AFFIRMING ORDINANCE NO. 18 DATED FEBRUARY 3, 2026 OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF CARMEN, THIS PROVINCE ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE IMPOSING A TEMPORARY LIQUOR BAN ON THE SALE, DISTRIBUTION AND CONSUMPTION OF ANY INTOXICATED^{MS} AND ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF CARMEN, SURIGAO DEL SUR DURING THE OCCURENCES OF TROPICAL CYCLONES (SIGNAL NO 1 OR^R HIGHER) NATURAL AND MAN-MADE CALAMITIES AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF", IT BEING WITHIN THE SCOPE OF THE PRESCRIBED POWERS OF THE SANGGUNIAN BAYAN CONCERNED TO ENACT SUCH ORDINANCE PURSUANT TO THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE OF 1991

WHEREAS, Chapter 3, Article III, Section 468 Par. (a) No. 1 (i) of the Local Government Code of 1991 provides that, "the sangguniang panlalawigan shall review all ordinances approved by the sanggunians of component cities and municipalities and executive orders issued by the mayors of said component units to determine whether these are within the scope of the prescribed powers of the sanggunian and of the mayor";

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 18 dated February 3, 2026 of the Municipality of Carmen, this Province entitled "An Ordinance Imposing a Temporary Liquor Ban on the Sale, Distribution and Consumption of Any Intoxicated and Alcoholic Beverages in the Municipality of Carmen, Surigao del Sur During the Occurences of Tropical Cyclones (Signal No 1 of Higher) Natural and Man-Made Calamities and Providing Penalties for Violation Thereof", was submitted to this Body for review and same was referred to the Committees on Trade, Industry, Investment and SMEs/Local Economic Enterprises and Utilities (Lead Committee)/Peace and Order, Public Safety and Anti-Illegal Drugs/Disaster Risk Reduction and Climate Change Adaptation, for appropriate action and technical review;

WHEREAS, after a careful review by the Committees to which the matter was referred to, it was found out that it is within the ambit of the provisions of the Local Government Code of 1991;

WHEREAS, in view of the foregoing and on motion of _____ and duly seconded by _____;

NOW THEREFORE

BE IT RESOLVED by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Surigao del Sur to affirm Ordinance No. 18 dated February 3, 2026 of the Municipality of Carmen, this Province entitled "An Ordinance Imposing a Temporary Liquor Ban on the Sale, Distribution and Consumption of Any Intoxicated and Alcoholic Beverages in the Municipality of Carmen, Surigao del Sur During the Occurences of Tropical Cyclones (Signal No 1 of Higher) Natural and Man-Made Calamities and Providing Penalties for Violation Thereof", it being within the scope of the prescribed powers of the Sangguniang Bayan concerned to enact such Ordinance pursuant to the Local Government Code of 1991.
