A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE CY 2025 4TH SUPPLEMENTAL ANNUAL INVESTMENT PROGRAM (SAIP) OF THE CITY OF TANDAG AMOUNTING TO ONE HUNDRED ELEVEN MILLION THREE HUNDRED EIGHTEEN THOUSAND PESOS (P111,318,000.00)

WHEREAS, under Section 321 of the Local Government Code of 1991, it is provided that local government units may approve a supplemental budget during the fiscal year to address unforeseen events, such as calamities or emergencies, or when additional revenue sources become available, allowing for adjustments in the annual budget to meet immediate needs or new projects and programs;

WHEREAS, the City Development Council of Tandag has reviewed the proposed CY 2025 4th Supplemental Annual Investment Program (SAIP) submitted by the Local Finance Committee and concerned departments;

WHEREAS, the majority of the content of the proposed 4th SAIP consists of fund augmentations for various departments and offices of the Local Government Unit, primarily to cover obligations and operational requirements of departments with insufficient appropriations in the current budget;

WHEREAS, the 4th SAIP also includes the funding requirement for the implementation of the second tranche of the Salary Standardization, as well as MOOE augmentations for different departments, and the implementation and funding for the Service Recognition Incentive (SRI) and other personnel-related benefits;

WHEREAS, others included in the proposed 4th SAIP are allocations for year-end incentives, such as the assistance to be provided to barangay personnel including barangay councils, and other departmental incentives and obligations that must be incorporated within the appropriation to ensure proper and timely disbursement;

WHEREAS, the source of funds is derived from savings from the current appropriations of various offices under the General Fund amounting to ₱60,600,000.00; savings from the current appropriations of various offices under the Economic Enterprise amounting to ₱2,718,000.00; and cash savings amounting to ₱48,000,000.00, for a total available source of funds of ₱111,318,000.00;

WHEREAS, after due deliberation, the City Development Council finds the proposed CY 2025 4th SAIP to be responsive, necessary, and aligned with the City's development thrusts and priorities;

NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, that the City Development Council (CDC) of Tandag City approve the CY 2025 4th Supplemental Annual Investment Program (SAIP) of the City of Tandag Amounting To One Hundred Eleven Million Three Hundred Eighteen Thousand Pesos (₱111,318,000.00);


