MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME  
TO FILE PETITION FOR REVIEW

PETITIONER MUNICIPALITY OF TAGO, by and through the undersigned counsel, unto this Honorable Court of Appeals, most respectfully states:

1. On April 16, 2026, Petitioner received the Decision of the Regional Trial Court (RTC), 11th Judicial Region, Branch 41, Cantilan, Surigao del Sur, in Civil Case No. 2041-24, which affirmed Sangguniang Panlalawigan Resolution No. 1557-24 (Series of 2024) in favor of Respondent City of Tandag;
2. On May 4, 2026, Petitioner timely filed a Motion for Reconsideration before the RTC;
3. On May 20, 2026, Petitioner received through its official electronic mail address the RTC Order denying the aforementioned Motion for Reconsideration. A printed copy of the said Order, together with the electronic mail transmission

4. The RTC ruling sought to be reviewed was rendered in the exercise of its **appellate jurisdiction**<sup>1</sup>, considering that the **Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Surigao del Sur**<sup>2</sup> had taken cognizance of the boundary dispute between the parties, and the case was thereafter elevated to the RTC pursuant to the Local Government Code;
5. Pursuant to **Section 1, Rule 42 of the Rules of Court**, it is provided that:

*Section 1. How appeal taken; time for filing. – A party desiring to appeal from a decision of the Regional Trial Court rendered in the exercise of its appellate jurisdiction may file a verified petition for review with the Court of Appeals, paying at the same time to the clerk of said court the corresponding docket and other lawful fees, depositing the amount of P500.00 for costs, and furnishing the Regional Trial Court and the adverse party with a copy of the petition. The petition shall be filed and served within fifteen (15) days from notice of the decision sought to be reviewed or of the denial of petitioner's motion for new trial or reconsideration filed in due time after judgment. Upon proper motion and the payment of the full amount of the docket and other lawful fees and the deposit for costs before the expiration of the reglementary period, the Court of Appeals may grant an additional period of fifteen (15) days only within which to file the petition for review. No further extension shall be granted except for the most compelling reason and in no case to exceed fifteen (15) days. (n) [Emphasis and Underscoring added]*

6. Counting from **May 20, 2026**, Petitioner has until **June 04, 2026** within which to file the Petition for Review;
7. Petitioner respectfully seeks an **additional period of fifteen (15) days**, or until **June 19, 2026**, within which to file the Petition for Review, for the following just reasons:

- a. Additional time is necessary to finalize and verify the Petition for Review and to gather, collate, and complete the documentary annexes required under the Rules. The case involves voluminous records spanning more than two decades of administrative and judicial proceedings, including historical documents, cadastral maps, survey plans, technical descriptions, and pertinent rulings that require careful review, collation, and synthesis to ensure that the issues are accurately and comprehensively presented before this Honorable Court. Likewise, time is needed to secure clearly legible duplicate originals or certified true copies of the assailed RTC Decision and Order, as well as certified true copies of the material portions of the record and supporting documents that will be cited and relied upon in the Petition; and
  - b. Additional time is likewise necessary as the matter of pursuing the present appeal is scheduled for deliberation by the Sangguniang Bayan of Tago. The Sanggunian is expected to convene and act on the matter, and Petitioner respectfully requires additional time pending the completion of such proceedings so that the results thereof may be duly considered in the preparation and finalization of the Petition for Review. *A copy of the Certification issued by the Secretary to the Sangguniang Bayan is attached hereto and made an integral part hereof as Annex "B".*
8. This Motion is filed within the reglementary period. The requested extension is sought in good faith and not for purposes of delay, but solely to afford Petitioner sufficient opportunity to prepare and file a complete and compliant Petition for Review;
  9. Simultaneously with the filing of this Motion, Petitioner is paying the full amount of the appellate court docket and other lawful fees and depositing the amount required for costs. *The corresponding Official Receipts evidencing such payments are attached hereto as Annex "C" and made integral parts hereof.*

## PRAYER

WHEREFORE, premises considered, Petitioner respectfully prays that it be granted an **extension of fifteen (15) days from June 04, 2026, or until June 19, 2026**, within which to file the **Petition for Review under Rule 42 of the Rules of Court**.

Other reliefs just and equitable are likewise prayed for.

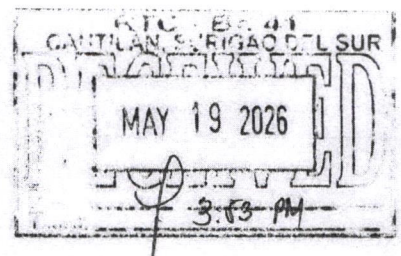

**ORDER**

Before this Court is the Motion for Reconsideration filed by petitioner-appellant Municipality of Tago seeking reconsideration of the Decision dated April 15, 2026 which affirmed Resolution No. 1557-24 of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Surigao del Sur.

Respondent-appellee City of Tandag filed its Comment/Opposition thereto praying for the denial of the motion for lack of merit.

After careful consideration, the Court finds no cogent reason to disturb its assailed Decision.

The issues raised in the Motion for Reconsideration merely reiterate the same arguments already thoroughly discussed and resolved in the Decision dated April 15, 2026, particularly on: (1) the standard of review applicable to the findings of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan; (2) the alleged evidentiary value of the purported 1919 Joint Resolution; and (3) the probative weight of the 1967 Tandag Cadastral Map and related technical records.

The Court remains convinced that the findings of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan, acting within its quasi-judicial authority under Sections 118 and 119 of the Local Government Code, are supported by substantial evidence. Settled jurisprudence holds that factual findings of administrative and quasi-judicial bodies are accorded great respect and even finality when supported by substantial evidence. Judicial review does not authorize the Court to conduct an entirely fresh determination of the controversy absent a clear showing of grave misappreciation of facts, arbitrariness, or misapplication of law.

Petitioner-appellant's insistence that the Court should have independently weighed the evidence under the rule on preponderance of evidence is misplaced. The assailed Decision did not disregard petitioner-appellant's evidence; rather, the Court found the same insufficient to overcome the superior evidentiary value of the official cadastral surveys, technical records, and governmental acts relied upon by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan.

Neither does the Court find merit in petitioner-appellant's reliance on the alleged 1919 Joint Resolution. As correctly discussed in the assailed Decision, said document was never properly authenticated and formally established in the proceedings before the Sangguniang Panlalawigan. The Court likewise finds unpersuasive petitioner-appellant's invocation of supposed "judicial admissions" arising from Resolution No. 88-81 and other prior references to the alleged document. Such references do not dispense with the requirement of competent authentication under the Rules on Evidence, nor can municipal resolutions independently establish or amend territorial boundaries fixed by law.

The Court likewise remains unconvinced by petitioner-appellant's attack on the 1967 Tandag Cadastre and its reliance on the "Critical Date Doctrine." The notation "claimed by the Municipality of Tago" merely acknowledges the existence of an adverse claim during the survey process. It is not an adjudication recognizing petitioner-appellant's territorial jurisdiction. Said annotation does not negate the official and technical character of the cadastral survey nor erase the presumption of regularity attaching to official governmental technical records.

The Court further agrees with respondent-appellee that the Motion for Reconsideration merely rehashes matters already passed upon by both the Sangguniang Panlalawigan and this Court. No  
2 new evidence, supervening event, or palpable error of law or fact


has been shown which would warrant the reversal or modification of the assailed Decision.

**WHEREFORE**, premises considered, the Motion for Reconsideration filed by petitioner-appellant Municipality of Tago is hereby **DENIED** for lack of merit.

Accordingly, the Decision dated April 15, 2026 stands.


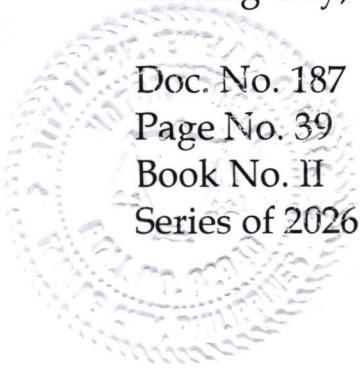


