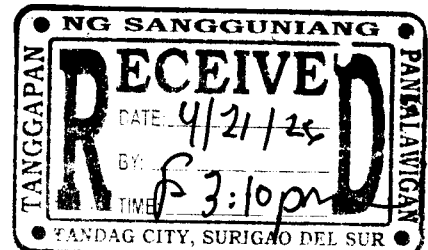

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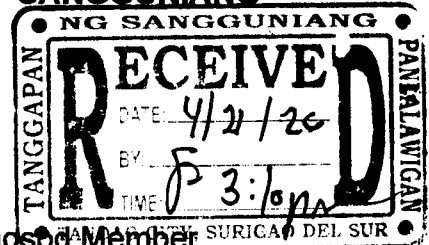

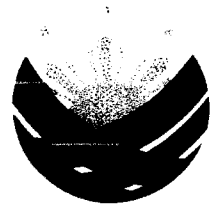

WHEREAS, Article II Section 12 of the 1987 Philippine Constitution mandates the equal protection of the life of the mother and the life of the unborn from the time of conception;

WHEREAS, Administrative Order: 2008-0029 Implementing Health reforms for rapid reduction of maternal and neonatal mortality states that Maternal, Neonatal and Child Health and Nutrition (MNCHN) outlines the specific policies and actions for local health systems to systematically address health risks that lead to maternal and especially neonatal deaths;

WHEREAS, Section 16 of the Local Government Code of 1991 (Republic Act 7160) provides that every Local Government Unit (LGU) within its respective jurisdiction shall ensure and promote health and safety and preserve the comfort and convenience of the inhabitants;

WHEREAS, Section 458 (a) of the Local Government Code of 1991 further states that the Sangguniang Panlungsod shall enact ordinances, approve resolutions, and appropriate funds for the general welfare of the city and its inhabitants:

WHEREAS, it is the duty of the City of Tandag to adopt measures to eliminate or reduce maternal and neonatal deaths in the city;

WHEREAS, the risk of maternal and neonatal deaths for a given population group is magnified by the risk of delivering without being attended by skilled birth attendants and not having access to emergency obstetric and neonatal care services;

WHEREAS, the United Nations Millennium Development Goals (MDGs) actively promote gender equality, reduction of child mortality and the improvement of maternal health to end extreme world poverty;

WHEREAS, in this measure, the City of Tandag seeks to enable pregnant women to obtain proper maternal health care and help them with the proper care and nourishment of their children, thereby reducing the incidence of child mortality;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE 7TH SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD OF THE CITY OF TANDAG IN A SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. TITLE. This Ordinance shall be known as "AN ORDINANCE BANNING CHILDBIRTH HOME DELIVERIES BY SKILLED BIRTH ATTENDANTS AND TRADITIONAL BIRTH ATTENDANTS (TBA) OR 'HILOT' IN THE CITY OF TANDAG AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF."

SECTION 2. DECLARATION OF POLICY. It is the policy of the Local Government of Tandag to ensure the protection and safety of the lives of both the mother and child. Pursuant thereto, the practice of home birth by skilled birth attendants and traditional birth attendants (TBA) "Hilot" is hereby banned in the City of Tandag to protect the health and well-being of the mother and the newborn from the risk of infection and other diseases.

SECTION 3. SCOPE. This Ordinance shall apply to all barangays, concerned departments of the Local Government and all public and private juridical persons in the city.

SECTION 4. DEFINITION OF TERMS. For this Ordinance, the following terms are defined as follows:

- a. **Birthing Facility** - a licensed institution that facilitates the delivery of a child at birth, catering to expectant mothers.
- b. **CHO** - City Health Office
- c. **Infant Death** - death of an infant caused after delivery.
- d. **Maternal Death** - death of women related to complications of pregnancy, childbirth and postpartum caused by the peril of pregnancy and childbirth.
- e. **Midwife** - licensed professional midwife trained to deliver a child.
- f. **Pregnancy** - a normal physiological function of productive women to host the product of fertilization (fetus) up to the termination of gestation in the host uterus.
- g. **Skilled Birth Attendants** - licensed physicians, nurses, and midwives who provide basic and emergency health care services to women and their newborns during pregnancy, childbirth and the postpartum period.
- h. **Traditional Birth Attendant (TBA) or "HILOT"** - the person other than a doctor or health professional administering the delivery of a newborn baby without the required license to practice such.
- i. **Traditional Home Delivery** - the act of delivering newborns outside a birthing facility (i.e. house, school, market, etc.), whether attended by a trained "hilot" or skilled birth attendant.
- j. **Emergency Childbirth** - is the precipitous birth of an infant in an unexpected setting.

SECTION 5. PROHIBITIONS. The following are the prohibited acts:

- a. The delivery of births at home by a skilled birth attendant or traditional birth attendant (TBA) or "hilot".
- b. The delivery of births by a "hilot" whether in a birthing facility or not.

In addition to the existing prohibition on home deliveries conducted by skilled birth attendants and traditional birth attendants, this policy further establishes accountability measures for pregnant women who intentionally seek or engage the services of any birth attendant for home delivery.

Any pregnant woman who knowingly arranges or consents to give birth at home with the assistance of a skilled or traditional birth attendant, in violation of this policy, shall be subject to appropriate penalties as determined by the implementing authority. These penalties may include, but are not limited to, mandatory counseling, community service, or other corrective measures deemed necessary to promote compliance.

Althea Momo



This provision aims to reinforce the importance of facility-based deliveries to ensure the safety and well-being of both mother and child, while encouraging adherence to established maternal health protocols.

SECTION 6. ROLE OF BARANGAY HEALTH WORKERS (BHW). The role of Barangay Health Worker (BHWs) is to provide supportive care during labor and post-partum. They shall encourage the pregnant women to subject themselves to regular prenatal check-ups in the Rural Health Unit or any private lying-in clinic of their choice. They will:

- a. Report to the Punong Barangay or Barangay Chairperson Committee on Health all current cases of pregnancy and shall refer to the Rural Health Unit for further Evaluation.
- b. Maintain a Tracking System for monitoring the progress of pregnant women;
- c. Accompany the pregnant woman to the birthing facility during labor;
- d. May assist the Midwife during labor watch;
- e. May run errands when necessary;
- f. Assist new mothers in initiating breastfeeding.
- g. Report to the Midwife any untoward post-partum complications.

SECTION 7. ROLE OF PUNONG BARANGAY. The Punong Barangay shall closely monitor the incidence of traditional childbirth home delivery, arrange for emergency transport of pregnant women (if needed), and apprehend the violators thereof.

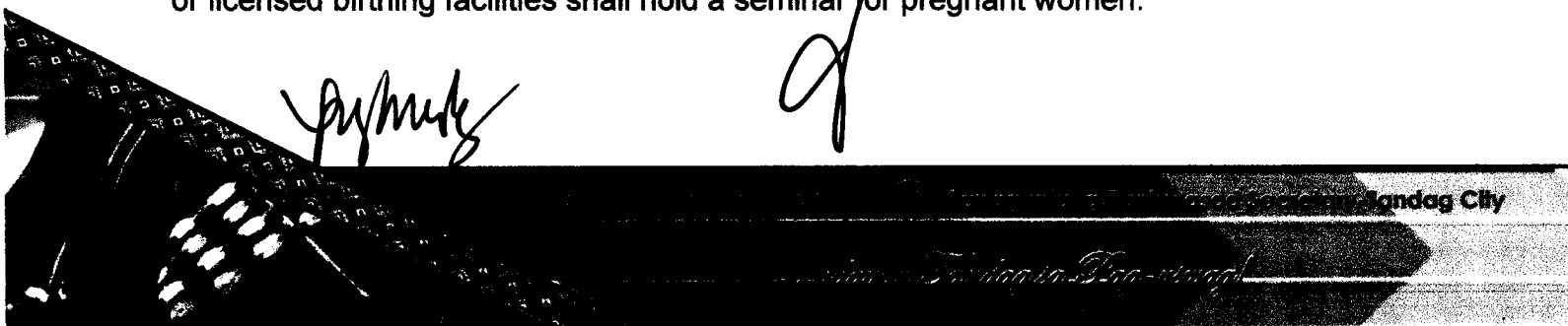
SECTION 8. PENALTIES. Any person or entity who violates Section 5 of this Ordinance shall be penalized in the amount of **Five Thousand Pesos (P 5,000.00)** and or imprisonment of not more than 30 days at the discretion of the court.

SECTION 9. EXEMPTION. Homebirth deliveries considered to be Emergency cases, as assessed by the City Health Office, shall be exempt from penalties.

SECTION 10. PROCEEDS FROM FINES. Proceeds from the fines collected in connection with this ordinance shall be placed in the General fund which will be earmarked specifically for the implementation of the program.

SECTION 11. PUBLIC INFORMATION AND AWARENESS. The City Health Office shall post at the Barangay Health Centers and in some significant portions of the barangays, different signage indicating the title of the ordinance together with its corresponding penalty for its violation. Barangay Health Workers shall encourage pregnant women to seek consultation and schedule a birth with the licensed birthing facility and other private lying-in clinics. The public and private lying-in clinics, hospitals or licensed birthing facilities shall hold a seminar for pregnant women.

SECTION 12. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. If, for any reason or reasons, any part or provisions of this Code shall be held unconstitutional or invalid, other parts or provisions thereof which are not affected shall continue to be in full force and effect.

SECTION 13. REPEALING CLAUSE. All ordinances, rules and regulations, or parts thereof, in conflict with or inconsistent with any provision of this Ordinance are repealed, amended or modified accordingly.

SECTION 14. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE. This ordinance shall take effect after the required posting of a minimum period of three (3) consecutive weeks at conspicuous places in the City of Tandag.

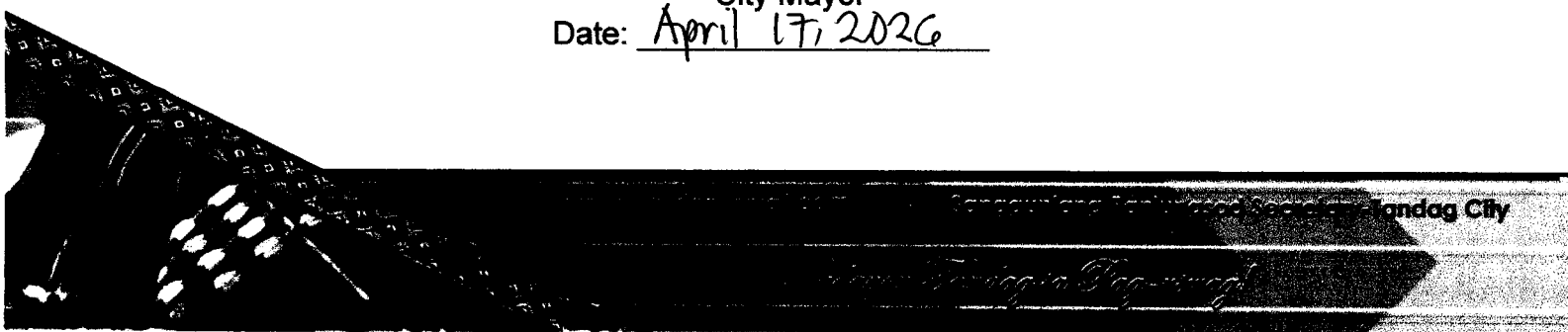

The Secretary to the SP informed that Hon. Eleanor D. Momo is on official business being the Acting City Mayor. Pursuant to Rule III Section 2 of the Internal Rules of Procedure (IRP) of the 7th Sangguniang Panlungsod, "In the event of inability of the City Vice Mayor to act as Presiding Officer...the members present constituting a quorum, shall elect among themselves a Temporary Presiding Officer xxx". As Acting City Vice-Mayor, Hon. Maria Lourdes Kharin C. Momo was elected and presided over the public hearing.

III. ROLL CALL

Eleven (11) SP Members were physically present; one was on official business, while three were on leave. Therefore, there were eleven (11) SP Members in total, including the Temporary Presiding Officer. The Temporary Presiding Officer, Hon. Maria Lourdes Kharin C. Momo, then declared a quorum.

IV. WORDS OF WELCOME: Hon. Maria Lourdes Kharin C. Momo, OIC-Vice Mayor

Hon. Maria Lourdes Kharin C. Momo warmly welcomed everyone to the 1st Public Hearing of the 7th Sangguniang Panlungsod of Tandag City, expressing gratitude and renewed passion for public service. She emphasized that governance is a shared responsibility in which every voice and concern matters. She acknowledged the presence and support of Acting City Mayor Hon. Eleanor D. Momo, her colleagues in the Sangguniang Panlungsod, the SP Secretary and staff, barangay officials and representatives from the LGU, the business sector, academe, the media, and other stakeholders. Hon. Momo highlighted that the hearing embodies active participation and collaboration in shaping policies that reflect the people's aspirations. She encouraged everyone to make the discussion meaningful and to unite in building a stronger, safer, and more progressive Tandag City.

V. MESSAGE OF THE CITY MAYOR/RATIONALE: c/o Acting City Mayor Hon. Eleanor D. Momo

The City Vice Mayor and Acting City Mayor Hon. Eleanor D. Momo, speaking on behalf of Mayor Roxanne Pimentel, welcomed the participants and emphasized the purpose of the public hearing, which is to deliberate on three proposed ordinances: (1) the naming of public plazas and parks, (2) the prohibition of home childbirth deliveries by *hilot* to ensure maternal and

newborn safety, and (3) the amendment of fare rates in light of the current energy and fuel crisis. She highlighted that the fare rate adjustment is the most urgent concern and stressed the need to balance the interests of transport operators and drivers with the welfare of commuters. She further underscored the importance of transparent, inclusive, and responsible governance and encouraged all stakeholders to actively and constructively participate in the discussions toward a fair and principled outcome for the benefit of the city.

A) AN ORDINANCE DECLARING AND OFFICIALLY NAMING THE PUBLIC PLAZA AND PARKS IN THE CITY OF TANDAG

OPEN FORUM:

1. Provincial Tourism Officer Marivic C. Chan suggested that fees should be added for the maintenance of comfort rooms in the public parks.
2. A concerned student of the Jacinto P. Elpa National High School raised a concern regarding the carrying of illegal firearms or weapons as well as the littering in public parks and plaza. With this, he suggested to include this concern in the penalty provision of the proposed ordinance.

Hon. Ty responded by assuring that their suggestions would be taken into consideration in the refinement and finalization of the proposed ordinance.

B) AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 3 AND 4 OF ORDINANCE NO. 04-2024 ENTITLED “PRESCRIBING FOR NEW FARE RATES FOR MOTORIZED TRICYCLES AND CENTERCAB (BAO-BAO) PASSENGERS, THIS CITY

OPEN FORUM:

Mr. Richard Mura, President of the KAMALIG Association, appealed to the City Council to take immediate action on the current plight of tricycle drivers brought about by the ongoing energy crisis, particularly the continuous increase in fuel prices, by considering an adjustment in the existing fare rates within the city.

Mr. Joselito Frada, (President, TODTOA Drivers Association): conveyed that their group is formally requesting a fare rate increase in order to mitigate the impact of the rising fuel prices on their operations.

Ms. Rosemarie, a rice retailer from Luha Public Market representing the business sector, reported a noticeable decline in the number of tricycles operating in the area since the onset of successive fuel price increases. She appealed to the City Council to address the concerns and requests of tricycle drivers and operators. However, she emphasized that any fare increase should remain fair and reasonable, ensuring it does not place an undue burden on the riding public and other sectors.

Ms. Maya Cornelio, representing Infinite FM Radio and the media sector, expressed her concurrence with the proposed fare rate increase, provided that it remains reasonable and duly justified based on the prevailing fuel prices.

Mr. Miggy Lubido, a student of Saint Theresa College representing the academe sector, inquired whether fare discounts are granted to senior citizens, persons with disabilities, and students, and requested clarification on the applicable discount rates.

Hon. Rosario Ninfa G. Dumagan II, Chairperson of the Committee on Transportation and Traffic, responded that the adjustment of the existing fare rates should no longer be put into question, as it is already timely and justified in light of the continuing increase in fuel prices. She emphasized that the Sanggunian convened the public hearing to solicit the opinions and views of stakeholders, which will serve as the basis in determining a reasonable fare rate increase for the welfare of the general public.

She further outlined the primary considerations for the proposed increase, namely: (1) the persistent rise in fuel prices; and (2) the need to establish a reasonable fare adjustment that would adequately offset the fuel expenses of tricycle operators and drivers.

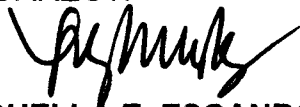

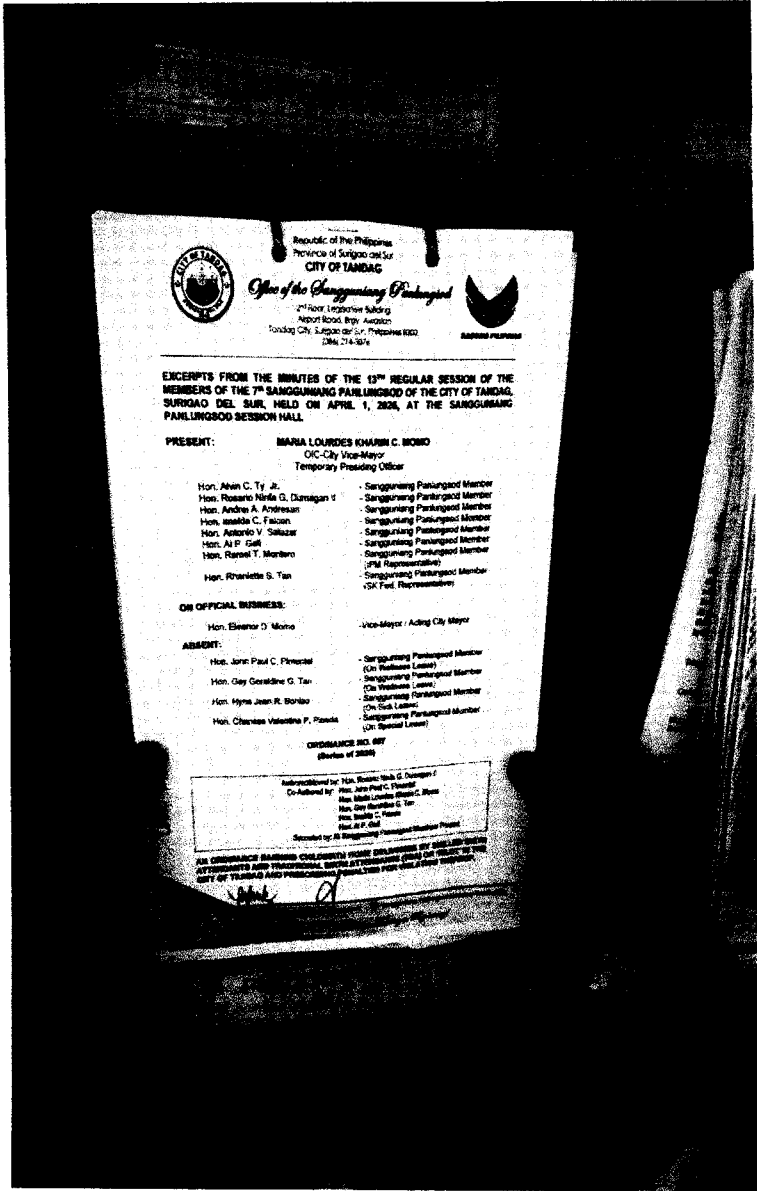
