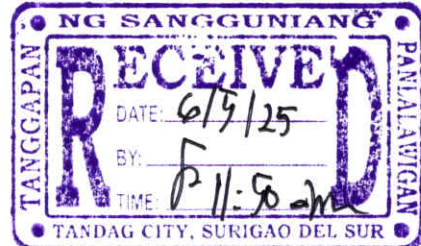

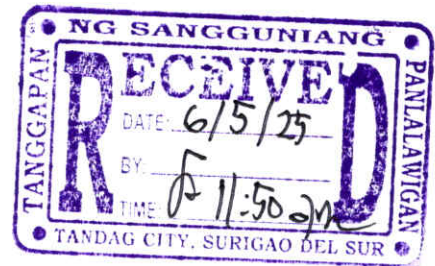

“ENDORISING THE CITY OF BISLIG SUPPLEMENTAL ANNUAL INVESTMENT PROGRAM (AIP) NO. 4 FOR CALENDAR YEAR (CY) 2025 TO THE SANGGUNIAN PANLUNGSOD (SP) FOR APPROVAL”

WHEREAS, Section 287 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, provides that local development councils shall assist the corresponding *sanggunian* in setting the direction of economic and social development, and coordinating development efforts within their territorial jurisdiction;

WHEREAS, Section 305 (c) of the same Code states that the Annual Investment Program (AIP) shall be the basis for the preparation of the annual budget of the local government unit (LGU), which includes programs, projects, and activities (PPAs) aligned with the approved development plans;

WHEREAS, the City Government of Bislig, through the City Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office (CDRRMO), proposed a Supplemental AIP No. 4 for CY 2025, amounting to Twenty-Seven Million Nine Hundred Forty Thousand Pesos (PhP27,940,000.00) to fund urgent and strategic PPAs in support of the city’s disaster preparedness, response, and resilience programs;
