.** The demolition team shall maintain complete, accurate, and upto-date records of all transactions, activities, and operations undertaken pursuant to this Ordinance. All documents, photographs, and reports related to the demolition shall be filed with the Municipal Engineering Office for record and possible court use.

SECTION 13. IMPLEMENTING AGENCIES. The Municipal Mayor's Office through the Municipal Tourism Office, in coordination with the MENRO, Municipal Engineering Office, and the Philippine National Police, shall be responsible for the implementation and enforcement of this Ordinance.

SECTION 14. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. If any provision of this Ordinance is declared invalid, the remaining provisions shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 15. REPEALING CLAUSE. All ordinances, resolutions, or parts thereof inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 16. EFFECTIVITY. This Ordinance shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its posting in at least three (3) conspicuous places within the Municipality.






MINUTES OF THE PUBLIC HEARING OF THE TWO (2) BARANGAYS NAMELY: BARANGAYS SAN VICENTE AND POBLACION FOR ONE (1) PROPOSED ORDINANCE OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF CARMEN, SURIGAO DEL SUR HELD AT THE MULTI-PURPOSE EVACUATION CENTER, BARANGAY POBLACION, CARMEN, SURIGAO DEL SUR ON AUGUST 23, 2025 AT 1:00 O’CLOCK IN THE AFTERNOON”

WELCOME MESSAGE:

Hon. Blandena V. Sugian gave her welcome message and acknowledged all the participants from Barangay San Vicente and Barangay Poblacion for attending the public hearing. She advised listening to all the speakers who will explain the proposed ordinance of the Municipality of Carmen, Surigao del Sur.

A video presentation on the beauty of Hubason River Resort and Adventure Trail and its adjacent areas was shown, followed by the presentation of photos showing rampant illegal cutting of trees in the said area.

PUBLIC HEARING PROPER:

Hon. Jane V. Plaza introduced and presented the proposed ordinance entitled **“ORDINANCE DECLARING THE HUBASON RIVER RESORT AND ADVENTURE TRAIL AND ITS ADJACENT AREAS AS A TOURISM AND ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION ZONE, REGULATING DEVELOPMENT, AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF”**

Hon. Jane V. Plaza explained that five (5) committees introduced this ordinance: 1. Committee on Laws, Rules, and Human Rights, 2. Committee on Tourism, 3. Committee on Environment, 4. Committee on Finance, Appropriations, Ways and Means, and Economic Enterprises, 5. Committee on Infrastructure.

Hon. Jane V. Plaza explained the urgency and importance of this ordinance for the long-term sustainability Hubason River Resort and Adventure Trail and its surrounding areas.

SB Committee Chairman on Laws, Hon. Quillano, first explained in Section 1. Title "Hubason River Resort and Adventure Trail Tourism and Environmental Protection Zone Ordinance of the Municipality of Carmen, Surigao del Sur.", and Section 2. Legal Bases **1. Article 51 of PD 1067, 2. PD 705, 3. Local Government Code, 4. Aquino vs. Municipality of Aklan, 5. DILG Opinion on Matugas v. Barbers, 6. Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Surigao Del Sur No.155-25, Series of 2025 Section 5 par. (d), 7. RA 7586 (NIPAS Act, as amended by RA 11038) – for biodiversity protection. 8. RA 9275 (Philippine Clean Water Act of 2004) – for water quality preservation, and 9. RA 9003 (Ecological Solid Waste Management Act).**

SB Committee Chairman on Tourism, Hon. Tejol, explained also in Section 3. Declaration of Policy, which is to **Protect**: Preserve the Hubason River's natural beauty, **Promote**: Encourage sustainable and responsible tourism, and **Regulate**: Control development in the area to ensure the long-term sustainability. And, Section 4. This Ordinance shall apply to the Hubason River Resort and Adventure Trail, including all waters, banks, trails, easements, and adjacent lands within forty (40) meters (forestlands) and twenty (20) meters (titled lands) from its demarcated boundaries, as determined by the Municipal Environment and Natural Resources Office and the Municipal Assessors Office.

SB Committee Vice-Chairman on Tourism, Hon. Estrada, explained Section 5. Definition of Terms. Like, **Core Protection Zone (CPZ)**: A strictly protected area where no building is allowed, **Easement Buffer Zone (EBZ)**: A vegetated area along the river that must be kept free of permanent structures, **Multiple Use Zone (MUZ)**: An area for low-impact, regulated activities like eco-tourism, **Tourism/Environmental Zone**: An area for sustainable tourism that protects the environment, **Adjacent Areas**: Lands next to the area covered by the ordinance, **Incompatible Construction**: Any building or activity that harms the environment or tourism, and **Notice of Violation (NOV)**: A formal document issued for breaking the rules of the building code or this ordinance.

SB Committee Chairman on Environment, Hon. Valeroso explained Section 6. Declaration of the Hubason River area as a **Tourism and Environmental Protection Zone** managed by the Municipality of Carmen. **Regulated Allowed Uses (MUZ only)**: Low-impact facilities like signs and view decks, Guided trail operations with trained guides, Research, education, and guided tours, and Maintenance for public safety.

SB Committee Chairman on Appropriations, Hon. Escuyos, explained the four (4) sections in the ordinance. Section 7. Moratorium on Incompatible Constructions. A moratorium is in effect, **prohibiting all incompatible construction** within the Hubason River's designated zone.

This includes:

- Industrial facilities
- Commercial buildings that block river access
- Structures that damage riverbanks or alter water flow
- Any structure built within 20 meters (titled lands) and 40 meters (forestland) of the water easements

This ban will remain in place until the Sangguniang Bayan (Municipal Council) officially lifts it, based on recommendations from the Municipal Tourism Council and the MENRO.

Section 8. Regulatory Acts:

All new development or construction in the protected zone must follow a strict process. Before starting any project, you must secure the following:

- a) **Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA)**, if applicable, in accordance with DENR and EMB guidelines;
- b) Prior **clearance** from the Municipal Environment and Natural Resources Office (MENRO) and the Municipal Tourism Office;
- c) Approval of a **Development Permit** by the Sangguniang Bayan;
- d) Securing a **Building Permit** from the Office of the Building Official/Engineering Office;
- e) Updated **Tax Declaration** duly issued by the Municipal Assessor's Office (MASSO and PASSO);
- f) **Alienable and Disposable (A&D) Land Certification** or related certification from the Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR), if applicable;
- g) **Zoning Clearance** from the Municipal Planning and Development Coordinator/Zoning Officer;
- h) **Business Permit** from the Municipal Mayor's Office if the proposed development involves commercial operations.

Section 9. Prohibitory Acts:

- 1) Construction of any cottages, houses, resorts, or other permanent/temporary structures without LGU permit;
- 2) Cutting, gathering, or destruction of trees, shrubs, and other vegetation;
- 3) Dumping of solid waste, sewage, or toxic chemicals;
- 4) Quarrying, mining, or extraction of sand, gravel, and other resources;

- 5) Poaching, hunting, or killing of wildlife;
- 6) Use of destructive fishing practices or alteration of riverbanks;

Any other act that may degrade water quality, endanger biodiversity, or destroy the natural beauty of the area.

Hon. Escuyos also explained in Section 10. Penalties.

First Offense	- Fine of One Thousand Pesos (Php1,000.00) and written warning
Second Offense	- Fine of One Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (Php1,500.00) and demolition/removal of the illegal structure or cessation of the prohibited activity at the violator's expense
Third and Subsequent Offenses	- Fine of Two Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (Php2,500.00), demolition/removal of the illegal structure, cancellation of business permit (if applicable), and/or imprisonment of up to six (6) months, subject to the discretion of the court.

SB Committee Chairman on Infrastructure, Hon. Bigno, explained in Section 11. Summary demolition of illegal of unauthorized structure. In furtherance of the objectives of this Ordinance and pursuant to Section 444(b) (3) (vi) of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the "Local Government Code of 1991, the Local Chief Executive is hereby authorized to order the summary removal and demolition of any structure, improvement, or encroachment. Followed by, Section 12. Procedure for Summary demolition, The following procedure shall govern the enforcement of summary demolition of illegal or unauthorized structures within the Hubason River Resort and Adventure Trail Tourism and Environmental Protection Zone, consistent with the Local Government Code of 1991 (RA 7160) and the National Building Code of the Philippines (PD 1096):

1. **Inspection and Documentation**
2. **Issuance of Notice of Violation (NOV)**
3. **Voluntary Compliance Period**
4. **Issuance of Demolition Order**
5. **Implementation of Demolition**
6. **Special Cases for Immediate Demolition**
7. **Cost Recovery**
8. **Record-Keeping**

Section 13. Implementing Agency, The Municipal Tourism Office, in coordination with the MENRO, Municipal Engineering Office, and the Philippine National Police, shall be responsible for the implementation and enforcement of this Ordinance.

After all the speakers presented all the sections of the proposed Ordinance, the Emcee Ms. Rachel Ontolan asked the public for any questions and deliberation.

QUESTIONS FROM THE PUBLIC:

Person No. 1. (Lyn-Lyn Quinto): Asked and clarified Hon. Tejol on Section 4 the 20 meters and 40 meters forestlands of the water easements?

ANSWER: Hon. Escuyos answered kon an imo lupa titled, 20 meters beyond you can construct, bali mo bilang kaw nan 20 meters, ug ma comply sab nimo ang mga requirements.

Person No. 1. (Lyn-Lyn Quinto): said tungod sa walay protection didto sa Hubason, never kami makapanamastamas na stress ako tungod ka yang mga basura didto nagkalat ra, dapat unta botangan didto paingon sa bukid nan notice o signage o "bawal maglabay ug basura". She expressed appreciation nga naa ni nga ordinansa para pag protect didto na area?

Person No. 2. Asked sa among yuta sa Hubason naa kami falcata nga gitanum pwedi na namo putlon?

ANSWER: Hon. Vice Mayor Jane V. Plaza said kon naay inyo mga falcata didto na gusto ninyo ipaputol pwedi nato na e-report sa MENRO ug DENR.

ANSWER: CENRO Cantilan answered pwedi kamo mukuha sa amo ug permit sa pagputol o cutting permit.

OPINION: Mr. Yu nahadlok kami dili kami tugutan pag construct.

ANSWER: Hon. Escuyos answered dli i-expropriate imo lupa ayaw kabero naa may ato 20 meters easement.

Mr. Yu nagpasalamat sa pagtubag sa iya opinion.

ANSWER: Vice Mayor Jane V. Plaza said kadtong mga title holder dili ta pwedi mag construct 20 meters welcome po kayo mag baligya naa may phase 2 priority kamo, you are welcome po.

Person No. 3: Asked parehas sa amo nag negosyo kami sa entrance nan Hubason River Resort mukuha paba kami ug permit?

ANSWER: Hon. Escuyos answered basta mag negosyo kamo mukuha jud kamo ug permit, dakan ma legal ang inyo negosyo.

ANSWER: Hon. Vice Mayor said actually amo na hisgotan meeting ato ipatawag ang concerned office.

ANSWER: Engr. Niko Josol mag construct ka for business purposes mukuha ka ug permit.

Person No. 3: asked gamay raman ang amo negosyo dapat priority kami didto.

ANSWER: Engr. Niko Josol answered priority ang land owner.

Person No. 4: asked kon naa ba benipisyo ang mga IPs na ikasaad sa amo sa Hubason?

ANSWER: Hon. Vice Mayor Jane V. Plaza answered years ago naa tay pulong-pulong particularly CADT 115, sa karon wala pa kay wala pa man ang adventure trail.

Person No. 1: Lyn-Lyn Quinto hangyo kami residenti dili kami mobayad sa entrance kay kada adlaw mi naa didto?

ANSWER: Hon. Vice mayor Jane V. Plaza answered ato ceguro himoan ug kasabotan sa mga owners ug isa ka area magbotang ug gate para inyo maagihan.

Person No. 5: Resing Boyhot said naa mi lupa wala matitolohi pero naa mi declaration.

ANSWER: Hon. Vice Mayor Jane V. Plaza answered kahibayo na ta sa ordinance kon tax declaration 40 meters easement, sa 40 meters kami pag protector. After sa 40 meters sa lupa bisan pa cottages lain-lain comply jud requirements sa LGU.

Person No. 5. Resing Boyhot asked bahin sa mga motor sa karsada kay hamok nabangga ug dapat naay parking area sa Hubason.

ANSWER: Hon. Vice Mayor Jane V. Plaza answered Barangay council dapat speed limit sa dalan sa mga sakyanan.

Person No. 5. Resing Boyhot suggested naay dapat ordinance kanang magbuyad sa karsada?

ANSWER: Hon. Escuyos answered national law kana dili ta pwedi mag buyad sa karsada.


