The right of every individual to a name, a nationality, and a legal identity is a fundamental human right enshrined in the Philippine Constitution and various international human rights instruments. Despite this mandate, a significant number of Filipinos, particularly those belonging to Indigenous Peoples (IPs), marginalized sectors, and families in far-flung areas, remain unregistered and "invisible" to the state. This lack of legal documentation serves as a massive barrier, preventing our constituents from accessing essential government services, including healthcare (PhilHealth), education, social protection (4Ps), and employment opportunities.

To address this systemic gap, the Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) has launched the Birth Registration Assistance Project (BRAP). This initiative is a strategic effort to intensify the registration of births across the country, ensuring that every Filipino is included in the National



Identification System. Recognizing that the primary deterrent for many indigent families in the Municipality of Madrid is the cost associated with registration—specifically the accumulated penalties for delayed filing and various administrative fees—the Inter-Agency Committee on Civil Registration and Vital Statistics (IACCRVS) has formally recommended the total waiver of these charges to facilitate the project's success.

By enacting this Ordinance, the Municipality of Madrid aligns itself with the national goal of achieving 100% civil registration. Waiving these fees is not merely a financial concession; it is an investment in our people. It empowers the undocumented to finally claim their legal identity, ensures more accurate local data for municipal development planning, and reinforces our commitment to the principle that no Madridanon shall be left behind.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Sangguniang Bayan of the Municipality of Madrid, Province of Surigao del Sur, that:

SECTION 1. TITLE.

This Ordinance shall be known as the "Madrid BRAP Free Civil Registration Act of 2026."

SECTION 2. SCOPE AND COVERAGE.

This Ordinance shall apply to all residents of the Municipality of Madrid who are eligible under the Birth Registration Assistance Project (BRAP) criteria, including but not limited to:

- Unregistered births of marginalized individuals and indigent families;
- Indigenous Peoples (IPs) within the ancestral domains of Madrid;
- Residents in geographically isolated and disadvantaged areas (GIDA).

SECTION 3. WAIVER OF FEES AND PENALTIES.

For the duration of the BRAP implementation, the following fees and penalties collected by the Local Civil Registry Office (LCRO) of Madrid are hereby WAIVED:

- Delayed Registration Fees (Late filing penalties);

SECTION 4. IMPLEMENTATION.

The Local Civil Registrar (LCR) of Madrid is hereby mandated to:

- Verify the "No Record" status of applicants in coordination with the PSA;
- Ensure the streamlined and priority processing of all BRAP-related applications.

SECTION 5. SUNSET CLAUSE.

The waiver of fees and penalties provided under this Ordinance is temporary in nature and shall remain in effect only for the duration of the Birth Registration Assistance Project (BRAP) within the Municipality. This Ordinance shall automatically expire and cease to be in effect upon the official declaration by the Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) that the BRAP has been completed or terminated.

SECTION 6. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE.

If, for any reason, any part or provision of this Ordinance shall be held unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, other parts or provisions hereof which are not affected shall continue to be in full force and effect.

SECTION 7. REPEALING CLAUSE.

All municipal ordinances, executive orders, or local rules and regulations inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed, amended, or modified accordingly.

SECTION 8. FUNDING.

The administrative costs and the waived revenue resulting from this Ordinance shall be charged against the current appropriations of the Office of the Local Civil Registrar, General Fund or other available sources subject to accounting and auditing rules.

SECTION 9. EFFECTIVITY.

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval and compliance with the posting requirements under the Local Government Code.



