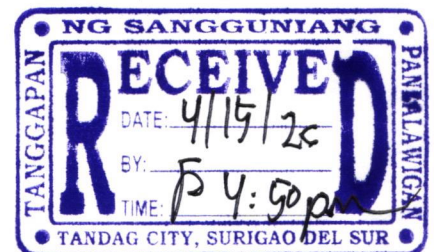

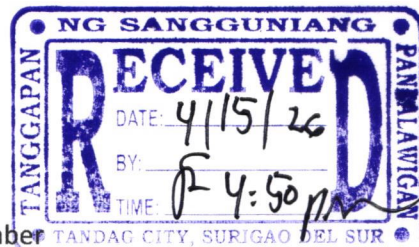

Budgetary Requirements of the PPAs enumerated therein, in the total amount of ₱ 68,584,118.56, was brought before this Sanggunian for possible appropriations;

WHEREAS, there are funds both from internal and external sources that are intended for various PPAs in support of DRRM concerns, Barangay Development Program, Nutrition Services, and to address the root causes of insurgency that need to be utilized by the Municipal Government;

WHEREAS, Section 336 of R.A. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, provides for the utilization of savings and unexpended balances, and makes them also available for the expenditure to augment any item in the approved annual budget upon enactment of an appropriate ordinance;

WHEREAS, one of the oversight functions of the Sangguniang Bayan (SB) is about budget authorization under Section 447, (2) (i), which provides that the SB shall approve the annual and supplemental investment programs of the municipal government and appropriate funds for its implementation, in reference to the general welfare of its inhabitants;

WHEREAS, based on the recommendation of the Committee on Finance and Appropriations, to which this measure was referred, this Sanggunian considers adopting this SAIP as the PPAs therein will address some of the pressing problems of the Municipality;

WHEREAS, after exhaustive deliberation of the said MDC-Executive Committee Resolution as regards SAIP No. 02, series of 2026, it was found to be proper and in the best interest of the people of Bayabas, Surigao del Sur; and

WHEREAS, in view of the foregoing and on motion of Hon. Nicholson Y. Lozada, duly seconded by all Sangguniang Bayan Members present;

NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Members of the Sangguniang Bayan in Special Session assembled to adopt The Supplemental Annual Investment Program (SAIP) No. 02, series of 2026, this Municipality, under MDC-Executive Committee Resolution No. 02, series of 2026 entitled "Resolution adopting and endorsing to the Sangguniang Bayan the inclusion of Programs, Projects, and Activities (PPAs) to the CY 2026 Supplemental Annual Investment Program (SAIP) No. 02 under the Municipal Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Services, Nutrition Services, and Engineering Services to be funded from the MDRRM previous fund (Trust Fund), 2025 and 2026 SBDP NTF-ELCAC, and 2025 and 2026 Growth Equity Fund in the amount of SIXTY-EIGHT MILLION, FIVE HUNDRED EIGHTY-FOUR THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED EIGHTEEN PESOS AND 56/100 (₱ 68,584,118.56)", and approving the same for its intended purpose.

RESOLVED FURTHER: to furnish a copy of this resolution to the Sangguniang Panlalawigan for their review and affirmation.

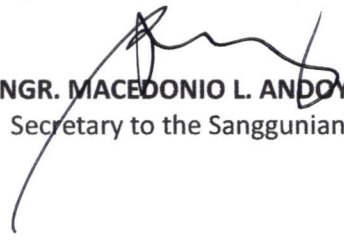

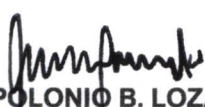
