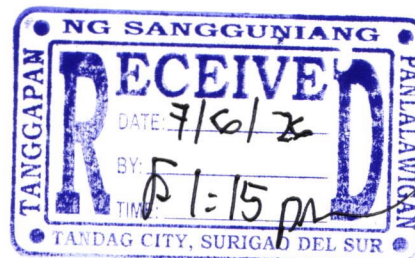

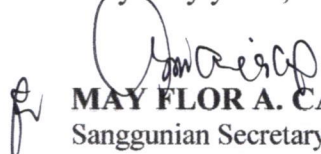

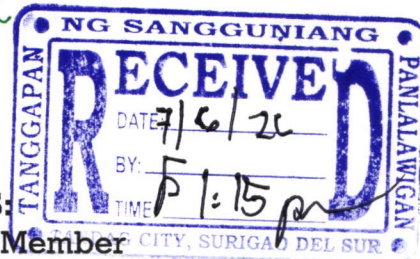

ACTIVITIES (PPAs) UNDER THE CY 2021-2025 TWENTY PERCENT (20%)
DEVELOPMENT FUND OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF BAROBO, SURIGAO
DEL SUR ABANDONED AND DECLARING THE FUNDS APPERTAINING
THERETO AVAILABLE FOR REPROGRAMMING, SUBJECT TO
EXISTING LAWS, RULES, AND REGULATIONS"**

WHEREAS, Section 16 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, grants local government units the authority to exercise powers necessary, appropriate, and incidental for effective governance and for the promotion of general welfare;

WHEREAS, the Twenty Percent (20%) Development Fund must be utilized and administered in accordance with applicable budgeting, accounting, and auditing laws, rules, and regulations, including issuances of the Commission on Audit (COA);

WHEREAS, during the audit of the Municipality of Barobo, Surigao del Sur, the Commission on Audit (COA) observed that certain Programs, Projects, and Activities (PPAs) under the CY 2021–2025 Twenty Percent (20%) Development Fund were realigned without undergoing the required formal abandonment process;

WHEREAS, in compliance with COA findings and applicable rules and regulations, the Municipal Development Council (MDC) passed **MDC Resolution No. 04, S. 2026, entitled: “Abandoning Certain Programs, Projects, and Activities (PPAs) Under the CY 2021–2025 Twenty Percent (20%) Development Fund of the Municipality of Barobo, Surigao del Sur,”** and endorsed the same to the Sangguniang Bayan for appropriate legislative action;

WHEREAS, upon review, evaluation, and validation, certain PPAs under the 20% Development Fund have been determined to be no longer feasible, necessary, or responsive to current development priorities due to changes in circumstances, implementation constraints, right-of-way issues, duplication of funding, or realignment of priorities;

WHEREAS, the abandonment of such PPAs is necessary to ensure efficient, effective, and lawful utilization of public funds and to allow the reprogramming of appropriations to more urgent and priority development projects of the Municipality;

WHEREAS, during the Regular Session of the Sangguniang Bayan held on March 12, 2026, the Honorable Members, after due deliberation, found merit in adopting the said MDC Resolution in order to comply with COA recommendations and to ensure proper fiscal management, transparency, and accountability.

NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Sangguniang Bayan of Barobo, Surigao del Sur, in session, **THAT:**

SECTION 1. Title. This Ordinance shall be known as the “**Ordinance Adopting the Abandonment of Certain Programs, Projects, and Activities (PPAs) under the CY 2021–2025 Twenty Percent (20%) Development Fund of the Municipality of Barobo.**”

SECTION 2. Declaration of Abandonment. The Programs, Projects, and Activities (PPAs) identified by the Municipal Development Council through MDC Resolution No. 04, Series of 2026, and enumerated in Section 3 hereof, are hereby declared **ABANDONED**.

SECTION 3. Abandonment of PPAs. The Programs, Projects, and Activities (PPAs) enumerated below are hereby declared **ABANDONED** and shall no longer be implemented under their original appropriation; viz:

SECTION 4. Justification for the Abandonment of PPAs. Below are the respective justifications for the abandonment of the subject Programs, Projects, and Activities (PPAs) under the 20% Development Fund of this Local Government Unit:

Justification for Abandonment:

Name of PPAs	Justification for Abandonment
Acquisition of Lot for Sanitary Landfill	Target area for Sanitary Landfill is not yet assessed by technical personnel for its suitability and possible environmental impact.
Construction of Multipurpose Waste Processing Building (Phase 2)	Additional investment in infrastructure in Ecopark has yet to be determined due to a more pressing concern to establish a sanitary landfill.
Equity to Kalahi-CIDSS-National Community Driven Devt Program	Currently, Barobo is on Phase 3 of KaLaHi-CIDSS implementation which requires specific projects and not just equity.
Equity to Externally Funded Projects - Construction of Municipal Double "A" Slaughterhouse in Barangay Javier	Currently, there is still no update from DA-PRDP as to the funding of the project which would require 10% equity from the LGU beneficiary. So instead the funds be on standby, it is more vital to use the funds to more pressing concerns.
Concreting of Poblacion - Dapdap Bypass Road (Phase 3)	The funds allocated are not enough to cover the most challenging part of the road section. It requires additional funds.
Cabacungan - Procurement of Lot for Barangay Site Expansion	There is an issue with the ownership of land which constrains the barangay to acquiring it following legal guidelines and regulations.
Rehabilitation/ Improvement of Roads and Bridges	There is an allocation for the same road sections in CY 2026 as this is an annual target of the municipal government in order to ensure passable roads, especially in far-flung barangays.

Construction of Barangay Health Center at Guinhalinan, Barobo, Surigao del Sur	Guinhalinan is a recipient of the DILG-SBDP funding for the same project worth 6 million pesos. Funds originally appropriated for the same project can be used to other priority projects.
Rehabilitation of Barobo Municipal Public Market (Roofing)	There is an allocation for the Barobo Municipal Public Market in CY 2026 which also covers its roofing problems.
Rehabilitation of Women's Comfort Room at Barobo Municipal Police Station	The concern of the Barobo Municipal Police Station regarding their existing comfort room has already been resolved with a lower cost. And so, this funds may be used to other more important projects.
Improvement of Barangay Covered Court (Stage) at Sua, Barobo, Surigao del Sur	Sua has recently received a new multi-purpose covered court from DPWH.
Establishment of Water System (San Roque)	There is a need to streamline the development of potable water source between San Roque, Gamut, Cabacungan, Sua, and Unidad. Therefore, allocating funds for San Roque would eliminate the chance of solving the water problem comprehensively.
San Roque - Improvement of Barangay Water System	
CLUP Revision and Updating	A possible grant for the updating of CLUP is currently in line. However, a more detailed topographic study of the municipality is necessary for the partnership.
Construction of Bogac Information Building	Additional funding is necessary for a GAD-responsive and climate-resilient infrastructure which may also be used as ticket-booth
Construction of Bogac Diving Platform and Riverbank Protection	A more comprehensive proposal was submitted to TIEZA and is awaiting funding which encompasses the development of Bogac including its riverbank protection and diving area.

SECTION 5. Reprogramming of Funds. The total amount of ₱51,149,876.73 corresponding to the abandoned PPAs is hereby declared available for reallocation, reprogramming, or re-identification to other priority programs, projects, and activities of the Municipality, subject to existing budgeting, accounting, procurement, and auditing laws, rules, and regulations.

SECTION 6. Compliance with Laws and COA Findings. This Ordinance is enacted in compliance with COA audit observations requiring formal abandonment of PPAs prior to any realignment or reprogramming of funds and in accordance with applicable provisions of Republic Act No. 7160 and other relevant laws, rules, and regulations.

SECTION 7. Implementing Offices. The Municipal Mayor, through the Municipal Planning and Development Coordinator, Municipal Budget Officer, Municipal Accountant, and Municipal Treasurer, shall ensure the proper implementation of this Ordinance.

SECTION 8. Separability Clause. If any provision of this Ordinance is declared invalid or unconstitutional, the remaining provisions shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 9. Repealing Clause. All ordinances, resolutions, and issuances inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 10. Effectivity. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon approval and compliance with posting and publication requirements under existing laws.

WHEREAS, Section 107 of RA 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code (LGC) of 1991 provides for the composition of a multi-sectoral body known as the Local Development Council (LDC) which is tasked to assist the Sangguniang Bayan in setting the direction of the economic and social development and coordinates the development efforts of the municipality;

WHEREAS, the Municipal Development Council (MDC) of the Local Government Unit of Barobo, Surigao del Sur conducted their First Semestral Meeting last April 8, 2026, at the Kvenz Restobar, Purok 2, Poblacion, Barobo, Surigao del Sur to discuss matters relative to their task as special body of the Local Government Unit (LGU).

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 287 of the Local Government Code of 1991, local government units shall appropriate not less than twenty percent (20%) of their Internal Revenue Allotment (IRA), now known as the National Tax Allotment (NTA), for development projects;

WHEREAS, the Municipal Development Council (MDC) of the Local Government Unit of Barobo, Surigao del Sur conducted their First Semestral Meeting last April 8, 2026, at the Kvenz Restobar, Purok 2, Poblacion, Barobo, Surigao del Sur to discuss matters relative to their task as special body of the Local Government Unit (LGU).

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 287 of the Local Government Code of 1991, local government units shall appropriate not less than twenty percent (20%) of their Internal Revenue Allotment (IRA), now known as the National Tax Allotment (NTA), for development projects;

WHEREAS, the identified Programs, Projects, and Activities (PPAs) funded under the 20% Development Fund are intended to support socio-economic development and infrastructure priorities of the municipality;

WHEREAS, Section 106 of Republic Act No. 7160 provides that local development councils shall assist the Sanggunian in setting the direction of economic and social development, and in coordinating development efforts within their territorial jurisdiction;

WHEREAS, Section 114 of Republic Act No. 7160 authorizes the Local Development Council to formulate and recommend local development investment programs, which serve as the basis for budgetary allocations;

WHEREAS, Section 318 of Republic Act No. 7160 provides that funds and appropriations may be realigned or modified when public interest so requires, subject to applicable laws, rules, and regulations;

WHEREAS, Section 322 of Republic Act No. 7160 provides that unexpended balances of appropriations authorized in the annual appropriations ordinance shall revert to the unappropriated surplus of the general fund at the end of the fiscal year and shall not thereafter be available for the expenditure except by subsequent enactment. Moreover, for capital outlays shall continue and remain valid until fully spent, reverted or the project is completed;

WHEREAS, Section 322 of Republic Act No. 7160 also provides that the balances of continuing appropriations shall be reviewed as part of the annual budget preparation and the Sanggunian concerned may approve, upon recommendation of the local chief executive, the reversion of funds no longer needed in connection with the activities funded by said continuing appropriations;

WHEREAS, upon review and evaluation, certain PPAs under the 20% Development Fund have been determined to be no longer feasible, necessary, or responsive to the current priorities and needs of the Municipality due to various factors such as changes in circumstances, issues in RROW, implementation constraints, or shifting development priorities;

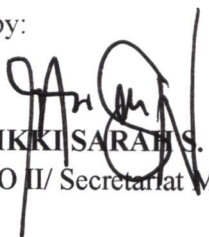

RESOLVED FINALLY, as it is hereby resolved finally, to furnish copy of this resolution to the office of the Sangguniang Bayan of this municipality.

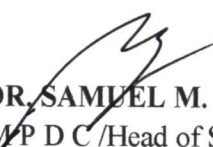
