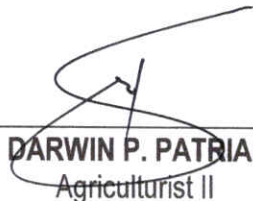

Section 8 Separability Clause. Should any part of this Memorandum of Agreement (MoA) be judicially declared null and void, such nullity shall not affect the validity of the remaining provisions hereof.

Section 9 Breach of Contract. The violation or omission of any of the provisions of this Agreement shall be ground for the cancellation or rescission of the same without need for legal or court action.
