

AN ORDINANCE PRESCRIBING THE PRIORITIZATION AND COMMITMENT TO PANTAWID PAMILYANG PILIPINO EXITED AND GRADUATED HOUSEHOLDS IN THE DELIVERY OF SERVICES THROUGH THE ADOPTION OF THE CONVERGENCE PROVISIONS OF RA 11310 IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF SAN MIGUEL

Explanatory Note

WHEREAS, Section 2 of Republic Act No. 11310, also known as the "Pantawid Pamilyang Pilipino Program Act," mandates the institutionalization of the 4Ps program, aiming to reduce poverty and promote inclusive growth through investment in human capital;

WHEREAS, the Municipality of San Miguel recognizes its role in the implementation of RA 11310, particularly in extending support to exited and graduated 4Ps households to sustain their progress towards self-sufficiency and improved living conditions;

WHEREAS, Section 9 of RA 11310 underscores the convergence strategy for delivering sustainable services, requiring local government units (LGUs) to coordinate with national agencies, private stakeholders, and civic organizations to address the socio-economic needs of 4Ps beneficiaries;

WHEREAS, the Municipality of San Miguel acknowledges the importance of prioritizing these households in various municipal programs, projects, and services to ensure the continuity of assistance and address vulnerabilities experienced by exited and graduated 4Ps families;

WHEREAS, this ordinance aligns with the mandate to uphold the dignity and welfare of all constituents by enhancing access to livelihood, health, education, and other socio-economic services for exited and graduated households;

NOW THEREFORE,

Be it ordained by the Sangguniang Bayan of San Miguel, Surigao del Sur in session assembled, that:

SECTION 1. Title. This ordinance shall be known as the "Pantawid Pamilya Convergence and Commitment Ordinance of San Miguel."

SECTION 2. Declaration of Policy. In accordance with the provisions of Republic Act No. 11310 or the "Pantawid Pamilyang Pilipino Program Act," the Municipality of San Miguel recognizes its duty to provide sustainable support and promote the well-being of Pantawid Pamilya Pilipino Program (4Ps) households that have exited or graduated from the program. The Municipality commits to implementing measures that will ensure these families are prioritized in accessing services, resources, and programs to improve their socio-economic conditions.

SECTION 3. Objectives. This ordinance aims to:

- a. Prioritize the delivery of municipal services to exited and graduated 4Ps households.
- b. Establish a convergence framework to align municipal programs with the needs of these households.
- c. Promote self-reliance and sustainable development for 4Ps households through targeted interventions.

SECTION 4. Definition of Terms. For purposes of this ordinance, the following terms are defined:

- a. Pantawid Pamilyang Pilipino Program (4Ps): A conditional cash transfer program of the national government aimed at poverty reduction and social development.
- b. Exited Households: Families that no longer qualify for the 4Ps due to improved socio-economic conditions or the completion of program conditions.
- c. Graduated Households: Families that have completed the 4Ps program and are recognized for achieving program objectives.
- d. Convergence: The integration and coordination of municipal programs to maximize the delivery of services to exited and graduated 4Ps households.

SECTION 5. Prioritization of Exited and Graduated Households:

- a. The Municipality of San Miguel shall prioritize exited and graduated 4Ps households in accessing municipal services, including but not limited to:
 - i. Livelihood and employment programs.
 - ii. Educational assistance and scholarships.
 - iii. Health and nutrition services.
 - iv. Housing and shelter programs.
 - v. Agricultural and micro-enterprise support.
- b. All municipal departments are directed to ensure that their respective programs are accessible to exited and graduated 4Ps households.

SECTION 6. Convergence Framework. The Municipality shall adopt a convergence approach in program implementation, which includes:

- a. Coordinating with relevant national government agencies, such as the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD) and the Department of Labor and Employment (DOLE).



- b. Developing partnerships with private sector stakeholders, non-government organizations, and civic groups to enhance service delivery.
- c. Establishing a monitoring and evaluation mechanism to track the progress of exited and graduated households.

SECTION 7. Implementation and Funding. The implementation of this ordinance shall be facilitated by the Municipal Social Welfare and Development Office (MSWDO) in coordination with other municipal offices. Funding for the programs shall be sourced from:

- a. The Municipal General Fund.
- b. Grants, donations, and other available resources.

SECTION 8. Penalty Clause. Non-compliance by any municipal department or official with the provisions of this ordinance shall be subject to administrative sanctions, as may be determined by applicable laws and regulations.

SECTION 9. Separability Clause. If any provision of this ordinance is declared invalid or unconstitutional, the remaining provisions shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 10. Effectivity. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon approval and publication in accordance with the Local Government Code of 1991.
