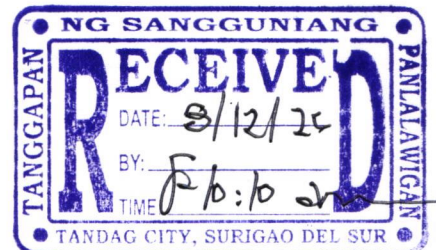

WHEREAS, after a thorough review and deliberation on the merits of the proposed measure, this Sangguniang Bayan resolved to approve the same; hence, this Resolution;

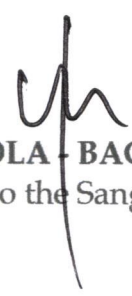

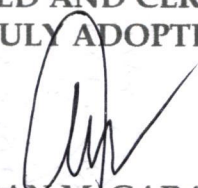

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE SUPPLEMENTAL ANNUAL INVESTMENT PROGRAM (SAIP) NO. 2, IN THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF EIGHT HUNDRED MILLION SIX HUNDRED THREE THOUSAND PESOS (₱ 800,603,000.00), INCLUDING THE HARMONIZED PROGRAMS, PROJECTS, AND ACTIVITIES (PPAs) PER SANGGUNIAN PANLALAWIGAN RESOLUTION NO. 1335-26, SERIES OF 2026 FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATIONS

WHEREAS, the Municipal Development Council (MDC), pursuant to the provisions of Republic Act No. 7160, is mandated to review and endorse annual and supplemental investment programs for approval by the Sanggunian;

WHEREAS, the Local Chief Executive endorsed Supplemental Annual Investment Program (AIP) No. 1 to support priority development programs, projects, and activities (PPAs) and to ensure the efficient delivery of basic services;

WHEREAS, the proposed Supplemental AIP No.2, in the total amount Eight Hundred Million Six Hundred Three Thousand Pesos **₱ 800,603,000.00**, reflects the updated and harmonized PPAs aligned with the approved Appropriation Ordinance, ensuring consistency between planning and budgeting documents;

WHEREAS, under Sangguniang Panlalawigan Resolution No.1335-26, Series of 2026, , "Declaring Appropriation Ordinance No. TC-055 dated April 28, 2026 (General Fund Supplemental Budget No. 01 FY 2026) of the municipality of Hinatuan this municipality, operative subject to some conditions" the review of the subject Appropriation Ordinance resulted in certain findings, which necessitate harmonization of the PPAs;

WHEREAS, there is a need to ensure prompt, coordinated and responsive decision-making mechanisms to address urgent development concerns, and time-sensitive opportunities affecting the municipality;

WHEREAS, said Sangguniang Panlalawigan Resolution No. 1335-26, Series of 2026 declared the Supplemental Budget No. 01 FY 2026 operative, subject to compliance with specific conditions, limitations and corrective measures, particularly on the alignment of PPAs, adherence to budgeting and accounting rules, and observance laws, rules and regulations;

WHEREAS, there is a need to incorporate and reflect said harmonization and adjustments in the Supplemental AIP No. 2 to ensure full compliance and avoid disallowances;

WHEREAS, the MDC Executive Committee finds the Supplemental AIP No. 2 to be responsive, necessary, and consistent with the municipality's development priorities, subject to compliance with the conditions set forth in the aforementioned resolution;

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion by Hon. Honorio S. Villaluz, MDC ExeCom member/Vice President Liga ng mga Barangay duly unanimously seconded by all members present, be it:

RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, to approve the Supplemental Annual Investment Program No. 2, in the amount of amount Eight Hundred Million Six Hundred Three Thousand Pesos **₱ 800,603,000.00** , including the harmonized Programs, Projects and Activities (PPAs) between the AIP and the Appropriation Ordinance.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that the approval is subject to strict compliance with the findings, conditions and directives stipulated under Sangguniang Panlalawigan Resolution No. 1335-26, Series of 2026 including but not limited to the required adjustments, corrections, and alignments of PPAs.

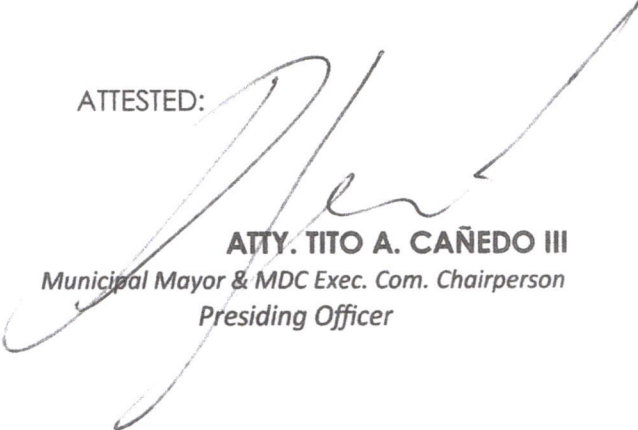
