Section 447(a)(1)(vi) of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, explicitly authorizes the Sangguniang Bayan to enact ordinances necessary to promote the general welfare of its inhabitants. In line with this mandate, the municipality recognizes the invaluable contribution of the individuals who shape the foundation of our youth. Under Republic Act No. 10410, or the Early Years Act of 2013, national policy firmly recognizes the vital role of these workers in delivering Early Childhood Care and Development (ECCD) Programs and Services. They serve as our true frontliners in nurturing the holistic growth of children, contributing significantly to the municipality's overarching social development goals.

Currently, Municipal Ordinance No. 18-2023 grants benefits and incentives to "Barangay Day Care Workers" who separate from service due to age retirement. However, there is an immediate need to update and align our local legislation with prevailing national laws and policies. Thus, this measure proposes to replace the term "Barangay Day Care Workers" with the legally recognized title of "Child Development Workers."

Furthermore, the Sangguniang Bayan finds it more equitable, compassionate, and responsive to adjust the criteria for these incentives. Rather than limiting the grant of benefits solely to age retirement, this amendment seeks to honor the actual dedication and time given by our workers. By basing the financial incentives and official recognition on their length of service upon separation, we ensure that those who have faithfully and selflessly served the Municipality of Madrid are justly accorded the dignity and support they highly deserve.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Sangguniang Bayan of the Municipality of Madrid, Province of Surigao del Sur, that:

SECTION 1. Amendment of Title. — The title of Municipal Ordinance No. 18-2023 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"AN ORDINANCE GRANTING BENEFITS AND INCENTIVES TO CHILD DEVELOPMENT WORKERS (CDWs) WHO SHALL SEPARATE FROM THE SERVICE AFTER RENDERING THE REQUIRED LENGTH OF SERVICE; PROVIDING FUNDS THEREFOR, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

SECTION 2. Amendment of Terminology. — All references to "Barangay Day Care Workers (BDCWs)" appearing in Municipal Ordinance No. 18-2023 are hereby amended to read as "Child Development Workers (CDWs)."

SECTION 3. Amendment of Section 3 (Purpose). — Section 3 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 3. Purpose. — This Ordinance aims to recognize and reward the invaluable contributions of Child Development Workers by providing benefits and incentives upon their separation from service based on the length of service rendered to the Municipality."

SECTION 4. Amendment of Section 5 (Definition of Terms). — The definitions of "Barangay Day Care Worker (BDCW)" and "Registered BDCW" under Section 5 of Municipal Ordinance No. 18-2023 are hereby amended to read as follows:

- a. **Child Development Worker (CDW)** – refers to a community-based worker duly appointed, accredited, and registered with the Municipal Social Welfare and Development Office who has undergone the required training and is responsible for the delivery of Early Childhood Care and Development Programs and Services.

- b. **Registered CDW** – refers to a Child Development Worker who has completed at least one (1) year of volunteer service and is duly registered and recognized by the Municipal Social Welfare and Development Office.

SECTION 5. Amendment of Section 6 (Benefits and Incentives). — Section 6 of Municipal Ordinance No. 18-2023 is hereby amended to read as follows:

“SECTION 6. Benefits and Incentives Upon Separation from Service.

All qualified registered Child Development Workers who separate from service shall be entitled to a one-time Separation Incentive and Certificate of Recognition.

The Separation Incentive shall be computed based on the actual number of years of service rendered multiplied by One Thousand Pesos (₱1,000.00) per year, using the following formula:

Separation Incentive = Total Years of Service × ₱1,000.00

For purposes of computation:

- a. Any fraction of six (6) months or more shall be considered as one (1) full year;
- b. The incentive shall be granted only once upon actual separation from service;
- c. The incentive shall be based on the certified length of service as determined by the Municipal Social Welfare and Development Office (MSWDO).
- d. In the event that a Child Development Worker (CDW) has been separated from the service and is subsequently rehired or reappointed, the computation of the length of service for purposes of this Ordinance shall commence from the date of such rehiring or reappointment. The period of service rendered prior to the separation shall not be included in the computation of the separation incentive.

In addition, thereto, each qualified beneficiary shall receive a Certificate of Recognition from the Municipality of Madrid.”

SECTION 6. Qualification. — To qualify for the benefits and incentives under this Ordinance, a Child Development Worker must:

- a. Be duly registered by the Municipal Social Welfare and Development Office;
- b. Have no pending administrative case involving grave misconduct or dishonesty at the time of separation from service; and
- c. Be certified by the Municipal Social Welfare and Development Officer as qualified to receive the incentive.

SECTION 7. Amendment of Administrative Provisions. — All references to Barangay Day Care Workers under Section 7 of Municipal Ordinance No. 18-2023 are hereby amended to Child Development Workers. The Municipal Social Welfare and Development Office shall likewise determine and certify the official length of service of every qualified beneficiary for purposes of computing the incentive.

SECTION 8. Funding Requirement. — The amount necessary for the implementation of this Ordinance shall be charged against available funds of the Municipality and thereafter included in the annual appropriations of the Municipal Government, subject to existing budgeting, accounting, and auditing laws, rules and regulations.

SECTION 9. Separability Clause. — If any provision of this Ordinance is declared unconstitutional or invalid, the remaining provisions not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and effect.

SECTION 10. Repealing Clause. — All ordinances, resolutions, executive orders, rules and regulations, or parts thereof inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed, amended, or modified accordingly.

SECTION 11. Effectivity. — This Ordinance shall take effect upon approval and after compliance with applicable posting requirements and review by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan pursuant to the Local Government Code of 1991

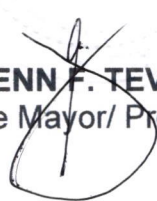

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Sangguniang Bayan of Madrid, Surigao del Sur, duly assembled in session, That:

Section 1. TITLE. This Ordinance is entitled, "*An Ordinance Granting Benefits and Incentives to Barangay Day Care Workers (BDCW) Who Will be Separating from the Services Due to Age Requirement; Providing Funds Therefor, and for Other Purposes*".

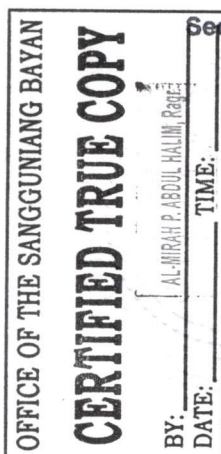
Section 2. POLICY. It is the policy of the Local Government Unit of Madrid, Surigao del Sur to provide quality education to all children and adopt an integrated and comprehensive approach to Day Care Service Programs which shall endeavor to make day care services available to all three (3) and four (4) years old; to promote and improve the social well-being and welfare of the Barangay Day Care Workers/Child Development Workers who are at the front of Day Care Programs and Services at the grassroots level.

Section 3. PURPOSE. This Ordinance aims to ensure continuity of the benefits and incentives which have been availed by the Barangay Day Care Workers for already a number of years during their tenure.

Section 4. LEGAL BASIS. Section 447, paragraph (2)(i) of Republic Act 7160.

Section 5. DEFINITION OF TERMS. For purposes of this Ordinance, the following terms are defined:

- Assistance to Individuals/Families in Crisis Situation (AICS)** – refers to the assistance to individuals in crisis situation is a social safety net or a stop-gap mechanism to support the recovery of individuals and families from unexpected crisis such as illness or death of a family member, and other crisis situations.
- Barangay Day Care Worker (BDCW)** – refers to a barangay-based worker appointed by the Punong Barangay and registered in the Municipal Social Welfare and Development Office, has undergone the required training, in accordance with law and regulations, and responsible for the conduct of day care sessions and implementation of other Day Care Service Programs.
- Registered BDCW** - refers to Barangay Day Care Worker who has undergone one (1) year of volunteer service and registered by the Municipal Social Welfare Office.
- Federation** – refers to Madrid Day Care Workers Federation.



Section 6. INCENTIVES AND BENEFITS – In recognition of the services of all Registered BCDWs who were actively and regularly performing their duties and are ceasing their services due to mandatory age requirement shall be entitled to the benefits and incentives, described as follows:

1. **PhilHealth Insurance Coverage** – shall be enrolled in the National Health Insurance Program through the LGU sponsorship scheme for them to receive and avail of an adequate package of personal health services that must include in-patient hospital care, out-patient care, emergency and transfer services;
2. **Assistance to Individuals in Crisis Situation (AICS)** – can avail of AICS through the Municipal Social Welfare and Development Office;
3. **Loyalty Incentives** – are given to accredited BCDWs who have rendered cumulative services in form of **monetary and certification**, as described hereunder:
 - a) 10 years (the least) - ₱ 5,000.00 and Certificate of Recognition
 - b) 11 – 20 years - ₱ 10,000.00 and Certificate of Recognition
 - c) 21 – 30 years - ₱ 20,000.00 and Certificate of Recognition
 - d) 40 years or more - ₱ 30,000.00 and Certificate of Recognition

Section 7. ADMINISTRATIVE PROVISIONS. Hereunder are the administrative provisions to avail of the benefits and incentives provided in this Ordinance. The MSWDO as head office shall:

1. Have the official list of Registered BCDWs;
2. Qualify and validate those are eligible to receive the benefits and incentives herein provided;
3. Prepare the Certificate of Recognition, duly signed by the Municipal Mayor and the SB Chairperson on Social Services, SB Chairperson on Education to be handed to the recognized recipient/s;
4. Prepare document i.e. vouchers and supporting papers; and other warrants that are necessary to effectively implement this Ordinance.

Section 8. FUNDING REQUIREMENTS. There is hereby appropriated an annual appropriation of *One Hundred Fifty Thousand Pesos (₱150,000.00)* for the expenses to be incurred in the implementation of this Ordinance, among others, Cash Incentives and Certificate of Recognition.

Section 9. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. If, for any reason or reasons, any part or provisions of this Ordinance which shall be declared unconstitutional or invalid, other parts or provisions not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and effect.

Section 10. REPEALING CLAUSE. All ordinances or resolutions passed prior to this enactment are hereby repealed, amended or modified accordingly.

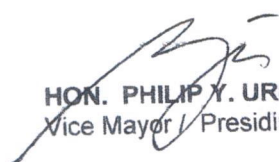
Section 11. EFFECTIVITY. This Ordinance shall take effect upon the affirmation from the Sangguniang Panlalawigan.

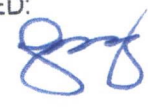
