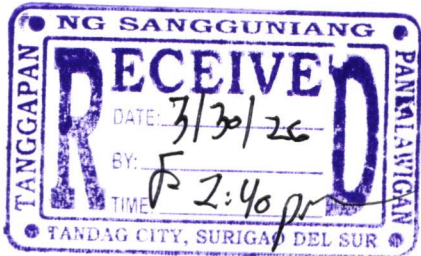

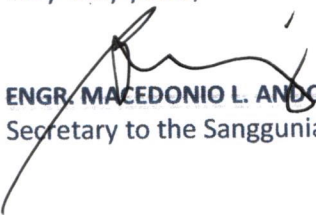

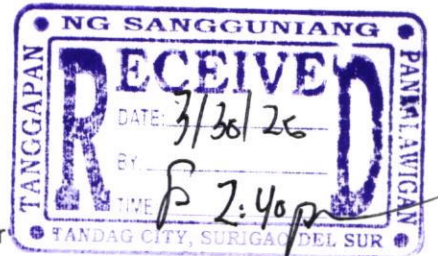

AN ORDINANCE INSTITUTIONALIZING THE GRANT OF INCENTIVES TO ALL BAYABAS PUBLIC AND PRIVATE SCHOOL LEARNERS FOR OUTSTANDING ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENT AND PROVIDING FUNDS THEREFOR

PREAMBLE

WHEREAS, Section 2(3), Article XIV of the 1987 Philippine Constitution provides that the State shall establish and maintain a system of scholarship grants, student loan programs, subsidies, and other incentives which shall be available to deserving students in both public and private schools, especially the underprivileged;

WHEREAS, in line with the implementation of Republic Act No. 10533, otherwise known as the "Enhanced Basic Education Act of 2013," the Local Government Unit of Bayabas, Surigao del Sur recognizes the importance of encouraging and rewarding the outstanding academic performance and exemplary public service of learners through student leadership;

WHEREAS, the proposed granting of incentives seeks to recognize learners who have obtained the distinction of "With Highest Honors" in Grades 6, Junior High School, and Senior High School in all public and private elementary and secondary schools in the Municipality of Bayabas, Surigao del Sur;

WHEREAS, the grant of appropriate incentives to such academic achievers will not only foster a sense of belongingness and gratitude, but will likewise serve as an inspiration and motivation for other youth to strive for excellence in their studies and in community service;

WHEREAS, the enactment of this Ordinance is in faithful pursuit of the constitutional mandate for the State to recognize the vital role of the youth in nation-building and to promote and protect their intellectual, moral, spiritual, social, and physical well-being.

NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED by the Sangguniang Bayan of Bayabas, Surigao del Sur, in session assembled that:

SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE. This Ordinance shall be known as the "INSTITUTIONALIZING THE GRANT OF INCENTIVES TO ALL PUBLIC AND PRIVATE SCHOOL LEARNERS IN BAYABAS, SURIGAO DEL SUR, FOR ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENTS."

SECTION 2. DECLARATION OF POLICY. It is hereby declared the policy of the Municipality of Bayabas, Province of Surigao del Sur, to foster discipline, hard work, and excellence among the youth, in recognition of their vital role in nation-building and local development. In pursuance of this policy, the Municipality shall establish institutional mechanisms to grant incentives and appropriate recognition to learners who have demonstrated outstanding and exemplary academic performance.

SECTION 3. OBJECTIVES - This Ordinance shall have the following objectives:

- a. To recognize exemplary academic achievements of Grade 6, Junior High School (Grade 10), and Senior High School (Grade 12) graduating learners of Bayabas public and private schools;
- b. To encourage learners to strive for excellence and to become proactive members of the school and community, especially during these extraordinary and challenging times.

SECTION 4. SCOPE AND COVERAGE. This Ordinance shall be applied to all public and private schools within the territorial jurisdiction of the Municipality of Bayabas, Surigao del Sur. Graduating students of Grade 6, Junior High School (Grade 10), and Senior High School (Grade 12) who will qualify for the granting of the incentives.

SECTION 5. DEFINITION OF TERMS. As used in this Ordinance, the following words are construed as follows:

- a. Customized Medal – A medal purposely fabricated or made of acrylic material with the official seal of the Municipality as its imposing feature. The sizes of the medals are as follows:
 1. Grade 6 - 2 inches in diameter
 2. Junior High School - 2.5 inches in diameter
 3. Senior High School - 3.5 inches in diameter
- b. Incentives – Refers to the cash and customized medals to be given to qualified learners as contemplated under this Ordinance.
- c. Municipality – The Municipality of Bayabas, Surigao del Sur, or its Municipal Government.
- d. "With Highest Honors" - In the current DepEd system for basic education, "with highest honors" refers to graduating learners who have achieved a general average of 98–100, with a passing final grade in all learning areas.

SECTION 6. INCENTIVES. Graduating learners with highest honors for Grade 6, Grade 10, and Grade 12 in all public and private schools within the territorial jurisdiction of this Municipality shall be given the following incentives, viz:

- a. Grade 6 - ₱ 500 plus customized medal;
- b. Grade 10 (Junior High School) - ₱ 700 plus customized medal; and
- c. Grade 12 (Senior High School) - ₱ 1,000 plus customized medal,

SECTION 7. ADMINISTRATION. The Municipal Mayor's Office (MMO), through the Human Resource and Management Officer (HRMO), shall administer the implementation of this Ordinance.

All schools within the territorial jurisdiction of this Municipality shall submit the list of students with the highest honors to the MMO to facilitate the awarding of the incentives, which shall be given or awarded during the graduation ceremonies, where the Municipal Mayor, or his duly authorized representative, shall be the one to award the incentives.

SECTION 8. APPROPRIATION. The incentives to be awarded for the initial implementation of this Ordinance shall be taken from the available budget of the Municipal Social Welfare and Development Office (MSWDO), and thereafter, the budgetary requirements shall be included in the annual budget of the Municipality under the MSWDO.

SECTION 9. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. If any part or section of this Ordinance is declared unconstitutional for any reason whatsoever, such declaration shall not in any way affect other parts or sections of this Ordinance.

SECTION 10. REPEALING CLAUSE. Any Ordinances, Executive Orders, and Local Issuances, Rules and Regulations or parts thereof, inconsistent with or in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed and or modified accordingly.

SECTION 11. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE. This ordinance shall take effect after ten (10) days from the date a copy hereof is posted in the bulletin board at the entrance of the Municipal Building of Bayabas, Surigao del Sur, and in at least two (2) conspicuous places in the Municipality.

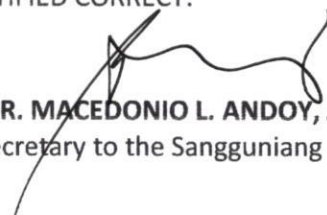

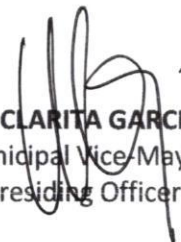

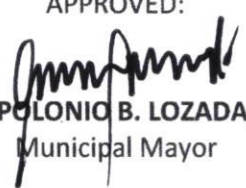
