

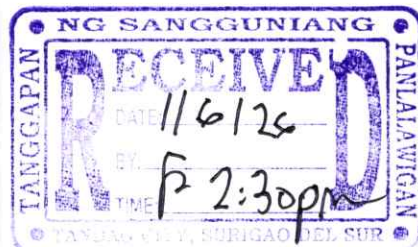

MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 24

Series of 2025

"AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE SALE, POSSESSION, AND USE OF FIREWORKS AND PYROTECHNIC DEVICES IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF MADRID, PROVINCE OF SURIGAO DEL SUR, AND PROVIDING PENALTIES THEREFOR."

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The Republic Act No. 9165, Republic Act No. 9514 (Fire Code of the Philippines), Executive Order No. 28, and related issuances regulate the manufacture, sale, and use of fireworks and pyrotechnic devices.

The injuries, fires, and public safety risks continue to be associated with the indiscriminate use of fireworks during holidays and special occasions.

The Local Government Code of 1991 (RA 7160) mandates local government units to enact measures that promote public safety, health, and general welfare;

The Municipality of Madrid seeks to ensure a safe and orderly celebration of festivities while minimizing risks to life and property;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Sangguniang Bayan of the Municipality of Madrid, Province of Surigao del Sur, that:

SECTION 1. TITLE. This Ordinance shall be known as the "Municipal Fireworks Regulation Ordinance of Madrid, Surigao del Sur."

SECTION 2. PURPOSE. This Ordinance aims to:

- Protect life, property, and the environment;
- Prevent firecracker-related injuries and fires;
- Regulate the sale and use of fireworks within the Municipality of Madrid;

- d. Promote safe and responsible celebration of festivities.

SECTION 3. DEFINITION OF TERMS

- a. Fireworks/Pyrotechnic Devices – Any device designed to produce visual, audible, or smoke effects through combustion or explosion.
b. Authorized Fireworks – Fireworks permitted under existing national laws and approved by the PNP.
c. Prohibited Fireworks – Fireworks banned under national laws and PNP regulations.
d. Designated Fireworks Display Area – Areas officially approved by the Municipal Mayor for fireworks display.

SECTION 4. PROHIBITED ACTS. The following acts are prohibited within the Municipality of Madrid:

- a. Selling fireworks without a valid Mayor's Permit, PNP clearance, and BFP inspection clearance;
b. Selling, possessing, or using prohibited fireworks;
c. Use of fireworks outside the designated areas and approved time schedule;
d. Use of fireworks by minors without adult supervision;
e. Use of fireworks while under the influence of alcohol or illegal drugs;
f. Manufacturing, repacking, or altering fireworks without authority.

SECTION 5. REGULATION OF SALE

- a. Sale of fireworks shall only be allowed to vendors with complete permits and clearances;
b. Selling period shall be limited from December 20 to December 31 of each year unless otherwise authorized;
c. Fireworks stalls shall not be located within 200 meters of schools, hospitals, churches, gasoline stations, and other high-risk areas.

SECTION 6. DESIGNATED AREAS AND TIME OF USE

- a. Fireworks display shall only be allowed in areas designated by the Municipal Mayor upon recommendation of the MDRRMO, PNP, and BFP;
b. Use of fireworks shall be allowed only from 6:00 PM of December 31 to 1:00 AM of January 1, except for officially sanctioned displays.

SECTION 7. ENFORCING AUTHORITIES

This Ordinance shall be jointly enforced by the:

- Philippine National Police (Madrid MPS)
- Bureau of Fire Protection – Madrid
- Municipal Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office (MDRRMO)
- Barangay Officials

SECTION 8. PENALTIES. Any person found violating this Ordinance shall be penalized as follows:

- a. First Offense – Fine of ₱1,000.00 and confiscation of fireworks;
b. Second Offense – Fine of ₱3,000.00 and/or imprisonment of not more than 30 days;
c. Third Offense – Fine of ₱5,000.00 and/or imprisonment of not more than 60 days,
without prejudice to prosecution under applicable national laws.

Business establishments may face suspension or revocation of business permits.

SECTION 9. DISPOSAL OF CONFISCATED FIREWORKS. All confiscated fireworks shall be turned over to the Bureau of Fire Protection (BFP) for proper handling and disposal.

SECTION 10. INFORMATION AND EDUCATION CAMPAIGN. The Municipal Government of Madrid shall conduct an information dissemination campaign through barangays, schools, and local media prior to the implementation of this Ordinance.

SECTION 11. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. If any provision of this Ordinance is declared unconstitutional or invalid, the remaining provisions shall continue to be in full force and effect.

SECTION 12. REPEALING CLAUSE. All ordinances, resolutions, rules, and regulations inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

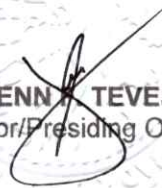
SECTION 13. EFFECTIVITY. This Ordinance shall take effect after posting and publication as required by law.
