





ORDINANCE NO. 23-25



**AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING COASTAL BARANGAYS IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF CAGWAIT TO CONDUCT A COMMUNITY-BASED COASTAL CLEAN-UP ACTIVITY EVERY THIRD (3<sup>RD</sup>) SATURDAY OF THE MONTH:**

**WHEREAS**, Section 16 of Article II of the 1987 Philippine Constitution states that the State shall protect and advance the right of the people to a balanced and healthful; ecology in accord with the rhythm and harmony of nature;

**WHEREAS**, Local Government Units (LGUs), through the Environment and Natural Resources Office, have the power and function to take active participation in all efforts concerning water quality protection and rehabilitation wherein excessive garbage has polluted seas and rivers resulting in contamination and water pollution;

**WHEREAS**, coastal environment in general are part of a healthy and functioning ecosystems of the municipality of Cagwait;

**WHEREAS**, there are many establishments operating in and families who are living along the coastal areas of this municipality;

**WHEREAS**, there is a need to save the bodies of water as well as coastal areas in the municipality of Cagwait by conducting a monthly clean-up activity and capacity building workshops for the establishments operating and residents living along the coastal areas;

**WHEREAS**, Presidential Proclamation NO. 470, series of 2003 was issued by the President declaring the Third Saturday of September of each year as the International Coastal Clean-up (ICC) Day in observance of the Global Coastal Clean-up Celebrations;

**WHEREAS**, Section 447 (a) (1) (vi) of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, grants the Sangguniang Bayan the power to approve ordinances which shall protect the environment and impose appropriate penalties for acts which endanger the environment, such as dynamite fishing and other forms of destructive fishing, illegal logging and smuggling of logs, smuggling of natural resource products and of endangered species of flora and fauna, slash and burn farming and such other activities which result in pollution, acceleration of eutrophication of rivers and lakes or of ecological imbalance;

**WHEREAS**, Section 389, par. (b) of the Local Government Code of 1991 further states that for efficient and effective economical governance, the purpose of which is the general welfare of the barangay and its inhabitants pursuant to Section 16 of the LGC, the barangay shall enforce laws and regulations relating to pollution control and protection of the environment;

**WHEREAS**, requiring all Barangays in coastal areas in the Municipality of Cagwait to conduct a community-based coastal clean-up activity once a month shall be instrument in promoting the significance of attaining ecological balance for a healthy environment;

**NOW THEREFORE:**

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Sangguniang Bayan of the Municipality of Cagwait, Province of Surigao del Sur in session assembled, that:

**SECTION 1. Short Title.** This Ordinance shall be known, in brevity, as ***"Cagwait Coastal Clean-up Ordinance or 3C's Ordinance of 2025"***

**SECTION 2. Declaration of Policy.** The Municipality of Cagwait, Province of Surigao del Sur adheres to the principles that Local Government Units share with the National Government the responsibility in the management and maintenance of ecological balance within their territorial jurisdiction. It also adheres on the sustainable development and environmental responsibility and recognizes the right of the people to a balanced and healthful ecology.

**SECTION 3. Definition of Terms.** As used in this Ordinance, the following terms shall mean as follows:

- a) ***Coastal Area*** – an area of Land that is affected in various ways by its closeness to the sea together with the area of sea that is affected by being close to human activities on and from the land;
- b) ***Coastal Water*** – includes the area from a line approximating the mean high water along the mainland or island as far out as twelve (12) nautical miles including the bays, harbors and sounds;
- c) ***Barangay Ecological Precinct*** – a group that shall convene and uphold the given functions under Section 6 of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 4. Synchronized Coastal Clean-up.** A synchronized Coastal Clean-up shall be done by all the Coastal Barangays in the Municipality of Cagwait every third (3<sup>rd</sup>) Saturday of the month.

**SECTION 5. Creation of Barangay Ecological Precinct (BEP)** – The Barangay Ecological Precinct is hereby created which is composed of, but not limited to the following:

**SECTION 6. Functions of the Barangay Ecological Precincts (BEP).** The functions of the BEP are the following:

- Oversee the cleanliness and sanitation of the coastal areas within their respective jurisdiction;
- Organize, train and deputize "Ecological Warriors" or "Bantay Palibot" in coordination with the Bantay Dagat Task Force, Municipal Environment and natural Resources Office (MENRO) and the Department of Environment and natural Resources (DENR);
- Spearhead in the conduct of community-based coastal clean-up activities; and
- Coordinate with the MENRO, other government organization and private organizations (POs) or Non-Government Organizations (NGOs) with regards to their activity in cleaning the coastal areas, collection and inventory of wastes taken from the coastal areas and the delivery to sanitary landfill/Material Recovery Facility.

**SECTION 7. Adopt a Coastal Area.** Any establishment, school or barangay along a coastal area must be responsible for its solid waste disposal and management. The Barangay Ecological Precinct (BEP) shall initiate a community-based coastal clean-up activity which will be undertaken every third (3<sup>rd</sup>) Saturday of the month, which will be participated by:

- All commercial and resorts establishments located in the immediate coastal areas;
- All schools located in the immediate coastal area;
- All barangays located in immediate coastal area in all coastal barangays in the municipality;
- Other volunteer POs, NGOs and government agencies present in the area, and
- All 4Ps Beneficiaries in the coastal areas.

**SECTION 8. Maintaining the Cleanliness and Sanitation of the Coastline.** Resort owners, lot owners and households along the coastlines shall maintain the cleanliness of their respective coastline every day.

**SECTION 9. Prohibitions.** It shall be unlawful for any person or establishment to discharge or cause the disposal of any untreated waste water, sludge, oil, grease, chemical, human or animal waste, plastics and containers or other waste to any part of the municipality that will endanger the environmental condition of its coastal areas.

**SECTION 10. Penalties.** Any individual or establishment who violates Section 9 of this Ordinance shall be liable of the following administrative fines and penalties:

- First Offense** – a fine of One Thousand (P1,000.00) Pesos and reprimand/warning;
- Second Offense** – a fine of Two Thousand (P2,000.00) Pesos;
- Third Offense** – a fine of Two Thousand Five Hundred (P2,500.00) Pesos and revocation/cancellation of Business or Mayor's Permit in the case of business establishments.



If the violator is a minor, the corresponding fine shall be paid by his/her parent or guardian.

If the violator is a juridical person, the President or CEO or owner shall be liable to pay the corresponding penalty.

If the violator failed to pay the administrative fine within seven (7) days from receipt of Citation Ticket, the person authorized to implement/enforce this Ordinance shall refer the matter to the PNP=MPS and/or prosecutor's office for filing of appropriate charges against violator.

**SECTION 11. Compliance with the Coastal Clean-up Activity.** Every coastal barangay hall ensure compliance with community-based coastal clean-up activity every Third (3<sup>rd</sup>) Saturday of the month. Failure to do so without justifiable reason shall be a reasonable ground for the filing of appropriate administrative case against concerned barangay officials.

**SECTION 12. Collection of Fines.** The Municipal Treasurer of Barangay Treasurer is hereby deputized to collect and issue Official Receipt (OR) for the corresponding fines that maybe paid by the violator. The amount collected in the enforcement of this Ordinance shall be shared by the following:

- Enforcer/s - 40%
- Barangay - 40%
- Municipality - 20%

**SECTION 13. Persons Authorized to Implement/Enforce this Ordinance.** The Philippine national Police – Municipal Police Station (PNP-MPS), Cagwait Law Enforcement Unit (CLEU), Punong Barangays and Barangay Kagawad in charge of the Committee on Environment, MENR Officer and his authorized representatives are deputized enforcers and are authorized to implement and enforce this Ordinance. They shall issue Citation Ticket to person/s violating this Ordinance in coordination with the Barangay Secretary who shall maintain a logbook showing the person/s who violated this Ordinance. The Barangay Secretary shall submit a Monthly Report to the MENRO in the violation of this Ordinance and the data on the Coastal Clean-up Activities.


**SECTION 14. Funding.** The Municipal Government of Cagwait shall allocate an initial fund of One Hundred Thousand (P100,000.00) pesos for the smooth implementation and enforcement of this Ordinance. For succeeding years, the MENRO shall incorporate in its annual office budget the funds not less than One Hundred Thousand (P100,000.00) Pesos for continuous implementation/enforcement of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 15. Information-Education Campaign.** The MENR Officer will spearhead the information-education campaign in coordination with the Municipal Information Officer/Designate, Municipal Tourism Office and all coastal barangays in the municipality.

**SECTION 16. Incentives.** The Municipal Government will give incentives/awards to the Barangay with the cleanest coastal area. IN this respect, a search for the cleanest coastal barangay shall be done every year which shall be awarded during the celebration of the Environment Month.

**SECTION 17. Implementing Rules.** The MENRO in coordination with the Chairman-SB Committee on Environment and Natural Resources, President – Liga ng mga Barangay, Municipal Tourism Office and representatives from PENRO shall formulate within sixty (60) days from its effectivity, the rules necessary to implement/enforce this Ordinance.

**SECTION 18. Oversight Committee.** The MENRO shall spearhead the implementation of this Ordinance. It shall submit a semestral report to the Office of the Mayor. Copy furnished the Chair, SB Committee on Environment & natural Resources as to the status of implementation of this Ordinance for its oversight function.



**SECTION 19. Separability Clause.** If any provision of this Ordinance is declared invalid, the remainder or any other provisions not affected thereby shall remain in full force and effect.

**SECTION 20. Repealing Clause.** Any existing ordinance, executive orders and issuances including rules and regulations inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed, amended or modified accordingly.

**SECTION 21. Effectivity.** This Ordinance shall take effect fifteen (15) days following its posting in three (3) conspicuous places in the municipality and all coastal barangays.

**MINUTES OF THE PUBLIC HEARING OF THE PROPOSED ORDINANCE OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF CAGWAIT ON AUGUST 13, 2025 AT BARANGAY TRAINING CENTER, UNIDAD, CAGWAIT, SURIGAO DEL SUR AT 8:30 IN THE MORNING:**

**I CALL TO ORDER**

Hon. Tabugoc, Chairman, Committee on Rules, Laws and Ordinances called to order at exactly 9:00 O'clock in the morning.

**II NATIONAL ANTHEM**

The national anthem was sung, through audio visual.

**III INVOCATION**

Hon. Estrada led the invocation.

**IV OPENING MESSAGE**

Barangay Captain Joseph E. Estrada give his welcome message.

**V ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF PARTICIPANTS**

Mrs. Yanto acknowledged the Sangguniang Bayan Members and staff of the SB Secretary to the public.

**VI RATIONALE OF THE PROPOSED ORDINANCE**

Hon. Tabugoc, Chair of the Committee on Rules, Laws and Ordinances give the rationale of seven (7) ordinances.

**VII MESSAGE**

Hon. Tuscano give his message to the public and overview of the ordinances.

**VIII PRESENTATION OF PROPOSED ORDINANCES**

- a) **An Ordinance establishing the Institutional Mechanisms for Trafficking in persons Protection and Support pursuant to the provisions of Republic Act No. 9208, otherwise known as the "Anti-Trafficking in Persons Act of 2003", as amended by Republic Act No. 10364 or the Expanded Anti-Trafficking in Persons Act of 2012 and for other purposes.**

Hon. Lozada presented the proposed ordinance page by page. He explained further.

After the presentation, Hon. Lozada declared for any comment, suggestion and insertion to the proposed ordinance presented.

**OPEN FORUM:**

Mr. Nick Lozada said, there is an establishment here in our place that the hired child labor. My question is how many hours that child labor working.

Ms. Yanto, answered it is only 8 hours working in one establishment, no overtime.

Hon. Lozada said Mrs. Yanto is a focal person of the DOLE, she knows all about the child labor.

Mr. Luengas said in Section 4 there is an specific paragraph that only women works. How about the men it is not part of the organizations?

Ms. Corvera answered it is there in the VAWC rules that women and men.

Hon. Lozada asked, what is the pleasure of the body?

Mr. Nick Lozada moved for the adoption and approval duly seconded by Kag. Jed Taripe.

Hon. Lozada asked the body, as many as there are in favor of said measure? Please raise your right hand.

**In favor: 150**

**Against: 0**

The Chair declared that said measure is adopted and approved

**b) An Ordinance enacting the Revised Guidelines for Cockfighting, Establishment, Operation and maintenance of Cockpits and the Breeding of Gamecocks in the municipality of Cagwait, Surigao del Sur.**

Hon. Tabugoc presented to the body the proposed draft ordinance page by page. Then, He explained further.

After the presentation, Hon. Tabugoc declared for any comment, suggestion and insertion to the proposed ordinance presented?

Hon. Tabugoc asked, what is the pleasure of the body?

Kag. Custodio moved for the adoption and approval duly seconded by Kag. Ruiz and Kag. Reyes.

Hon. Tabugoc asked the body, as many as there are in favor of said measure? Please raise your right hand.

**In favor: 150**

**Against: 0**

The Chair declared that said measure is adopted and approved.

**c) An Ordinance imposing Rental and Fixing Rates on the use of Heavy Construction Equipments owned by the Municipality of Cagwait, Province of Surigao del Sur and for other purposes.**

Hon. Bayogbog presented to the body the proposed draft ordinance page by page. Then, He explained further.

After the presentation, Hon. Bayogbog declared for any comment, suggestion and insertion to the proposed ordinance presented?

**OPEN FORUM:**

Mr. Pepino said if possible the fuel is free for those who rent the heavy equipment.

Hon. Bayogbog answered the fuel and the labor of the driver is not included.

Mr. Pepino said if, I as a private person can rent those equipments.

Hon. Bayogbog answered yes, but you have to paid 20% of the rental.

Kag. Ruiz said, if the barangay will use the equipment they will not pay the rental.

Hon. Bayogbog said if the equipment is damaged the barangay will be the responsible to repair.

Engr. Cuarez said the rental of this heavy equipment is for the maintenance not put in the treasury. Then, He explained further.

Mr. Nozarez said consider the Barangay will pay 40% for the rental.

Hon. Bayogbog said, it's up to the Municipal Government.

Mr. Pepino asked, if the private person will rent the heavy equipment the rental will be reduce.

Engr. Cuarez answered, no because this is the standard rate for heavy equipment.

Mr. Idjao said in other places, if I will be the one to rent the heavy equipment the fuel is free to those who rent the equipment.

Engr. Cuarez answered that place is a first class municipality they can give a free fuel to client.

Hon. Bayogbog asked, what is the pleasure of the body?

Mr. Nozares moved for the adoption and approval duly seconded by Mr. Silagan.

Hon. Bayogbog asked the body, as many as there are in favor of said measure? Please raise your right hand.

In favor: 150

The Chair declared that said measure is adopted and approved.

**d) An Ordinance requiring coastal barangays in the Municipality of Cagwait to conduct a Community-Based Coastal Clean-up activity every third (3<sup>rd</sup>) Saturday of the month.**

Hon. Loma presented to the body the proposed draft ordinance page by page. Then, He explained further.

After the presentation, Hon. Loma declared for any comment, suggestion and insertion to the proposed ordinance presented?

**OPEN FORUM:**

Kag. Balacuit said in our barangay Bitaugan West is always conducting a kalinisan sa barangay every week as a program of our President.

Hon. Loma said kalinisan sa barangay is the program of our President, but this is the ordinance of our municipality that every 3<sup>rd</sup> week of the month is our clean up day.

Mr. Balacuit answered Yes it's the program of our President.

Hon. Loma said we have to follow for what is in the ordinance, its only 3<sup>rd</sup> week of the month is the clean up activity. Then, He explained further to the public.

Kag. Taripe said the barangay Unidad is practising to clean once in a month in all areas of barangay. Then, He said that the request of the barangay council is to take out the garbage after the tagbo.

Hon. Loma answered noted. Then, He asked, what is the pleasure of the body?

Kag. Taripe moved for the adoption and approval duly seconded by Ms. Salgado.

Hon. Loma asked the body, as many as there are in favor of said measure? Please raise your right hand.

In favor: 150

Against: 0

The Chair declared that said measure is adopted and approved.

**e) An Ordinance institutionalizing the Clean-As-You-Go practice in Food Serving establishments and all public eating places in the Municipality of Cagwait, Province of Surigao del Sur, providing penalty for violations thereof and for other purposes.**

Hon. Estrada presented to the body the proposed draft ordinance page by page. Then, He explained further.

After the presentation, Hon. Estrada declared for any comment, suggestion and insertion to the proposed ordinance presented?

**OPEN FORUM:**

Kag. Sala said as for me I have a carenderia, what would I say to my customer about this ordinance.

Hon. Estrada said you would talk to your customer slowly and encouragement to the people of Cagwait of this CLAYGO ordinance.

Kag. Sala answered it's up to the owner of the carenderias to talk to the customer about this ordinance.

Hon. Estrada asked, what is the pleasure of the body?

Brgy. Capt. Leuterio moved for the adoption and approval duly seconded by Kag. Montalban and Mrs. Pizarras.

Hon. Estrada asked the body, as many as there are in favor of said measure? Please raise your right hand.

**f) An Ordinance enacting the Pet Animal Code of the Municipality of Cagwait, Province of Surigao del Sur providing penalties for violation thereof and for other purposes.**

Hon. Lozada said if this ordinance will be approved all of the prohibition of pet animals and the creation of the committee is there.

Hon. Lozada asked, what is the pleasure of the body?

Kag. Sala moved for the adoption and approval duly seconded by Brgy. Capt. Leuterio.

Hon. Lozada asked the body, as many as there are in favor of said measure? Please raise your right hand.

**g) An ordinance adopting the Paleng-QR PH Plus Program in the Municipality of Cagwait, Province of Surigao del Sur.**

In favor: 150



Hon. Tuscano give his message to the public and overview of the ordinances.

**VIII PRESENTATION OF PROPOSED ORDINANCES**

- d) **An Ordinance establishing the Institutional Mechanisms for Trafficking in persons Protection and Support pursuant to the provisions of Republic Act No. 9208, otherwise known as the “Anti-Trafficking in Persons Act of 2003”, as amended by Republic Act No. 10364 or the Expanded Anti-Trafficking in Persons Act of 2012 and for other purposes.**

Hon. Lozada presented the proposed ordinance page by page. He explained further.

After the presentation, Hon. Lozada declared for any comment, suggestion and insertion to the proposed ordinance presented.

**OPEN FORUM:**

Kag. Panto said there is an specific violation during the penalty impositions and we have to adopt the national laws.

Hon. Lozada answered is in section 15, the whole violations and impositions of ordinance.

Mrs. Corvera said the ordinance is correct, we have to adopt the local imposition of penalties.

Hon. Lozada asked, what is the pleasure of the body?

Kagawad Panto moved for the adoption and approval duly seconded by Kagawad Ferrer.

Hon. Lozada asked the body, as many as there are in favor of said measure? Please raise your right hand.

The Chair declared that said measure is adopted and approved

- e) An Ordinance enacting the Revised Guidelines for Cockfighting, Establishment, Operation and maintenance of Cockpits and the Breeding of Gamecocks in the municipality of Cagwait, Surigao del Sur.**

Hon. Tabugoc presented to the body the proposed draft ordinance page by page. Then, He explained further.

After the presentation, Hon. Tabugoc declared for any comment, suggestion and insertion to the proposed ordinance presented?

**OPEN FORUM:**

Kag. Climaco asked, before we apply a cockpit arena. The requirement is to settle the owner of the land to construct a cockpit arena.

Hon. Tabugoc answered, yes it is in section 10 letter (b) you can read.

Kag. Acup asked, during the cockpit the owner is complying permit for that purpose?

Hon. Tabugoc answered, yes.

Kag. Acup said I don't know if they are complying a barangay clearance before they are complying a permit in the municipal level

Hon. Lozada said actually all renewal permits and clearances they are all seeking a barangay clearance before they go to the municipal level to seek a permit. He said it is their in section 10 letter b of renewal of permit and franchise. Then, He explained further.

Hon. Tuscano said the cockpit arena is seeking a barangay clearance before he go to municipal level to have franchise.

Kag. Panto said, what is the significant form from the existing guidelines of the ordinance.

Hon. Lozada said before to start the year, there will be cockpit arena owner to have a franchise because they will seeking a special permit for that purpose.

Kag. Panto said why we could not include in the ordinance for that purpose.

Hon. Lozada said, it is in section 30.

Hon. Tabugoc asked, what is the pleasure of the body?

Kag. Plaza moved for the adoption and approval duly seconded by Kag. Tabugoc.

Hon. Tabugoc asked the body, as many as there are in favor of said measure? Please raise your right hand.

In favor: 90

Against: 0

The Chair declared that said measure is adopted and approved.

**f) An Ordinance imposing Rental and Fixing Rates on the use of Heavy Construction Equipments owned by the Municipality of Cagwait, Province of Surigao del Sur and for other purposes.**

Hon. Bayogbog presented to the body the proposed draft ordinance page by page. Then, He explained further.

After the presentation, Hon. Bayogbog declared for any comment, suggestion and insertion to the proposed ordinance presented?

**OPEN FORUM:**

Kag. Panto said when the barangay government will used the equipment, why not reduce to 50% the rental discount.

Mr. Cuarez answered it depends upon the municipal officials for their studies of this rental equipment.

Mr. Vertical asked, I as private person, can I rent the equipment to LGU.

Hon. Bayogbog answered, yes. But the rental is 20% from the rate.

Hon. Lozada said our heavy equipment is all constituent can rent.

Hon. Bayogbog asked, what is the pleasure of the body?

Kag. Panto moved for the adoption and approval duly seconded by Brgy. Capt. Adaya.

Hon. Bayogbog asked the body, as many as there are in favor of said measure? Please raise your right hand.

In favor: 90

Against: 0

The Chair declared that said measure is adopted and approved.

**d) An Ordinance requiring coastal barangays in the Municipality of Cagwait to conduct a Community-Based Coastal Clean-up activity every third (3<sup>rd</sup>) Saturday of the month.**

Hon. Loma presented to the body the proposed draft ordinance page by page. Then, He explained further.

After the presentation, Hon. Loma declared for any comment, suggestion and insertion to the proposed ordinance presented?

**OPEN FORUM:**

Kag. Panto clarified that the barangay have a clean up once in every 3 months or every quarter.

Hon. Loma said, we will adopt this ordinance as clean up day every 3<sup>rd</sup> Saturday of the month this is very important to our community. Then, he explained further.

Brgy. Capt. Adaya said this ordinance is good to our barangay to implement that every 3<sup>rd</sup> Saturday of the month is a clean up day.

Hon. Loma asked, what is the pleasure of the body?

Brgy. Capt. Lozada moved for the adoption and approval duly seconded by Kag. Plaza.

Hon. Loma asked the body, as many as there are in favor of said measure? Please raise your right hand.

In favor: 90

Against: 0

The Chair declared that said measure is adopted and approved.

**h) An Ordinance institutionalizing the Clean-As-You-Go practice in Food Serving establishments and all public eating places in the Municipality of Cagwait, Province of Surigao del Sur, providing penalty for violations thereof and for other purposes.**

Hon. Estrada presented to the body the proposed draft ordinance page by page. Then, He explained further.

After the presentation, Hon. Estrada declared for any comment, suggestion and insertion to the proposed ordinance presented?

**OPEN FORUM:**

Kag. Panto said this ordinance is good but can be create a dispute between the owner and the customer.

Hon. Lozada said we have to discipline ourselves in eating in the carenderias or anywhere here in our place.

Hon. Estrada asked, what is the pleasure of the body?

Kag. Tabugoc moved for the adoption and approval duly seconded by Kag. Ferrer.

Hon. Estrada asked the body, as many as there are in favor of said measure? Please raise your right hand.

In favor: 90

The Chair declared that said measure is adopted and approved.

**i) An Ordinance enacting the Pet Animal Code of the Municipality of Cagwait, Province of Surigao del Sur providing penalties for violation thereof and for other purposes.**

Hon. Lozada presented to the body the proposed draft ordinance page by page. Then, He explained further.

After the presentation, Hon. Lozada declared for any comment, suggestion and insertion to the proposed ordinance presented?

**OPEN FORUM:**

Brgy. Capt. Adaya said we have to register the dog so that they can put a dog tag.

Mr. Palero said the office does not make a vaccine, if you did not register your dog in the office to have their dog tag. Then, he explained further.

Kag. Climaco said if the dog is vaccinated only not registered in the Agriculture Office. What will happen the dog?

Mr. Palero answered, it's okay that your dog is vaccinated. Then, he announce that next week we will have their massive registration for this dog tag.

Brgy. Capt. Lozada said in Bacolod they implement to catch the dog because they have their budget for the food of the dog in the dog pound but unfortunately the dog was died. I challenged the barangay to have a dog pound or dog tagging. Then, He explained further.

Hon. Lozada asked, what is the pleasure of the body?

Brgy. Capt. Adaya moved for the adoption and approval duly seconded by Brgy. Capt. Lozada.

Hon. Lozada asked the body, as many as there are in favor of said measure? Please raise your right hand.

In favor: 90

The Chair declared that said measure is adopted and approved.

**j) An ordinance adopting the Paleng-QR PH Plus Program in the Municipality of Cagwait, Province of Surigao del Sur.**
