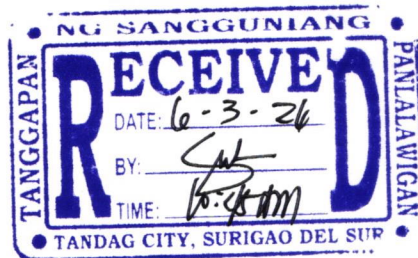

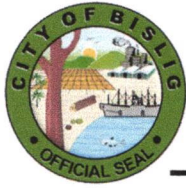

“RECOMMENDING TO THE CITY DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL THE AFFIRMATION OF THE SUPPLEMENTAL ANNUAL INVESTMENT PROGRAM NO. 6 CALENDAR YEAR 2026 AMOUNTING TO FORTY-EIGHT MILLION SEVEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-EIGHT THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED PESOS (PHP 48,778,300.00)

AND ENDORSING THE SAME TO THE SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD (SP) FOR APPROVAL”

WHEREAS, the Local Government Code of 1991 mandates the preparation and adoption of an Annual Investment Program (AIP) as a basis for the formulation of the annual budget;

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Bislig, in its regular session on June 3, 2025 duly adopted the AIP for Calendar Year (CY) 2026 through Resolution No. 2025-289 “Resolution adopting the Annual Investment Program (AIP) CY 2026 of the City of Bislig”;

WHEREAS, there is an urgent need to formulate Supplemental AIP No. 6 to include various Programs, Projects, and Activities (PPAs) funded under the General Fund (GF) and the 20% Economic Development Fund (EDF) which were duly appropriated in the regular budget but were inadvertently omitted in the original CY 2026 AIP;

WHEREAS, it is likewise necessary to augment the AIP allocation for certain existing PPAs, considering that the actual appropriations exceeded the original amount reflected in the previously approved CY 2026 AIP;

WHEREAS, the Supplemental AIP includes the prioritization of programs, projects, and activities in response to the current needs of the city and to ensure the efficient delivery of services to its intended beneficiaries;

WHEREAS, the said Supplemental AIP was reviewed by the CDC-EXECOM and found consistent with the development thrusts and goals of the City of Bislig;

WHEREAS, during the deliberation of the committee, it was emphasized that the endorsement and implementation of specific proposals herein are contingent upon the submission of comprehensive Project Briefs by the respective proponents to the City Planning and Development Office (CPDO);

NOW THEREFORE, on motion of Hon. Victor B. Alvar, Jr. and duly seconded by Mr. Rolan R. Ugmad, **BE IT RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED** to recommend to the CDC Full Council for affirmation and to endorse the same to the Sangguniang Panlungsod for approval.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that the endorsement of the aforementioned Programs, Projects, and Activities (PPAs) is SUBJECT TO THE CONDITION that the respective proponents shall submit a Project Brief to the City Planning and Development Office (CPDO) to ensure alignment and detailed documentation prior to the implementation of the projects.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that copies of this resolution be furnished to all concerned offices for their information and appropriate action.
