

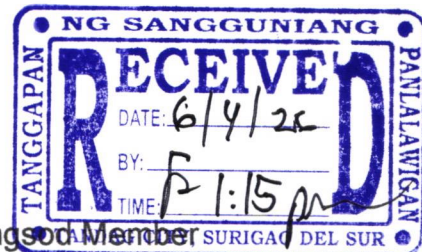

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD OF THE CITY OF TANDAG, PROVINCE OF SURIGAO DEL SUR:

SECTION 1. TITLE.

This Ordinance shall be known as the ***“INSTITUTIONALIZING THE EXPANDED CCTV INSTALLATION SYSTEM IN THE CITY OF TANDAG TO STRENGTHEN PUBLIC SAFETY, DISASTER MONITORING, AND EMERGENCY RESPONSE OPERATIONS, AND PROVIDING FUNDS THEREFOR”***.

SECTION 2. DECLARATION OF POLICY.

It is hereby declared the policy of the City Government of Tandag to promote public safety, disaster preparedness, crime prevention, and efficient emergency response through the use of modern monitoring technologies, including Closed-Circuit Television (CCTV) systems strategically installed in key areas within the city.

SECTION 3. LEGAL BASIS.

This Ordinance is enacted pursuant to the provisions of:

- Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991;
- Republic Act No. 10121, otherwise known as the Philippine Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Act of 2010;
- Relevant policies and directives of the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG) on local government public safety and disaster preparedness.

SECTION 4. INSTITUTIONALIZATION OF THE EXPANDED CCTV INSTALLATION PROGRAM.

There is hereby institutionalized the Expanded CCTV Installation System in the City of Tandag to provide a comprehensive, city-wide monitoring system aimed at improving disaster risk management, emergency response, and peace and order operations.

SECTION 5. COVERAGE OF CCTV INSTALLATION.

The Expanded CCTV Installation System shall prioritize installation of CCTV cameras in the following areas:

1. Major roads, intersections, and traffic-prone areas;
2. Public markets, transport terminals, and commercial districts;
3. Public parks, plazas, and open public spaces;
4. Government offices and public facilities;
5. Schools, health facilities, and evacuation centers;
6. Coastal areas, flood-prone zones, landslide-prone areas, and other disaster-prone locations;
7. Critical infrastructures and other strategic areas as determined by the City Government.



SECTION 6. SUPERVISING OFFICE.

The City Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office (CDRRMO) shall serve as the lead implementing office for the Expanded CCTV Installation System.

The CDRRMO shall coordinate with the following offices and agencies:

- Tandag City Police Station (PNP)
- City Engineering Office
- City Information and Communications Technology (ICT) Unit
- City Planning and Development Office
- Barangay Local Government Units
- Other relevant government agencies upon execution of a data sharing agreement.

SECTION 7. CCTV MONITORING AND CONTROL CENTER.

All CCTV systems installed under this program shall be connected, whenever feasible, to a centralized monitoring system, such as the Tandag City Operation 911 Command Center or other designated monitoring facility of the City Government.

The monitoring center shall operate twenty-four (24) hours daily to ensure real-time monitoring and prompt response.

SECTION 8. DATA PRIVACY AND SECURITY.

All CCTV installations and operations shall comply with the provisions of Republic Act No. 10173 (Data Privacy Act of 2012) and other applicable laws and regulations regarding privacy, security, and the proper use of recorded data.

Access to CCTV recordings shall be restricted to authorized personnel and may only be used for legitimate purposes such as public safety, law enforcement, disaster response, and official investigations.

SECTION 9. MAINTENANCE AND UPGRADING.

The City Government shall ensure the regular maintenance, upgrading, and proper operation of all CCTV systems installed under this program.

The CDRRMO and the concerned technical offices shall conduct periodic evaluation to ensure the effectiveness and reliability of the monitoring system.



SECTION 10. FUNDING.

Funding for the implementation of the Expanded CCTV Installation Program shall be sourced from:

- The City Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Fund (CDRRMF);
- The General Fund of the City Government;
- Grants, donations, or assistance from national government agencies or development partners.

The necessary appropriations for its continuous operation and expansion shall be included in the Annual Investment Plan and Annual Budget of the City Government.

SECTION 11. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE.

If any provision of this Ordinance is declared unconstitutional or invalid, the remaining provisions not affected thereby shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 12. REPEALING CLAUSE.

All ordinances, resolutions, rules, and regulations inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 13. EFFECTIVITY.

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon approval.

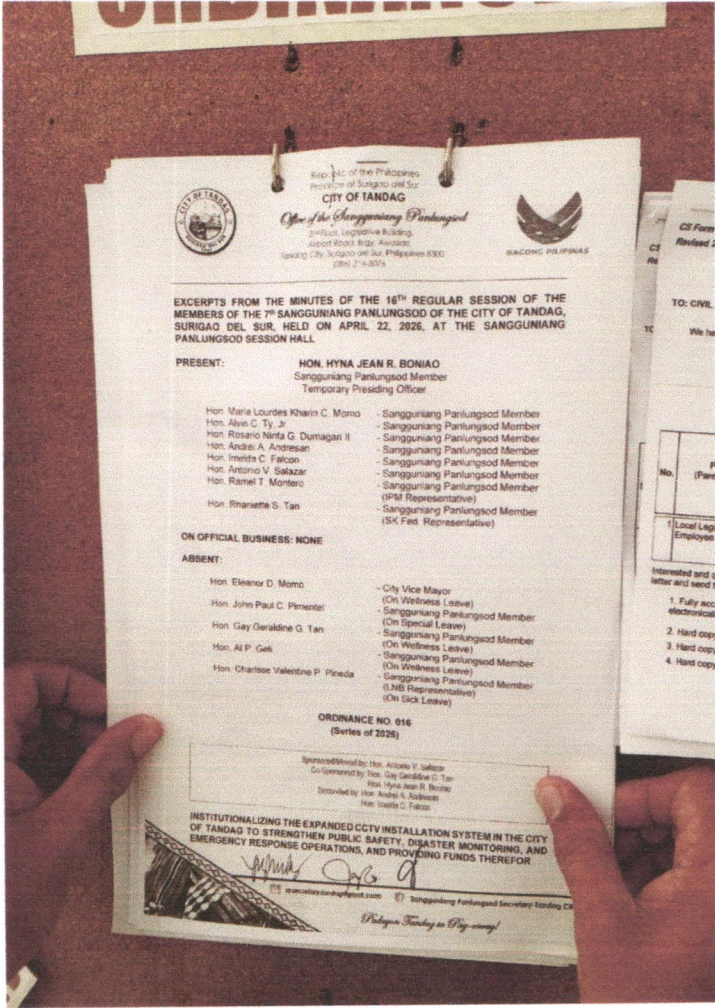

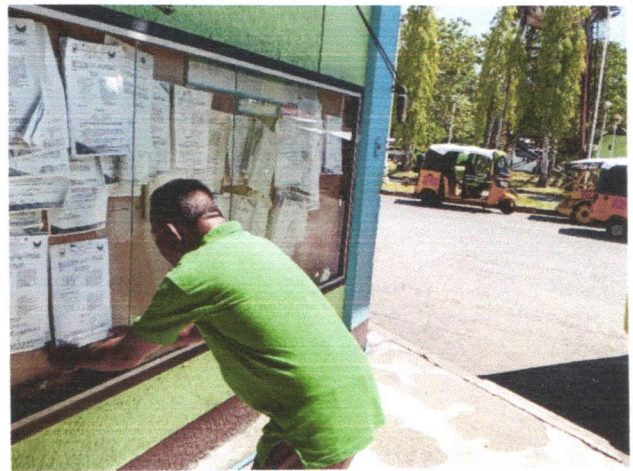

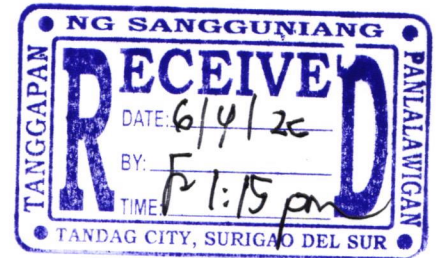
