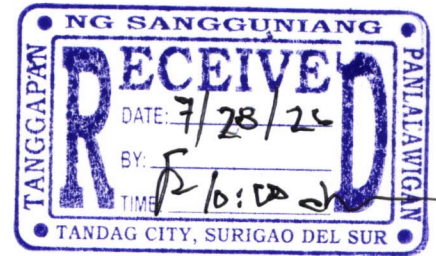

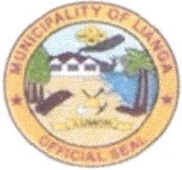

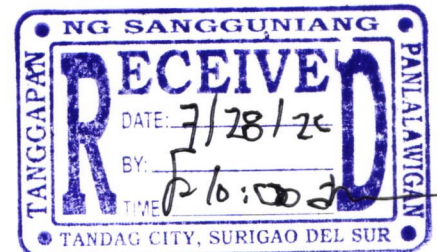

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MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 14
Series of 2026



"AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE FOOD TOURISM HUB, PRESCRIBING GUIDELINES FOR THE USE, MANAGEMENT, AND OPERATION, SETTING RENTAL RATES, AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF"

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 9593 (Tourism Act of 2009), is the principle law declaring tourism as an indispensable engine of national economy. It explicitly tasks the state with encouraging agri-tourism and private sector participation for countryside development, preserving local life and generating employment;

WHEREAS, the construction of the Food Tourism Hub by the Coastal Road in the municipality is anchored in national legislation aimed at socio-economic growth, countryside development, and culinary tourism;

WHEREAS, General Appropriations Act (RA 11260) and subsequent annual (GAAs), the project is specifically funded by the national budget under the General Appropriation Act. The funds are managed and administered through the Tourism Infrastructure and Enterprise Zone Authority (TIEZA);

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 10816 (Farm Tourism Development Act of 2016), provides the legal framework for the promotion of Philippine farm tourism. It serves as a complementary basis for hubs designed to showcase locally sourced agricultural and fresh seafood products, directly supporting local farmers and fisherfolk;

WHEREAS, Local Government Code of 1991 (RA 7160), empowers local government units to enact local ordinances and zoning policies that facilitate land use changes, ensure the economic viability of the project, and partner with national agencies for tourism-centric infrastructure;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Sangguniang Bayan of Lianga, Surigao del Sur in session assembled, that:

SECTION 1. TITLE. This Ordinance shall be known as the **"Food Tourism Hub Rental and Management Ordinance of the Municipality of Lianga"**

SECTION 2. DECLARATION OF POLICY. It is the policy of the Local Government Unit to promote food security, support local producers, strengthen market access, and ensure the orderly management of food facilities by establishing clear and standardized rules for the rental and operation of the Food Hub.

SECTION 3. PURPOSE AND OBJECTIVES. This Ordinance aims to:

- a. Provide guidelines for the rental and assignment of stalls or spaces within the Food Hub;
- b. Ensure the orderly, sanitary, and safe operation of the Food Hub;
- c. Establish fair, reasonable, and transparent rental rates;
- d. Protect consumers by promoting quality and affordability of goods;
- e. Support farmers, fisherfolk, cooperatives, and micro-entrepreneurs.

SECTION 4. COVERAGE. This Ordinance applies to all individuals, associations, cooperatives, and business entities who wish to rent, lease, or occupy any stall or space within the Food Tourism **Hub** with priority granted to registered local business enterprises.

SECTION 5. DEFINITION OF TERMS

- a. **Food Tourism Hub** – A facility owned, operated, or supervised by the LGU intended for the selling, consolidation, storage, processing, or distribution of agricultural and food products.
- b. **Tenant/Vendor** – Any individual or group renting space within the Food Hub.
- c. **Stall/Space** – The assigned area for selling or operations.
- d. **Management** – The office or committee designated by the LGU to supervise the Food Hub.

SECTION 6. RENTAL RATES. The following rental rates are hereby prescribed:

1. **Fixed stalls:** ₱5,000.00 per month (Stall from 1 to 9);
2. **Occupancy Fee:** ₱6,000.00 renewable yearly is required;
3. **Utilities:**
 - o Electricity and Water – stall renter is responsible to install sub meter for water and electricity meter for their stall consumption

The Sangguniang Bayan may review and adjust these rates through an amendatory ordinance.

SECTION 7. RENTAL APPLICATION AND PROCEDURES. All applicants shall:

- a. Submit a completed **Food Tourism Hub Rental Application Form**;
- b. Present valid ID and required permits (e.g., Business Permit, Barangay Clearance);
- c. Stall allocation shall be conducted through a competitive bidding process
- d. Pay the monthly rent, security deposit and other fees;
- e. Sign a **Food Hub Rental Agreement**;
- f. Receive stall assignment from Food Hub Management.

SECTION 7a. Bidding Process. The stall occupancy shall be awarded through a competitive bidding process starting at Php5,000.00. Each stall shall be opened for bidding, and the highest bidder shall be granted the stall of their choice.

SECTION 8. PAYMENT TERMS

- a) One Month advance payment shall be required prior occupying the stall;
- b) Monthly rent shall be paid on the date of his/her actual occupancy;
- c) The renter may opt to pay in a daily, weekly or monthly basis;

- d) **Non-payment for two (2) consecutive months** constitutes automatic cancellation of rental rights.

SECTION 9. DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF TENANTS. It is the responsibility of tenants to:

1. Secure Stall electrical and water meters for stall billing
2. Keep their area clean at all times;
3. Observe waste segregation and disposal requirements under RA 9003 and local ordinances;
4. Display price tags clearly and avoid overpricing;
5. Observe operating hours from 4AM to 10PM;
6. Non-transfer, sublease, or share stalls without written approval by the management;
7. Installation of CCTV and Fire Extinguisher in their respective stalls;
8. Ensure safety of respective customers;
9. Use only approved eco-friendly packaging as mandated by the existing ordinance of the LGU

SECTION 10. PROHIBITED ACTS. The following acts are prohibited:

- a. Selling unregistered, illegal, or unsafe food products;
- b. Unauthorized tapping or tampering of electrical or water lines;
- c. Obstruction of aisles, walkways, or fire exits;
- d. Storing hazardous, flammable, or toxic materials;
- e. Renters are not allowed to bring their pet animals in their respective stalls
- f. Subleasing or transferring stall rights without authorization;
- g. Treating the stall as a living space or domicile;
- h. Smoking within the premises of food hub;
- i. Modification and improvement of the stalls is strictly prohibited; and
- j. All prohibited acts stipulated in all ordinances enacted by the Sangguniang Bayan.

SECTION 11. SANITATION AND MAINTENANCE

- a. Tenants shall require to clean her/his premises daily and must participate in **weekly general cleaning**;
- b. Every stall shall provide their own garbage receptacle/bin with its corresponding proper waste segregation that will be stored in the Material Recovery Facility (MRF);
- c. Food Tourism Hub Management shall conduct regular inspections;
- d. Any damage in the facility caused by tenants shall be repaired at their own cost.

SECTION 12. SECURITY AND SAFETY. The Management Committee shall coordinate closely with the Philippine National Police (PNP) for the maintenance of peace and order. Barangay Tanods shall assist the PNP as deputized by the Punong Barangay of Poblacion.

SECTION 13. CREATION OF MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE. The Food Tourism Hub Management Committee shall be created thru an Executive Order and shall be composed of the following:

SECTION 14. ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITY OF THE FOOD TOURISM HUB MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE (FTHMC)

- Formulate and implement policies, rules, and regulations for the effective management and operation of the Food Tourism Hub.
- Supervise and monitor the occupancy, operation, and maintenance of all stalls and facilities within the hub.
- Ensure that all stall occupants comply with sanitation, safety, environmental, and business permit requirements.
- Conduct and oversee the competitive bidding and awarding of stalls in accordance with approved guidelines.
- Maintain peace, order, cleanliness, and proper waste management within the Food Tourism Hub premises.
- Coordinate with concerned offices, agencies, and stakeholders regarding tourism promotion, business operations, and facility development.
- Monitor collections, fees, rentals, and other revenues generated from the hub and ensure proper remittance.
- Recommend improvements, development projects, and operational strategies for the enhancement of the Food Tourism Hub.
- Resolve conflicts, complaints, and operational issues involving stall occupants, customers, and other stakeholders.
- Submit regular reports and recommendations to the Local Government Unit regarding the status, performance, and operations of the Food Tourism Hub.
- May initiate and accommodate fund raising, events and other related activities by accredited and recognized organization that promotes Food and Tourism industry of Lianga;

SECTION 15. PENALTIES. Violations of this Ordinance shall be penalized as follows:

1. **First Offense:** Php500.00
2. **Second Offense:** Fine of ₱1,000.00
3. **Third Offense and Succeeding Offenses:** Fine of ₱2,500.00 and cancellation of rental agreement and permit

Upon closure of the establishment, the renters shall settle all outstanding obligations at the Office of the Municipal Treasurer. Failure to comply shall subject the concerned party to appropriate actions, including the filing of civil or criminal charges.

SECTION 16. FUNDING. All revenues generated from this Ordinance shall be deposited in the General Fund or any designated LGU account and shall be utilized exclusively for the maintenance, operation, and improvement of the Food Hub.

SECTION 17. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE

If any portion of this Ordinance is declared invalid, the remaining provisions shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 18. REPEALING CLAUSE

All ordinances, rules, or regulations inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 19. EFFECTIVITY

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately and posting in three (3) conspicuous places of the municipality.

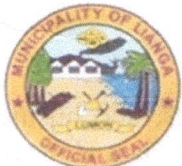

Determination of quorum was then pronounced by the presiding officer.

Meeting Proper:

On her opening statement, presiding officer greatly thankful for heeding her call for a public hearing as it is but timely to fast track the enactment of this ordinance, considering annual town fiesta of the municipality is almost approaching.

Right then, presiding officer presented the proposed Ordinance with emphasis on the following provisions:

- Purpose and Objectives
 - provide guidelines for the rental and assignment of stalls or spaces;
 - ensure the orderly, sanitary, and safe operation;

- Prior to its occupancy, make sure that the food hub is in operational condition as to the lighting among others.
- Operating hours from 4AM to 10PM must be extended up to 12Midnight

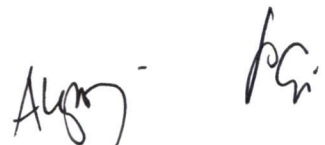
In respond, Hon. Ignacio L. Serrano, reiterated citing the ordinance on curfew hours and extending same to midnight might violate the rules. It might reflects the integrity of the sangguniang bayan citing a common saying "law maker, law breaker". But anyway, the concern of Hon. Sychangco will be answered on other ordinances enacted by the sangguniang which has an exemption provision, particularly on the implementation of curfew hours.

- Mr. Enrique G. Layno, MAC – concern regarding overflowing of drainage that needs immediate action of the engineering office.
- supplemental provision emphasizing the mode of Bidding process.
 - In view of this, Municipal Treasurer, Loida C. Orbeta informed that bidding process shall be for all applicants, as it might connotes favoritism. Also informed that St. 82 only paid taxes but never paid its rental.
- additional provision on the creation of Management Committee, to include their roles, duties and responsibilities. It shall be created thru an Executive Order and shall be composed of: Mayor as Chairperson, Tourism Officer Designate/MPDC as Co-Chairperson, and the following as members: SBM, Chair., Committee on Tourism & Cultural Heritage, SBM, Chair., Comm. on Rules, Laws & Privileges, Good Government, Public Ethics and Accountability, MTO, MEEDO, BPLO, SWM Designate/MENRO, MHO, Sanitary Inspector, MDRRMO, Municipal Engineer & CSO Representative

Roles and Responsibility of the Food Tourism Hub Management Committee (FTHMC)

- Formulate policies, plans, programs sustainable for the operation and management of the Food Hub;
- Conduct quarterly meeting, reporting and feedbacking on any update in the implementation of the Food Hub, or as may deemed necessary;
- Update the Sanggunian Bayan on any development, progress and/or any issues related to the operation and management of the Food Hub;
- Conduct periodic inspection according to their Office mandate and shall report result assessment during meeting;
- The Committee may initiate and accommodate fund raising, events and other related activities by accredited and recognized organization that promotes Food and Tourism industry of Lianga;
- Hear grievances and conflicts within the operation and management.
- Loida C. Orbeta, Municipal Treasurer
 - related the common complaint of the occupants at Food Hub which is the issue of no exit access;
 - occupancy fee must be separate to monthly rental;
 - preferable to daily rental collection.
- Ariel R. Pandi, BPLO – amenable to the opinion of Municipal Treasurer for having daily collection of rental as to ease the burden of the occupants.
- It was also recommended to include in the role and responsibilities of tenants, as follows: installation of CCTV and Fire Extinguisher in their respective stalls/spaces;
 - implementation on the prohibition of single use plastic;
 - establish outline/framework as to actual area (perimeter) being occupied; and
 - proper waste segregation and disposal.

Before the meeting ended, presiding officer, Hon. Cynthia P. Sajot, PhD. extended her thanks and appreciation to the attendees for simply sharing their wisdom, talent and skills for the efficient and effective implementation of the ordinance. All those recommendations will be brought to the plenary on the next regular session for the sanggunian to determine, especially on the reduction of monthly rental.
