"AN EXECUTIVE ORDER DESIGNATING A FOCAL PERSON FOR THE ASSESSMENT AND VERIFICATION OF DAMAGED GOVERNMENT EQUIPMENT"

WHEREAS, it is necessary to ensure the proper assessment, verification, and documentation of government equipment that have been damaged, rendered unserviceable, or require repair, replacement, or disposal;

WHEREAS, the conduct of a pre-inspection is essential to determine the extent of damage, establish accountability when necessary, and provide recommendations for appropriate action in accordance with existing government accounting and auditing rules and regulations;

WHEREAS, the Local Chief Executive is authorized to designate personnel to perform duties necessary for the efficient administration of local government operations;

NOW THEREFORE, I, ALGERICO H. IRIZARI, M.D., Municipal Mayor of the Municipality of Lanuza, Surigao del Sur, by virtue of the power vested in me by law, hereby order to prescribe guideline for the utilization and management of equipment and all other equipment's of the Municipality of Lanuza to wit;

SECTION 1. Designation of Focal Person.

Mr. RUSTOM M. GARCIA, Construction & Maintenance Foreman, is hereby designated as the Focal Person for all government owned equipment reported damaged, and defective.

SECTION 2. Function of the Focal Person

The Focal Person shall perform the following functions, namely:

- a. Conduct an actual inspection of damaged equipment and verify its physical condition;
- b. Document the findings, including the nature and extent of damage, through inspection reports and photographs when necessary;
- c. Determine whether the equipment is repairable, beyond economical repair, or recommended for disposal;
- d. Coordinate with the concerned office, property custodian, and other relevant personnel regarding the inspection;
- e. Prepare and submit a Pre-Inspection Report containing findings and recommendations to the Municipal Mayor and concerned offices;
- f. Perform other related functions necessary to facilitate the proper disposition, repair, replacement, or disposal of damaged equipment.

SECTION 3. Effectivity Clause.

This Executive Order shall take effect immediately upon signing, and it shall remain in full force and effect until revoked, repealed, amended or suspended accordingly.

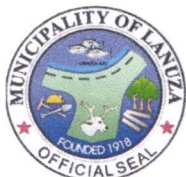

AN EXECUTIVE ORDER GRANTING PANTAWID PAMILYANG PILIPINO PROGRAM (4Ps) BENEFICIARIES ACCESS TO AGRICULTURAL SUPPLIES, TRAINING, AND RELATED AGRICULTURAL DEVELOPMENT INTERVENTIONS THROUGH THE MUNICIPAL AGRICULTURE OFFICE OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF LANUZA, SURIGAO DEL SUR.

WHEREAS, Section 16 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, empowers local government units to exercise powers necessary and appropriate to promote the general welfare of their constituents;

WHEREAS, Section 17(b)(2)(ii) of the same Code devolves to municipalities the delivery of social welfare services, including programs and projects on child and youth welfare, family and community welfare, women's welfare, and community-based rehabilitation programs;

WHEREAS, Section 444(b)(1) of the Local Government Code vests in the Municipal Mayor general supervision and control over all programs, projects, services, and activities of the municipality and authorizes the issuance of executive orders necessary for the efficient and effective delivery of public services;

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 11310 institutionalized the Pantawid Pamilyang Pilipino Program (4Ps) as a national poverty reduction strategy that provides social assistance and complementary interventions to qualified beneficiary households;

WHEREAS, the Municipal Government of Lanuza recognizes the need to strengthen the food security and economic resilience of 4Ps beneficiary households through agricultural support interventions such as the provision of seeds, agricultural training, and participation in agriculture-related programs and activities of the municipality;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALGERICO H. IRIZARI, Municipal Mayor of Lanuza, Surigao del Sur, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order:

SECTION 1. Provision of Seeds and Agricultural Training.

All active 4Ps beneficiary households in the Municipality of Lanuza shall be provided with vegetable seeds and shall be given access to agricultural training programs designed to promote sustainable backyard gardening and food production.

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SECTION 2. Purpose and Objectives.

This project aims to:

- a. Promote food security among 4Ps beneficiary households through the establishment and maintenance of backyard vegetable gardens as a practical response to increasing food prices and other economic challenges;
- b. Equip beneficiaries with the necessary knowledge and skills on proper vegetable production and sustainable gardening practices; and
- c. Recognize and provide incentives or awards to beneficiaries who successfully establish and maintain exemplary and sustainable backyard gardens.

SECTION 3. Management and Operations.

- (a) The Municipal Agriculture Office (MAO) shall serve as the lead implementing office and shall be responsible for the provision of vegetable seeds, conduct of agricultural training, monitoring of project implementation, and administration of the Best Backyard Garden Recognition Program.
- (b) The Pantawid Pamilyang Pilipino Program Municipal Operations Office (4Ps MOO/DSWD) shall serve as co-implementing office and shall be responsible for providing the updated master list of active 4Ps beneficiary households, participating in project monitoring activities, and designating a representative to serve as a member of the evaluation and judging committee for the Best Backyard Garden Recognition Program.
- (c) The Municipal Social Welfare and Development Office (MSWDO) shall participate in the monitoring and evaluation of project implementation and provide necessary support to ensure beneficiary participation.

SECTION 4. Funding.

The funding requirements for the provision of seeds, conduct of training activities, monitoring, and awards shall be sourced from available municipal funds, subject to existing accounting and auditing rules and regulations. Necessary appropriations shall be proposed for inclusion in the Annual Investment Program (AIP) and the respective Work and Financial Plans (WFPs) of concerned offices.

Additional support may be obtained from national government agencies, non-government organizations, development partners, and private donors, subject to applicable Commission on Audit (COA), Department of Budget and Management (DBM), and other relevant government

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regulations. Donations shall be accepted and administered through appropriate agreements and documentation.

SECTION 5. Monitoring and Reporting.

The Municipal Link/Focal Person of the Pantawid Pamilyang Pilipino Program shall submit quarterly accomplishment and monitoring reports to the Municipal Convergence Advisory Council (MCAC) for evaluation and appropriate action.

SECTION 6. Separability Clause.

If any provision of this Executive Order is declared unconstitutional or invalid, the remaining provisions not affected thereby shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 7. Repealing Clause.

All executive orders, issuances, rules, regulations, or portions thereof inconsistent with this Executive Order are hereby repealed, amended, or modified accordingly.

SECTION 8. Effectivity.

This Executive Order shall take effect on 10 June 2026 and shall remain in full force and effect unless sooner amended or revoked.
