

**WHEREAS**, the proposed Annual Investment Plan outlines strategic programs, projects, and activities that align with the overall Disaster Risk Reduction and Management framework of the Local Government, ensuring effective and efficient fund utilization;

**WHEREAS**, the 13<sup>th</sup> Sangguniang Bayan Members of Carmen, Surigao del Sur, after due deliberation, finds the proposed LDRRM Trust Fund Annual Investment Plan for CY 2025 to be necessary and beneficial in strengthening disaster preparedness and response mechanisms within the locality;


