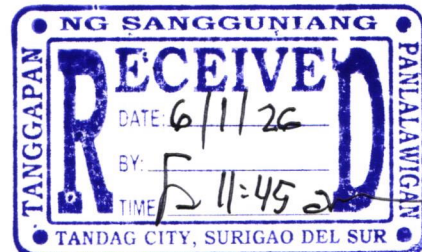

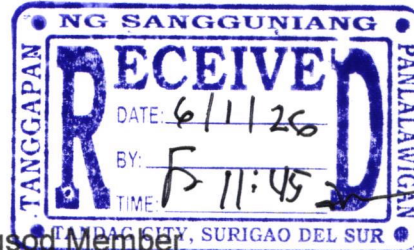

## ARTICLE I BASIC PRINCIPLES

**SECTION 1. TITLE.** This Ordinance shall be known as the **“AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 5, 6, 8, 9, 10, 13, 14, 16, 17 AND 30 OF ORDINANCE NO. 14-2015 ENTITLED ‘AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING AND REGULATING A NIGHT MARKET IN THE CITY OF TANDAG’”**.

**SECTION 2. DEFINITION OF TERMS.** As used in this ordinance, the following terms shall be construed and understood as follows:

- a) NIGHT MARKET - Refers to a government-regulated market conducted at a specific time and duration at night and located in portions of designated places or streets in the City of Tandag, and are legally and temporarily closed to vehicular traffic, for the purpose of accommodating people indulged in the business of selling goods or offering services to the public for profit.
- b) OCCUPANTS - Refers to interested persons allowed to display and sell goods or offer services after an application has been approved, a definite space has been assigned temporarily, and the nightly fee has been paid.
- c) COLLECTORS - Refers to revenue collection clerks who are properly bonded to collect fees or charges and issue corresponding receipts or cash tickets to occupants of the night market.
- d) CUSTOMER - Refers to any person buying the goods displayed or patronizing the services of the occupants in the night market of the City of Tandag.
- e) SECURITY OFFICER - Refers to the policemen, public safety officers and barangay tanods assigned to maintain peace and order in the market area.
- f) NIGHT MARKET SUPERVISORS - Refers to the personnel assigned by the City Mayor's Office who shall implement the distribution of the space to the occupant, ensure that fees are duly and promptly collected, and guarantee that sanitation and security in the areas are maintained and that regulations are strictly enforced and observed.
- g) DESIGNATED NIGHT MARKET PLACE - These are officially declared locations which could be government properties and/or portions of roads or streets legally and temporarily closed to vehicular traffic, for the purpose of accommodating the night market project of the City Government of Tandag. Location can be expanded, relocated, or transferred by the Local Government as needed.

**SECTION 3. DECLARATION OF POLICIES.** It is hereby declared that the policies of Tandag City are to:

1. Enhance small and locally owned entrepreneurs' earning capacity by trading goods, especially local produce and services;

2. Encourage the general public to further patronize local products and talents;  
and,
3. Create an avenue for the City Government to generate additional revenues.

## **ARTICLE II THE NIGHT MARKET**

**SECTION 4. LOCATION OF THE NIGHT MARKET.** While the City Government of Tandag could designate and declare legally a portion of open spaces or roads legally for the night market, the initial designated site is at the Vicente T. Pimentel Sr. Boulevard, Quezon Street in Barangay Bag-ong Lungsod.

**SECTION 5. DESIGNATED DAYS OF NIGHT MARKET.** The days of the Night Market shall be Monday to Sunday (the whole week).

**SECTION 6. DESIGNATED TIME AND DURATION OF THE NIGHT MARKET.** Installation of the paraphernalia shall be at 4:00 PM, and closing time shall be at 1:00 AM on Fridays, Saturdays, and Sundays, and at 12 midnight on Mondays, Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays. No commercial structure, paraphernalia or goods can be displayed before 4 PM, the opening time of the Night Market.

**SECTION 7. NIGHT MARKET OCCUPANTS.** Preference must be given to any voting resident of the City of Tandag. Applicant shall be qualified to sell his/her goods or offer his/her services in the night market, provided, however, that his/her application to become one has been duly approved first by the Business Permits and Licensing Division, City Mayor's Office.

**SECTION 8. APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS.** Individuals/entrepreneurs who wish to be occupants in the night market shall submit their application documents to the Business Permits and Licensing Division with the following requirements:

- 1) Community Tax Certificate
- 2) Barangay Clearance (Barangay Bag-ong Lungsod)
- 3) Health Clearance
- 4) Voter's ID/Voter's Affidavit (in case of loss)
- 5) Police Clearance

The City Government of Tandag shall, upon approval of the application, grant and issue only one (1) Night Market Permit (NMP) per applicant.

**SECTION 9. STALL ASSIGNMENT.** Upon approval of their applications, occupants in the night market shall be given a Night Market Permit (NMP) and shall be assigned to a location by the Business Permits and Licensing Division through a "drawn by lot" scheme.

Occupants shall sell their goods and/or services, as declared in their application forms, within the period specified in the contract. Failure to abide by this condition shall be sufficient cause for cancellation of their contract, and the subsequent revocation of the Night Market Permit (NMP); hence, the City Mayor's Office is entitled to award his/her space to another applicant.

**SECTION 10. DURATION OF CONTRACT, FEES, AND TIME OF PAYMENT.**

Applicants shall choose between a (a) monthly (1 month), (b) quarterly contract (3 months), and (c) bi-annual (6 months).

Rental fees shall be at (a) Php250.00, in case of a monthly contract to be collected within the first seven days of the month; (b) Php750, in case of a quarterly contract, to be collected within the first 7 days of January, April, July and October; or (c) Php1,500.00, in case of a bi-annual contract, to be collected within the first 7 days of January and July.

There shall be collected a miscellaneous fee of Php30.00 every night on top of the rental fees. Individuals/entrepreneurs with a business permit (massage, foot spa, and bike rental) shall also pay the miscellaneous fee of P30.00 for a 3x3 square meter stall/space.

Pre-termination of the contract shall be reported to the City Mayor's Office immediately.

**SECTION 11. COLLECTION OF RENTAL FEES.** The City Treasurer's Office shall deputize its collectors to collect the payment and issue corresponding cash tickets/ official receipts.

No credit is allowed. Inability to pay the rental fee on the time provided above is considered a violation of this ordinance, and the sanctions provided in this ordinance shall be levied against the occupant.

**SECTION 12. PROHIBITION ON SUBLEASING.** Subleasing is not allowed. All occupants permitted by the City Mayor's Office to do business in the night market should be the legal and rightful owner of the enterprise that will use and occupy the appropriated space for him/her.

**ARTICLE III**

**DESIGNATING OF PARKING ZONE AND/OR DECLARING ONE-WAY STREET**

**SECTION 13. PARKING ZONE.** Pursuant to Section 458(a)(5)(v) of the Local Government Code of 1991, the right-side lane of Quezon Street, Barangay Bag-Ong Lungsod, Tandag City is hereby designated as "Parking Zone" every Fridays and Saturdays from 4 p.m. to 1 a.m. (4 PM-1 AM), and Sundays to Thursdays from 4 p.m. to 12 o'clock midnight (4 PM-12MN) for Night Market.

The Task Force ATP, led by the Philippine National Police-Tandag City, shall take steps to enforce a mandatory diagonal parking at the parking zone, further separately designating four-wheeled vehicles and motorcycles.



**SECTION 14. ONE-WAY STREET.** In view of the parking zone designated as above, and to further bolster the regulation of traffic flow, the whole stretch of Quezon Street, Barangay Bag-ong Lungsod, Tandag City is hereby declared as "One-Way Flow" for vehicular traffic passage from the corner of National Highway to San Nicolas Street, Barangay Bag-ong Lungsod, Tandag City, every Friday and Saturday from 4 p.m. to 1 a.m. (4 PM-1 AM), and Sundays from 4 p.m. to 12 o'clock midnight (4 PM-12MN).

**ARTICLE IV  
INSTALLATION, DISPLAY AND REMOVAL OF GOODS AND OTHER  
PARAPHERNALIA**

**SECTION 15. INSTALLATION AND DISPLAY OF GOODS.** Occupants can only install and display their goods and other market paraphernalia within their designated area. No commercial structure, paraphernalia or goods can be displayed in the market site and/or along any streets, road rights-of-way, or any government sites. Failure to comply shall be a ground for the immediate removal of the goods by the Tandag City Police Office.

**SECTION 16. KIND OF MATERIALS AND MAXIMUM AREA FOR OCCUPANCY.** Only light structures and materials that could be easily folded, lifted, and removed should be installed. The occupants shall be responsible for the lighting of their respective stalls. However, the City Government, if deemed necessary, shall provide for the electrical installation, subject to payment of fees.

Each occupant shall be allowed to rent a 3x3 square meter stall/space. A maximum of three (3) stalls/space shall be allowed for each occupant with a business permit (massage, foot spa, and bike rental).

**SECTION 17. ALLOWABLE SERVICES AND GOODS FOR DISPLAY AND VENDING.** The following goods and services shall be allowed:

1. Used clothing
2. Used footwear
3. Used bags
4. Native delicacies (e.g., puto, budbud, hagikhik, etc.)
5. Pica-pica food & refreshments (e.g. siomai, mani, balut penoy, etc.)
6. Handicrafts/Native Products/Souvenir items
7. Other related goods and/or services upon approval of the City Mayor's Office

**SECTION 18. THE NIGHT MARKET SECTIONS.** For purposes of order and aesthetics, the dry goods section of the night market shall be arranged in sections by the City Engineer's Office.

**SECTION 19. SELLING OF GOODS AND SERVICES.** Occupants and their respective sales personnel and helpers must wear an identification card duly issued by the City Government of Tandag when they are in the premises of the night market and are actively involved in the selling of their goods or services.

The identification card shall reflect the picture and name of the bearer clearly legible. The City Mayor's Office shall determine the size, design and other necessary information needed to be written on the ID.

**SECTION 20. REMOVAL OF GOODS AND COMMERCIAL PARAPHERNALIA.**

All materials installed and/or displayed at the night market must be completely removed and cleared on or before closing time.

No structures, paraphernalia and goods of any part shall be left within the site of the night market, along any streets, road-rights-of-way and/or in any publicly owned sites.

**ARTICLE V  
CLEANLINESS AND SANITATION**

**SECTION 21. RESPONSIBILITY OF THE OCCUPANTS.** It is the duty and obligation of the occupants to maintain the cleanliness and sanitation of their premises.

**SECTION 22. PROPER DISPOSAL OF SOLID WASTE.** For convenient collection by garbage trucks, occupants are hereby obliged to observe proper segregation of solid waste and to place their garbage in separate disposable containers, properly labeled either "MALATA" or "DI MALATA", with their top openings tied or sealed to avoid scattering or spillage.

No solid waste shall be thrown into the drainage canals situated inside or in the surroundings of the night market.

**SECTION 23. DRYNESS OF THE AREA.** To avoid foul odor and unclean surroundings, occupants must maintain dryness in their respective areas.

**SECTION 24. PROPER DISPOSAL OF LIQUID WASTE.** Liquid waste must be placed in a separate container, which shall be properly labeled "LIQUID WASTE", with its top opening tied or sealed to avoid spillage.

**ARTICLE VI  
PEACE AND ORDER**

**SECTION 25. SECURITY OFFICERS.** While it is understood that occupants are to avoid unruly behavior, the City Government of Tandag, however, shall seek assistance from the Philippine National Police, in addition to the representative designated by the Chief Executive and the tanods of Barangay Bag-ong Lungsod for the purpose of maintaining the security, peace and order of the place.

**SECTION 26. DUTY OF NIGHT MARKET SUPERVISORS IN CASE OF EMERGENCIES.** In case of emergency or fire conflagration in the vicinity of the night market area, the night market supervisor(s), in coordination with the Task Force, shall inform the occupants of such incidents and advise the latter to speedily remove or, if needed, abandon their structures and valuables and hastily clear the road for the passage of firefighting units.



**ARTICLE VII  
ENFORCEMENT AND PENALTIES**

**SECTION 27. DISCUSSIONS, TRAININGS AND WORKSHOPS.** Vendors shall be required to attend discussions, trainings and workshops duly called for by the City Government of Tandag, such as but not limited to Food Handling and Health Awareness and Solid Waste Management.

**SECTION 28. ORGANIZATION AND MEETINGS.** Night vendors shall be organized. There shall be a regular meeting to be conducted between the vendors and the City Government to monitor and evaluate the operations.

**SECTION 29. ESTABLISHMENT OF TASK FORCE.** There shall be established a Task Force for the effective operation, monitoring, evaluation and implementation of rules in the night market.

**SECTION 30. PENAL CLAUSE.** The following prohibited acts shall be imposed with corresponding penalties, to wit:

Non-payment of fees at the time of payment provided above	One (1) week suspension of Night Market Permit
Non-operation of the occupant for three (3) consecutive nights without a valid cause	Revocation of the occupant's Night Market Permit
Violation of Article II, Section 9 on Subleasing (after due notice and hearing)	Suspension for one (1) month pending investigation Upon conviction, revocation of the occupant's NMP
Violation of Article IV, Section 6 on Non-Removal of Goods and Paraphernalia	1st Offense: Fine of P500 2nd Offense: Revocation of occupant's NMP and Removal of Goods and Paraphernalia from site
Violation of Article V on Improper disposal of solid and liquid wastes (Vendors)	1st Offense: Fine of P500 2nd Offense: Fine of P1,000 3rd Offense: Revocation of occupant's NMP and Removal of Goods and Paraphernalia from site
Violation of Article V on Improper disposal of solid and liquid wastes (Consumers)	1st Offense: Fine of P300 2nd Offense: Fine of P500 3rd and Subsequent Offenses: Fine of P1,000 and Community Service for 3 hours

**ARTICLE VIII  
FINAL PROVISIONS**

**SECTION 31. REPEALING CLAUSE.** Sections 5, 6, 8, 9, 10, 13, 14, 16, 17, and 30 of Ordinance No. 14-2015 and other issuances that are inconsistent with any of the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

**SECTION 32. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE.** If any provision of this ordinance or the application thereof to any persons or circumstances is held invalid, the remainder of this ordinance, and the application of such provision to other persons or circumstances, shall not be affected thereby.

**SECTION 33. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE.** This ordinance shall take effect in full and immediately upon its approval unless otherwise suspended by the proper authorities.





### III. ROLL CALL


Eleven (12) SP Members were physically present; one was on official business, while one was absent. Therefore, there were twelve (12) SP Members in total, including the Presiding Officer. The Presiding Officer, Hon. Eleanor D. Momo, then declared a quorum.

### IV. WORDS OF WELCOME/RATIONALE: Hon. Eleanor D. Momo, City Vice Mayor/Presiding Officer

City Vice Mayor Eleanor D. Momo warmly welcomed all attendees to the 2nd Public Hearing and acknowledged the presence of the City Mayor, members of the Sangguniang Panlungsod, barangay officials, and the public. She emphasized that the event reflects the legislative body's collective efforts to review and deliberate on ordinances that significantly affect the lives of Tandaganons.

She highlighted the four proposed ordinances presented during the hearing, namely: the Septage and Sewerage Ordinance, which aims to promote proper sanitation and public health; the Anti-Sexual Harassment Ordinance, which seeks to prevent and address incidents of harassment while strengthening protective mechanisms; the amendment to the Children's Welfare Code, intended to enhance child protection and access to services; and the amendment to the Night Market Ordinance, designed to balance economic activity with public order, safety, and quality of life.

The Vice Mayor underscored the importance of public participation, encouraging attendees to actively engage in the open forum by asking questions and sharing their insights and concerns. She stressed that community feedback is essential in crafting responsive and inclusive legislation. She concluded by calling for unity, transparency, cooperation, and shared responsibility in decision-making, recognizing that diverse perspectives contribute to better outcomes for the community.

- Sanitation Inspector **Nerio Japson** of the City Health Office raised a concern about the proper management and treatment of sewerage and septic or wastewater systems in private establishments, noting that the City currently lacks a centralized sewerage treatment facility for the disposal of liquid and solid waste.

In response, **Hon. Geli** assured that the City Government is working to establish a wastewater treatment facility in the near future. In the meantime, he emphasized that restaurants and other establishments shall be required to provide their own individual wastewater treatment systems. He further stressed that now that the locality has attained cityhood, the strict implementation of sanitation and environmental regulations must be enforced.

3. **An Ordinance Amending Sections 5, 6, 9, 10, 13, 14, 17, And 30 Of Ordinance No. 14-2015 Entitled "An Ordinance Establishing And Regulating A Night Market In The City Of Tandag"**

**OPEN FORUM:**

1. **Ms. Catherine Gilvosa**, representative of TACHARA, proposed on behalf of the *Atong Tiangge Panggabii (ATP) Vendors* the inclusion in the proposed amendments to the Night Market Ordinance of a provision designating a specific area for the consumption of food and other products purchased from ATP vendors at the boulevard, in order to help minimize littering.

**Hon. Dumagan** responded that patrons of ATP stalls should consume their purchases within the respective stalls where the items were bought, and not along the sea dike or seawall. She further assured the Body that the concern would be taken into consideration during the committee hearing, with the participation of the City Treasurer, the Business Permit and Licensing Officer, and the City Tourism Officer.

**Hon. Charisse Valentine Pineda** likewise expressed support for the proposal and suggested the establishment of a designated area equipped with tables and chairs for the convenience of customers.

2. **Ms. Jocelyn Layno**, an ATP vendor, raised a concern regarding the collection of solid waste at the City Boulevard. She conveyed, on behalf of the ATP vendors, that in support of the City Government's waste management efforts, they have agreed to shoulder the cost of hiring a garbage collector to manage their waste. She likewise expressed appreciation to Hon. Dumagan for her initiatives in addressing their concerns.

**Hon. Dumagan** responded that the matter will be taken into consideration and assured that appropriate implementing rules and guidelines will be crafted to effectively address the concerns raised by the vendors.

4. **An Ordinance Declaring Sexual Harassment Unlawful In The Employment, Education Or Training Environment, Defining Gender-Based Sexual Harassment In Streets, Public Spaces, Online, Providing Protective Measures And Prescribing Penalties Therefor, Also Known As "Respeto Sa Tandaganon Ordinance"**

**OPEN FORUM:** *No concerns or objections were raised on the proposed measure.*

#### VI. CLOSING REMARKS:

**Hon. John Paul C. Pimentel** expressed his gratitude to all Sangguniang Panlungsod Members, the SP Secretary, and all participants for the success of the activity. He emphasized that the proposed ordinances are crafted for the welfare of the constituents and underscored that it is the fundamental role of the councilors to enact measures for the common good.

There being no further matters to discuss, the public hearing was adjourned at 4:20 p.m.
