Likewise, good morning to my distinguished colleagues and of course the amazing staff of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan and our visitors for today. For the Privilege Hour, may I have the honor Honorable Presiding Officer to ask that the following Members of this August Body be acknowledged and recognized to be given the floor to deliver their respective Privilege Speeches. First in line, would be the gentleman from down under, Hon. Henrich M. Pimentel, to be followed by the gentleman from Bislig City, Hon. Raul K. HON. H. PIMENTEL:

Thank you very much, Honorable Presiding Officer. Honorable Presiding Officer, my dear and esteemed colleagues in this August Chamber, good morning. If you can note in the schedule, I was asked earlier, if I have a Privilege Speech and my answer is in affirmative and the subject matter is only the present plight of our farmers, Honorable Presiding Officer. But when I arrived, I was handed with two (2) communications coming from the Office of the Governor and I would just like to dispense with this first, Honorable Presiding Officer. If I may read the letter, Honorable Presiding Officer?

HON. VICE GOVERNOR ALAMEDA, SR.:

Go ahead, please.

HON. H. PIMENTEL:

Letter from the Provincial Governor's Office dated July 16, 2025 addressed to the Honorable Members, Office of the Provincial Council, this Province thru Hon. Manuel O. Alameda, Sr., Vice Governor & Presiding Officer. Sir, greetings! May I request for the urgent passage of a Sangguniang Panlalawigan Ordinance for the formal establishment of Lingig Community Hospital. Attached please find a copy of the request of Dr. Julius E. Bastillada, M.D., APCHA, Chief of Lingig Community Hospital for your perusal. We are hoping for your immediate and favorable action on the matter. Truly your's, signed Johnny T. What is attached to the letter, was a letter of Chief of Hospital, Dr. Julius E. Bastillada addressed to the Honorable Governor and this precipitated the letter of the Honorable Governor for the urgent passage. Since, this is an Ordinance Honorable Presiding Officer, I cannot author an Ordinance right now without a draft and I even have to read first the letter of the Chief of Hospital. So if it pleases the Body, I would just like to refer the matter to the Committee on Laws and Justice and Human Rights, Honorable Presiding Officer.

Second, was again an indorsement coming from the Office of the Governor but the Representative of the Provincial DILG was here earlier and we agreed that we refer the matter first for a Committee Meeting, again, to be handled by the Committee on Laws and Justice and Human Rights, Honorable Presiding Officer.

So I will now come to the main point of my Privilege Speech, this is in connection with the sorry plight of our farmers, Honorable Presiding Officer. If you can remember, Honorable Presiding Officer, during the campaign, the First District Congressman, Hon. Romeo Salazar Momo, Sr., initiated Town Hall Meeting and it was in Sumo-sumo if I'm not mistaken, Board Members from the First District were there, you, Honorable Presiding Officer, Hon. Montesclaros, Jr., Hon. Azarcon, Hon. Dumagan, Jr., and myself. We witnessed a young lady asking question to Honorable Congressman Romeo S. Momo, Sr., and she was crying. She cried your Honor because in her language *sa Tinagon-on na pagkasulti*, if I may relayed, she said, I am not supposed to be here but since the youth in our Barangay said that there's a Town Hall Meeting to be conducted so that's why I am here. When I learned, *pagkahibalo nako nga miingon si Cong. Momo nga farmer siya*, so I was excited but *dili pwede na dili nako ni mahi-istorya, naghilak siya*, Honorable Presiding Officer because *ingon siya*, we in the family, we were raised by our farmer parents. But right now, *unsa na man ning plight sa mga farmers nga again, constant, high cost of production to produce palay but during the harvest season pagpamaligya sa mga ani sa uma, sa humay, permi barato ang pamalit*. Now, this has been happening since time immemorial and more so now with the advent of the Rice Tarrification Law, *gipasangil sa Rice Tarrification Law tungod kay*, the government through the National Food Authority (NFA), *giwagtang na ang mga daghan nga mga restrictions for importation*. So it is now easy for even non-government entities to import rice. The purpose of this is very good, Rice Tarrification Law *daghan ang supply so that barato ang pamaligya sa mga consumers (Law of Supply and Demand)*, that's correct Hon. Garay. The problem is, *mauy i-rason nga dili makapamalit ug taas ang traders tungod kay bugason nila kay magnegosyo barato ang bugas*. So *naghilak tong babayhana*, Honorable Presiding Officer. Now, if this will go on and we don't know how long it will go on *naa pa bay mananum ug humay nga permi man barato, permi man alkanse? Balikon nako*, high cost of production *pagbaligya sa imong humay barato*, so that is the sorry plight of our farmers. Now, the meat of my Privilege Speech is, I will pass a Resolution in Unassigned Business/Privilege Business in today's session asking Honorable Governor Johnny T. Pimentel to form a Technical Working Group to study the matter. The point is, the government has to come in, now there is a national solution to this, is through the National Food Authority. *Ang problema karon with the Rice Tarrification Law, samut na mibaba ang budget sa NFA kay dili na sila, ang ilang mandate, nawala na didto sa Food Security gihimo nila ang NFA nga buffer stock*. So the point of the matter is that, it is about time that the Provincial Government has to set-in. Under Section 22 of the Local Government Code, Honorable Presiding Officer, we have corporate powers and if I may read the last paragraph of Section 22 of the Local Government Code it says: "*local government unit shall enjoy full autonomy in exercise of their propriety functions and in the management of their economic enterprises subject to the limitations provided in this Code and other applicable laws*".

So the point is, *pwede magnegosyo ang* Provincial Government like the operation of Terminal, so *para madali*, Honorable Presiding Officer, the idea is for the Provincial Government to intervene *kung pwede* the Provincial Government or the Governor set aside the fund *nga naay ato gamiton nga pundo direkta mamalit ug humay ang* Provincial Government maybe through the Office of the Provincial Agriculturist, maybe through the creation of Economic Enterprise or we can have a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) with NFA. So, that is the zest of the Resolution asking the Provincial Governor Johnny T. Pimentel to form a Technical Working Group to study the matter if there is viability because it has been done in the other provinces, for the Province of Surigao del Sur to buy the palay of our farmers and its acronym will be AMPP – it does not mean for the big 4 political leaders of our province AMPP – does not mean Alameda, Momo, Pimentel, Pimentel, no. AMPP will mean Honorable Presiding Officer “**Ani Mo Paliton sa Probinsya Program**”. In line with this, I would like also to ask that there will be a Committee Meeting that will be conducted probably the lead Committee will be the Committee on Agriculture/Fisheries to be paired with the Committee on Ways and Means and Taxation because this will also lead for the province to gain income because we will now be engaging in business of buying palay and selling rice through Kadiwa, Honorable Presiding Officer. That’s the very zest of the Resolution and I would like to sponsor that in Unassigned Business/Privilege Business in today’s session, Honorable Presiding Officer. That is all, Honorable Presiding Officer, thank you and good morning.

HON. GARAY:

Good morning everyone, especially to our Presiding Officer. Road accidents are among the primary cause of death of Filipinos aged 5 to 29, and the fifth top cause of death in the Philippines, just behind Cardiovascular Diseases, Cancer, Diabetes and Pneumonia. According to the United Nations data, an average of 32 persons died every day in the Philippines as a result of road accidents. To minimize or avoid road accidents, there is a need to strengthen the enforcement of road-related laws and improve road behavior among drivers of motorcycles or four-wheeled vehicles and regulate speed on City and Municipal streets.

Honorable Presiding Officer, may I be allowed to pass a Resolution regarding this situation. Honorable Presiding Officer, a Resolution entitled “Enjoining Local Government Units within the Province of Surigao del Sur for the Strict Implementation of Road-Related Laws and Enforce Speed Limit Not Exceeding 30 Kilometers Per Hour as to Republic Act 4136, and or Install a Speed Detection Device and Monitor the Speed Limits”. This is to be included in today's session under Unassigned Business/Privilege Business. Thank you and good morning again.

To this Honorable Body, I stand before this podium to address my Privilege Speech relative to the recent crime incident that happened yesterday, which shocked the people of Bislig City, especially the Media Industry and not just the local but also it was being published and aired to the different big news company or industry like ABS-CBN, GMA, Sun Star and etc..

Yesterday, around 9:00 A.M., Mr. Erwin “Boy Pana” Segovia, 64 years old by his age, a local media or news anchor who just finished his daily program, which he called it “Diretsahan ni Boy Pana” at 7:00 to 8:00 A.M., was being shot at the head twice by the two unidentified assailants on his way home right after his morning program while he was also driving his motorcycle near Bislig Water District in Purok 3, John Bosco, Barangay Mangagoy, Bislig City, which is also a few blocks away from my home. The suspects fled right away on their direction somewhere in Barangay Tabon, and until now, they're still at large.

Every Surigaonon deserves to live peacefully and sociably no matter what his job would be as long as it is not illegal, especially to our Local Media Industry here. This kind of brutal killing and cruelty is totally unacceptable, intolerable and the perpetrators should be held accountable and responsible for the crime that they did. We, the Public Officials, should do our best to protect the most vulnerable sector in our society, which is the poor, ethnic, religious minorities, media entities, and even the ordinary people who lives in our land. I am hoping that the death of Kuya Boy Pana or Mr. Erwin Segovia, will be given justice in the earliest time.

To the Philippine National Police, I am praying that they would exert all their efforts to resolve this case as soon as possible or ASAP, as it would be a manifestation that we strongly condemn this kind of cruel act, and also sending a message to the public that we are doing our job, especially in giving justice to the victims of these heinous crimes, and also protecting the lives of every Surigaonon.

In line with this matter, Mr. Presiding Officer, I would like to pass some Resolution under Unassigned Business/Privilege Business relative to this incident. With the indulgence of the Chairman of the Committee on Peace and Order, Public Safety and Anti-Illegal Drugs, Hon. Ruel “Wawing” Momo, I will be passing some of these Resolutions.

The first Resolution that I'd like to pass, is a Resolution “Expressing Sincere Condolences to the Immediate Family and the Local Media or News Industry Family of Mr. Erwin “Boy Pana” Segovia, a Local News and Media Anchor from Barangay Mangagoy, Bislig City”.

The second Resolution that I'd like to pass, is a Resolution “Strongly Condemning the Brutal Killing of Mr. Erwin “Boy Pana” Segovia, a Local News and Media Anchor from Barangay Mangagoy, Bislig City, Who was Been Shot Yesterday, July 21, 2025”.

The last two (2) Resolutions that I'd like to pass, relative to this matter is a Resolution “Earnestly Requesting the National Bureau of Investigation (NBI) to Investigate and Resolve the Killing of the Local Media News Anchor, Mr. Erwin Segovia from Bislig City, Who was Been Shot on July 21, 2025 in Purok 3, John Bosco District, Barangay Mangagoy, Bislig City”.

And also, we will be passing the same tenor of Resolution, but it will be addressed to the Philippine National Police - Provincial Office.

Actually, Mr. Presiding Officer, the last project that was being constructed in Bislig City, which is the DICT Digital Transformation Center, was already finished. I think the Phase 1, was already completed and it was being funded, worth P5 Million, by Congressman Johnny T. Pimentel. And right now, the construction of the Phase 2, is ongoing and it was also being funded by the City of Bislig, worth P3.6 Million, under the leadership of Mayor Florencio C. Garay.

Relative to this matter, Mr. Presiding Officer, I have a request by passing a Resolution to the Office of Congressman Alexander "Ayek" T. Pimentel, which is the construction of the fencing of this facility because Mr. Chair, the said facility needs to be secured because there are expensive IT Equipments that will be deployed in the said facility. So to this matter, I already spoke with Congressman Alexander T. Pimentel and he said that he is also very willing to help, especially the funding of the fencing of the said facility and also the site development.

So lastly, the Resolution that I'd like to pass, is a Resolution "Requesting Congressman Alexander T. Pimentel to Allocate Three Million Pesos (P3,000,000.00) for the Construction of the Perimeter Fence and Site Development in the 1,000 Square Meter Lot of the New DICT Digital Transformation Center in Barangay Poblacion, Bislig City". Honorable Presiding Officer, again for this matter, I'd like to humbly move for the passage of these different Resolutions under Unassigned Business/Privilege Business for today's session. Thank you.

HON. VICE GOVERNOR ALAMEDA, SR.:

Thank you for that, Board Member Cañedo.

Now the Chair recognizes the Honorable Board Member, Atty. Jun-Jun Dumagan.

HON. DUMAGAN, JR.:

Thank you very much, Honorable Presiding Officer. In our previous session, we adopted the Rules of Procedure for the 21st Sangguniang Panlalawigan. We all know that the Internal Rules of Procedure is mandated by the Local Government Code and this serves as a guide in how we do the proceedings within our Chamber. Though we just passed these Internal Rules of Procedure, but we also admit that this is not a perfect guideline. For example, just this morning, it was properly observed by the Majority Floor Leader that there are instances where matters should be corrected and the Rules should be amended.

With this, yesterday, we have visitors coming from the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG), which conducted an inventory and inspection on the manner on how the Sangguniang Panlalawigan conducts its Regular Session and Committee Hearings. One of the recommendations is to abide with the New Guidelines of the Department of the Interior and Local Government that in view of the Freedom of Information Act, all proceedings by the Sangguniang Bayan, Sangguniang Pambarangay and Sangguniang Panlalawigan throughout the nation should be published live in any form of media publication or on any media platform.

With this, there is a necessity to amend our Internal Rules and I would like also to invite all the Members that if you have observed that there are Rules which should be amended, then kindly submit it to the Committee on Rules, Privileges and Ethics so that on the next session, we

If it is okay with you, Honorables, Chairman on Laws and Justice and Human Rights and Chairman on Good Government, Public Ethics and Accountability, we would like to have this meeting right after the

session on Tuesday, if okay with you guys? Alright. So that's all, Mr. Chair, for this Privilege Hour. Thank you very much.

1. Memorandum Order No. 89 from Hon. Johnny T. Pimentel, Provincial Governor, addressed to all Department Heads and Chief of Hospitals dated July 17, 2025 with subject: Implementation of Precautionary Measures on the Prevention of MPOX. The latter informed the Body that in view of the increasing risk of Mpox (Monkeypox) transmission and in alignment with the Department of Health Memorandum No. 2024-0306 entitled "Updated Interim Guidelines on the Prevention, Detection, and Management of Mpox," all offices under the Provincial Government of Surigao del Sur are hereby directed to implement the following precautionary measures effective immediately: 1. Information Dissemination – Ensure that all employees are informed about the signs and symptoms of Mpox, modes of transmission, and preventive strategies through posters, digital platforms, or orientation sessions; 2. Hygiene and Sanitation – Reinforce hand hygiene practices by ensuring availability of handwashing stations and alcohol-based hand sanitizers in all entrances, comfort rooms, and common areas. Regular disinfection of high-touch surfaces and communal areas must be carried out at least twice daily; 3. Health Monitoring and Reporting – Employees exhibiting symptoms suggestive of Mpox (such as fever, rash, swollen lymph nodes, or unexplained skin lesions) must be advised to seek immediate medical evaluation and refrain from reporting to work. Offices must coordinate with the Provincial Health Office and the Provincial Epidemiology and Surveillance Unit (PESU) for any suspected or confirmed Mpox case; 4. Minimizing Physical Contact and Congestion – Implement physical distancing and discourage handshakes and close contact in official interactions; and 5. Use of Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) – Encourage the use of face masks especially when experiencing respiratory symptoms or when interacting with the public. Further, compliance to the Memorandum shall be strictly monitored by the Provincial Health Office. Non-compliance may be subject to administrative action, for the Body's information.
