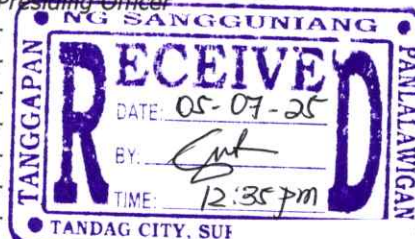

**AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE SALE, DISTRIBUTION, AND
CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES BY MINORS AND IMPOSING
PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF**

Be it enacted by the Sangguniang Bayan of Lingig, Surigao del Sur:

SECTION 1. TITLE. This Ordinance shall be known as the “Lingig
Alcoholic Beverage Regulation for Minors Ordinance.”

SECTION 2. DECLARATION OF POLICY. It is hereby declared a policy
of the Municipality of Lingig to protect the welfare of minors by regulating access
to alcoholic beverages and preventing underage drinking, which can lead to
negative social and health consequences.



SECTION 3. DEFINITION OF TERMS. For purposes of this Ordinance, the following terms shall be defined as follows:

- a. *Minor* – Any person below eighteen (18) years of age.
- b. *Liquor or Intoxicating Drink* – Any alcoholic beverage such as but not limited to beer, wine, whiskey, gin, rum, vodka, brandy, and other similar beverages containing more than 0.5% alcohol by volume.
- c. *Retailer* – Any individual, establishment, or entity engaged in the sale or distribution of alcoholic beverages.
- d. *Public Places* – Includes streets, plazas, parks, markets, schools, churches, public transportation terminals, government offices, and any other places open to the public.

SECTION 4. PROHIBITED ACTS. The following acts are hereby prohibited:

- a. Selling, serving, or distributing liquor or intoxicating drinks to minors.
- b. Allowing minors to purchase, possess, or consume alcoholic beverages within any establishment or public place.
- c. Drinking or consuming alcoholic beverages by minors in public places, whether alone or in the company of others.
- d. Any person of legal age aiding or abetting a minor in acquiring, possessing, or consuming liquor or intoxicating drinks.

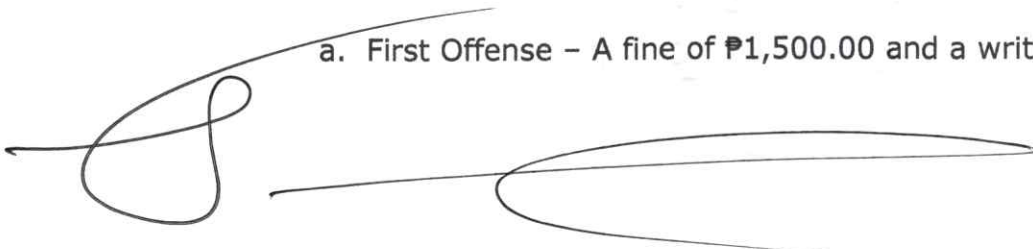
SECTION 5. EXEMPTIONS. This Ordinance shall not apply in the following cases:

- a. The use of alcoholic beverages for religious or medicinal purposes, provided that such use is prescribed by a recognized religious or medical authority.
- b. The presence of a minor in an establishment selling liquor, provided they are accompanied by a parent or legal guardian and are not consuming such beverages.

SECTION 6. PENALTIES. Any person found violating this Ordinance shall be penalized as follows:

1. For Retailers or Establishments:

- a. First Offense – A fine of ₱1,500.00 and a written warning.



- b. Second Offense – A fine of ₱2,000.00 and suspension of business permit for thirty (30) days.
- c. Third Offense – A fine of ₱2,500.00, revocation of business permit, and prohibition from reapplying for one (1) year.

2. For Minors Found Drinking in Public Places:

- a. First Offense – Written warning and notification of parents or guardians.
- b. Second Offense – Community service for three (3) days and attendance in a seminar on the effects of alcohol consumption.
- c. Third and Subsequent Offenses – Community service for five (5) days and referral to the Municipal Social Welfare and Development Office (MSWDO) for appropriate intervention.

3. For Adults Aiding Minors:

- a. First Offense – A fine of ₱1,500.00 or community service for three (3) days.
- b. Second Offense – A fine of ₱2,000.00 and community service for five (5) days.
- c. Third and Subsequent Offenses – A fine of ₱2,500.00 and imprisonment of up to thirty (30) days, subject to court discretion.

SECTION 7. IMPLEMENTING AGENCIES. The implementation of this Ordinance shall be the responsibility of the Municipal Mayor through the Philippine National Police (PNP), Barangay Officials, and the Municipal Business Permit and Licensing Office. Regular monitoring and enforcement shall be conducted to ensure compliance.

SECTION 8. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. If any provision of this Ordinance is declared invalid or unconstitutional, the remaining provisions shall not be affected and shall continue to be in full force and effect.

SECTION 9. REPEALING CLAUSE. All ordinances, rules, and regulations inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 10. EFFECTIVITY. This Ordinance shall take effect after ten (10) days from the date of posting following Section 59 of RA 7160.
