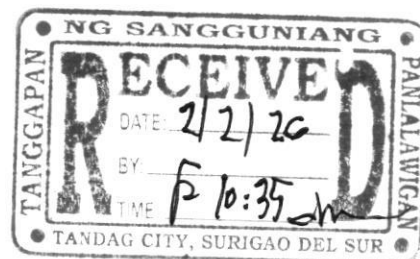

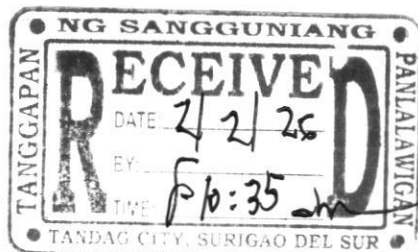

“AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING GUIDELINES IN SETTING AND DETERMINING STANDARD FARE MATRIX AND FREIGHT ADJUSTMENT FOR TRICYCLE-FOR-HIRE, TRIKES (BAO-BAO), SINGLE MOTORCYCLES AND HABAL-HABAL IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF LIANGA, SURIGAO DEL SUR, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES”

WHEREAS, by virtue of Article 99, Section 3 (vi) of Republic Act 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, the power to regulate tricycle for hire has already been devolved from the Land Transportation Franchising and Regulatory Board (LTFRB) to the Local Government Unit (LGU);

WHEREAS, the unstable oil price hikes, high cost of spare parts and the implementation of the Tax Reform for Acceleration and Inclusion (TRAIN) Laws caused the increase in prices of prime commodities and at the same time affected the income of the transportation sector affecting the quality of life of their respective families;

WHEREAS, while the municipal government sympathizes with the welfare of the riding public, the current fare is not sufficient to sustain the needs of the tricycle drivers and/or operators;

WHEREAS, tricycle-for-hire, trikes (Bao-Bao), Single Motorcycle and Habal-Habal issues such as fare increases, when not effectively resolved would cause a setback to the local government's promotion of social welfare;

WHEREAS, addressing these issues necessitate a strong government intervention with a clear-cut focus on crafting regulatory and proactive policies that will standardize the fares of all franchised tricycle-for-hire operating within the municipality of Lianga;

WHEREAS, upon careful perusal of the issue, the sanggunian deemed it proper and timely to grant set and determined the standard fare matrix and freight adjustment in the municipality;

NOW THEREFORE, on motion of Hon. Eduardo P. Dominguito, Jr. duly seconded by Hon. Anthony S. Pagapulaan and Hon. Hernalyn U. Layno;

BE IT ENACTED, by the Sangguniang Bayan of Lianga in session assembled that:

SECTION 1. TITLE. This Ordinance shall be known as the "An Ordinance Providing Guidelines In Setting And Determining Standard Fare Matrix And Freight Adjustment For Tricycle-For-Hire Trikes (Bao-Bao), Single Motorcycles And Habal-Habal In The Municipality Of Lianga, Surigao Del Sur, And For Other Purposes"

SECTION 2. SCOPE AND LIMITATION. This Ordinance shall apply to all public tricycles-for-hire, Trikes (Bao-Bao), Single Motorcycles And Habal-Habal plying the routes within the territorial jurisdiction of Lianga.

SECTION 3. DEFINITION OF TERMS. For the purpose of this Ordinance, the following definitions shall be adopted.

- a. **Fare** – refers to the money a passenger on public transportation has to pay;
- b. **Fare Matrix** – is a chart that tells how much the base fare is per passenger and is usually a requirement by the local government. Most of the time, they are posted inside that sidecar of a tricycle so that passengers can easily read them;
- c. **Tricycle** – a public utility vehicle, a motorized tricycle, or simply tricycles (known as a motorcycle and sidecar), a common means of public or private transportation.
 - Habal-Habal – is an indispensable, albeit largely informal mode of transportation in the hinterland barangays. It serves as the primary, and often only, mean of transport in rural, mountainous, and underdeveloped areas where road conditions are too narrow, steep, muddy or unpaved for jeepneys or tricycles.
 - Single Motorcycle – act as a primary, cost-effective, and efficient mode of transportation, often favoured for beating traffic and reducing fuel costs.
 - Trikes (Bao-Bao) - frequently operating as primary "vehicle for the masses" for quick, door-to-door, or community-level travel. It is often smaller, covered vehicles which offer modern comfort, essential, low-cost, short-distance transportation.
- d. **Person with Disability (PWD)** – are those who have long-term physical, mental, intellectual or sensory impairments which in interaction with various barriers may hinder their full and effective participation in society on an equal basis with others;
- e. **Senior Citizen** – refers to any resident citizen of the Philippines at least sixty (60) years old;
- f. **Students** – those enrolled in and who regularly attend in an educational institution;
- g. **Colorum** – it is an operation of the operator without a valid MTOP;
- h. **Motorized Tricycle Operators Permit (MTOP)** – is a document granting a permit or license to operate issued to a person, natural or juridical, allowing to operate a tricycle transport service within the territorial limits of the Municipality of Lianga;
- i. **Driver** – is a duly license person assigned by the owner to drive a specific tricycle;

- j. **Tricycle-for-Hire** – is a tricycle for hire rendering transport services to the general public with existing franchise duly registered with the Motorized Tricycle Operators Permit (MTOPI);
- k. **Owner or Operator** – is the registered owner of a tricycle as shown by the Certificate of Registration or other documents;
- l. **Contract Fare/Special Trip** – fares beyond the cut-off points specified above shall be by agreement of the passengers and the tricycle driver/operator a reasonable amount.

SECTION 4. FARE. All tricycle-for-hire, trikes (Bao Bao), single motorcycle and habal-habal (bukid line), operators/drivers are required to adhere, to the following approved prescribed fare in the Municipality of Lianga, to wit:

A. Amount of Fare – The minimum fare increase (flagdown rate) of 10.00 is hereby approved:

SECTION 5. POINT OF ORIGIN – The rates indicated above applies from the point of origin and vice versa.

SECTION 6. CONDITIONS FOR FARES AND FREIGHT AND PRIVILEGES. – The driver/operator can charge no more than what is provided for in this Ordinance. Fares and freight shall also be subject to the following conditions:

- a. A Senior Citizen with I.D. shall be entitled to a 20% fare discount (Expanded Senior Citizens Act).
- b. A student with valid ID shall likewise be entitled to a student fare discount of 20%.
- c. PWDs with I.D. shall be also entitled to a fare discount of 20% (Magna Carta for Persons with Disabilities).
- d. Children below 7 years old shall not be charged fare unless that the child has occupied a seat.
- e. Each passenger is entitled to a baggage load not exceeding 20 kilograms for free.
- f. Cargoes and baggage in excess of 20 kilograms shall pay freight equivalent to an adult passenger.
- g. Cargoes whose length is no longer than 6 meters (20 feet) shall not be allowed.

Violation of any of the conditions mentioned in this Section is a ground to cancel the franchise granted to the owner besides the administrative penalties hereinafter provided.

SECTION 7. POSTING OF FARE MATRIX. A matrix of the lawful fares and freight of all tricycle for hire with franchise shall be posted on the lower corner of the windshield and/or within the passenger's view upon implementation of this Ordinance. Failure to provide such matrix shall authorize apprehending officer to take the motorized tricycle to the nearest police station and to release the same only upon payment of the administrative fine.

SECTION 8. FARE AND FREIGHT RATE INCREASE. The fare and freight rates is subject to changes as deemed necessary by the Sangguniang Bayan or upon the petition of the TODA and after a public hearing and/or consultation to amend or modify the fare and freight rates.

SECTION 9. LOWER FARE RATES. The Sangguniang Bayan, upon its discretion and proper notice, may lower foregoing fares every time there are movement of fuel prices in the market.

SECTION 10. MTFRB. There shall be created a MTFRB that shall be composed of the following:

a. Composition:

b. Duties and Functions:

- Responsible for the regulation and franchising of motorized tricycles within the municipality;
- Issuing Motorized Tricycle Operator's Permits (MTOPs) to qualified applicants;
- Ensuring that Filipino citizens and corporations with a majority Filipino equity are granted these permits;
- Verifying that applicants possess units valid Land Transportation Office (LTO) registration papers;
- Setting requirements for common carrier insurance;
- Requiring that tricycle operators employ only LTO-licensed drivers.
- Investigate and conduct settlement to erring drivers and operators misbehaviour

The MTFRB may hear the petition for fare and freight rate adjustment depending on the world supply of oil and other economic factors subject to the concurrence or approval of the Sangguniang Bayan.

SECTION 11. LOAD CAPACITY LIMIT. The load capacity for all tricycle-for-hire, trikes (Bao Bao) shall be limited to up to five (5) passengers provided that road safety component is maintained.

SECTION 12. ISSUANCE OF FRANCHISE. No motor vehicle for hire shall be issued franchise unless the following applicable physical requirements equipage are complied with:

- Clear windshields;
- Garbage receptacle;
- Functioning horn that does not emit exceptionally loud or startling sound;
- Two (2) signal lights, fronts and back for turning right or left or for emergency purposes;
- Tail light, including license plate light;
- Top chain extending to the rear wheel;
- White head lights in front and red tail light with functioning stop light in the rear, visible at least 50 meters from the front and rear of the tricycle and functioning under all weather conditions and lighted starting 6:00 pm until 6:00 am;

- Light installed inside the sidecar and keep lighted while plying routes;
- Anti-noise equipment/silencer;
- Sticker containing the body number of the vehicle and placed prominently to be identifiable from a distance;
- Fully operating mufflers; and
- Roadworthiness of the tricycle unit.

SECTION 13. LOWER FARE RATES. The Sangguniang Bayan, upon its discretion and proper notice, may lower foregoing fares every time there are movement of fuel prices in the market.

SECTION 14. LIABILITY OF ANY MEMBERS OF PNP, BPSO, ELECTED MUNICIPAL AND BARANGAY OFFICIALS AND EMPLOYEES.

- a. Any member of the PNP stationed in Lianga who refuses to apprehend violators of this Ordinance during his tour of duty for the day shall be charged administratively for dereliction of duty.
- b. Any elected municipal and barangay officials and employees of Lianga who will intercede for the release or fixing the case of any arrested violator will be proceeded against him administratively and or criminally for obstruction of justice and/or violation of R. A. 6713.

SECTION 15. PROHIBITED ACTS.

- 1) All tricycle/trikes (BaoBao) drivers are prohibited from charging the fare equivalent to five (5) passengers for only one (1) passenger.
- 2) Non-posting of the corresponding fare matrix schedule in the tricycle/trikes (BaoBao) units bearing the new fare rate.
- 3) It shall be unlawful for any driver and/or operator of any tricycle/trikes/single motor and habal-habal to refuse to convey or choose their passengers and their destination without any valid reason.
- 4) Charging of exorbitant fees other than those lawfully prescribed in this ordinance.
- 5) None compliance of the requirements stipulated in Section 12 & 17 of this ordinance.

SECTION 16. PENALTIES.

Any tricycle drivers and or operators caught violating Section 15 of this Ordinance shall be liable for the following penalties, to wit:

- 1) First Offense – One Thousand Pesos (Php1,000.00)
- 2) Second Offense – One Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (Php1,500.00) or imprisonment of five (5) days or both such fine and imprisonment at the discretion of the court.
- 3) Third and Succeeding Offense – Two Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (Php2,500.00) or imprisonment of ten (10) days or both such fine and imprisonment at the discretion of the court, and shall be ground for the revocation of Motorized Tricycle Operators Permit (MTO).

The violator shall be given five (5) calendar days from issuance of the Citation Ticket within which to pay the fine.

SECTION 17. ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF DRIVERS AND OPERATORS. To ensure safety and efficient driving, the following are the primary and vital responsibilities of the drivers/operators, viz:

- 1) The driver must be equipped with Professional Driver's License;
- 2) That the tricycle used or operated must have been registered in the LTO;
- 3) That the unit must have been issued with business permit to operate at the local government unit of Lianga, Surigao del Sur and must have complied the franchising laws;
- 4) That the body number of the unit must be inscribed at the visible area with 8 x 8 inches dimensions;
- 5) That the unit must have been insured or has promptly paid the transportation insurance premium for surety of the passengers, in case of accident;

- 6) See to it that the unit operated is in good condition and well-maintained to provide comfort and to avoid from possible accident;
- 7) Assist the passengers in boarding and getting off, especially the aged and physically handicapped;
- 8) Ensures safety of the passengers while on board;
- 9) Loads passengers limited to setting capacity only;
- 10) Observes proper hygiene and avoid wearing sando;
- 11) Observes traffic rules and regulations on loading and unloading of passengers (or baggage) which should be at the road shoulders or not within the road areas and intersections;
- 12) Posts the tariff fare rates at the visible area for the information of the commuter/passenger; and
- 13) Must have complied all the requirements on the issuance of franchise.

SECTION 18. DUTIES OF THE COMMUTER/PASSENGER. Should any driver makes any violation or infringement of the above provisions, he should: take note of the plate number of the unit or the name of the driver thereof, if he knows, the date and time and the route, then report the same to the police for appropriate disciplinary actions based on the penal provisions hereof.

SECTION 19. ENFORCEMENT. This ordinance shall be implemented by PNP personnel and Lianga Municipal Police Station with the assistance of the traffic enforcers.

SECTION 20. ROLE OF THE BARANGAYS. Barangays in the municipality of Lianga are important domain and embodiment of the grassroots level of society. They have first-hand information with regard to the realities and on-site conditions of the riding public/commuters, as well as the public transport sector. As such, they shall make necessary recommendations thru representation to the Municipality of Lianga on matters of fare implementation, fare increase, ambiguous transport fare practices, and such other related concerns, taking into account the welfare of the majority of its constituents.

SECTION 21. OFFICES WITH ADMINISTRATIVE AUTHORITY: The following offices of this LGU are responsible in the implementation hereof:

| PNP | - conduct a timely inspection and monitoring subject in this Ordinance and the violators thereof; and issue Citation ticket for the said violation, in coordination with the BPLO and Traffic Enforcers; |
| Traffic Enforcers | - Assist the PNP in the implementation of traffic rules and policies imposed herein and report any violation to the PNP for appropriate action; |
| Municipal Treasurer | - Issue Official Receipt to Citation Ticket issued by the PNP for any violation committed; Provide the new tricycle fare matrix, and; Ensure proper information and dissemination to all the Tricycle Operators and Drivers Associations (TODAs) in Municipality of Lianga. |
| BPLO | - In-charge in the issuance of MTOP, in coordination with the Municipal Treasurer for the payments and charges thereof. |

SECTION 22. REPEALING CLAUSE – All ordinances, resolutions, orders or parts thereof which are inconsistent with any section or provision of this Ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 23. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE – Should any provision or section of this Ordinance or any part thereof be declared invalid, the other provisions or sections, insofar as they are separable from the invalid ones, shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 24. EFFECTIVITY – This Ordinance shall take effect immediately after a copy hereof is posted in three (3) conspicuous places in the municipality.

Preliminaries:

- Hon. Eduardo P. Dominguito, Jr., Presiding – called the meeting to order at exactly 1:30 in the afternoon;

- Functioning horn that does not emit exceptionally loud or startling sound;
 - Two (2) signal lights, fronts and back for turning right or left or for emergency purposes;
 - Tail light, including license plate light;
 - Top chain extending to the rear wheel;
 - White head lights in front and red tail light with functioning stop light in the rear, visible at least 50 meters from the front and rear of the tricycle and functioning under all weather conditions and lighted starting 6:00 pm until 6:00 am;
 - Light installed inside the sidecar and keep lighted while plying routes;
 - Anti-noise equipment/silencer;
 - Sticker containing the body number of the vehicle and placed prominently to be identifiable from a distance;
 - Fully operating mufflers; and
 - Roadworthiness of the tricycle unit.
- Liability of any members of PNP, BPSO, elected municipal and barangay officials and employees.
- **Prohibited Acts:**
- All tricycle drivers are prohibited from charging the fare equivalent to five (5) passengers for only one (1) passenger.
 - Non-posting of the corresponding fare matrix schedule in the tricycle units bearing the new fare rate.
 - It shall be unlawful for any driver and/or operator of any tricycle to refuse to convey or choose their passengers and their destination without any valid reason.
 - Charging of exorbitant fees other than those lawfully prescribed in this ordinance.
- **Penalties:**
- *1st Offense* – One Thousand Pesos (Php1,000.00)
 - *2nd Offense* – One Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (Php1,500.00) or imprisonment of five (5) days or both such fine and imprisonment at the discretion of the court.
 - *3rd and Succeeding Offense* – Two Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (Php2,500.00) or imprisonment of ten (10) days or both such fine and imprisonment at the discretion of the court, and shall be ground for the revocation of Motorcycle/Tricycle Operators Permit (MTOP).
- Enforcement, Role of the Barangays and Duties of the Municipal Treasury has been clearly defined in the ordinance.
- Municipal Treasurer, Ms. Loida C. Orbeta, asked as to the number of TODA accredited by the Sangguniang Bayan and further suggested for merging/federating them into one (1) association.
 - **Noel H. Tejero, Vice President-LIBODA** - suggested to grant equal minimum fare of 10.00 within barangay Diatagon proper, same with Barangay Poblacion.
 - Sangguniang Bayan Member, Hon. Ignacio L. Serrano, Jr. explained that barangay Diatagon proper has wide coverage compared to Barangay Poblacion, hence, the grant of equal minimum fare of 10.00 might not be justifiable.
 - **Hon. Euberto A. Morgado, Punong Barangay of Barangay Anibongan** – suggested to include in the fare matrix route from Anibongan National High School (point of origin) to different barangays, considering that students from ANHS coming from barangays of the municipality. The route shall include the following:

Anibongan National High School (vice versa)	Fare
ANHS to Barangay Baucawe proper	15.00
ANHS to Baucawe, Baugo	20.00
ANHS to Barangay Payasan	20.00
ANHS to Barangay Poblacion	25.00
ANHS to Barangay Liatimco	15.00

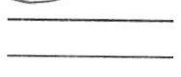
