Pursuant to existing budgeting, accounting, and auditing rules and regulations, I respectfully submit for your consideration and approval the proposed Supplemental Budget No. 02 to fund priority programs, projects, and activities necessary for effective governance and the delivery of basic services to our constituents.

This Supplemental Budget No. 02 is proposed to cover the following:

- 1. Construction of Entrance Canopy – Multipurpose Building at the Municipal Grounds and Construction of Multipurpose Building at Pamian, Bogak**
To improve accessibility, safety, and functionality of the multipurpose facility for public use.
- 2. Counterpart Funding for the Construction of the Bureau of Fire Protection (BFP) Building**
To support the completion of the BFP building and strengthen fire protection services in the Municipality.
- 3. Installation of One (1) Unit 37.5 KVA Transformer for the BFP**
To ensure a stable and adequate power supply necessary for continuous emergency operations.
- 4. Repair and Maintenance of Municipal Building**
To preserve and improve the condition of government facilities for efficient public service.
- 5. Repair and Maintenance of Sound System**
To ensure functionality during official functions, public announcements, and community activities.
- 6. Purchase of LED Wall Stand**
To enhance communication, public information dissemination, and conduct of municipal events.
- 7. Supplies and Materials for the Mayor's Office**
To support daily administrative operations and delivery of services.
- 8. Counterpart for KALAHI (Supplies and Materials)**
To assist in the implementation of community-driven development projects under the KALAHI program.
- 9. Supplies and Materials for the Purchase of Toilet Bowl for the Municipal Health Office (ZOD)**
To improve sanitation facilities and support health service delivery.
- 10. Additional Funding for Socio-Cultural Activities**
To promote cultural development, tourism, and community engagement.
- 11. Supplies and Materials, Fuel, Oil, and Lubricants for Environmental and Other Operations**
To sustain field operations and environmental programs of the Municipality.

12. Statutory and Mandatory Obligations

Allocation for mandatory requirements, including:

- Five Percent (5%) Municipal Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Fund (MDRRMF)
- Five Percent (5%) Gender and Development (GAD) Fund
- One Percent (1%) for Senior Citizens and Persons with Disabilities (PWD)



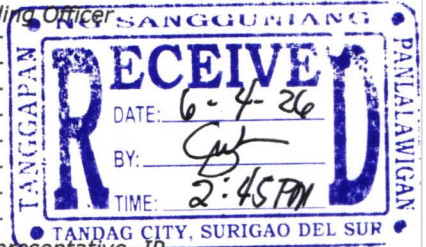





Section 5. Effectivity. The provisions of this Appropriation Ordinance shall take effect immediately.




