



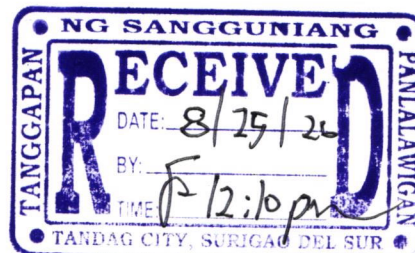

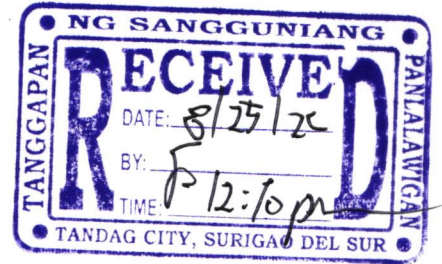

WHEREAS, Section 19, Article 14, of the 1987 Philippine Constitution provides that the State shall promote physical education and encourage sports programs, league competitions, and amateur sports, including training for international competitions, to foster self-discipline, teamwork, and excellence for the development of a healthy and alert citizenry;

WHEREAS, the Philippine Government has adopted a policy of giving incentives to athletes who are winners or medalists in legitimate international and local sports competitions pursuant to R.A. 9064 or the National Athletes, Coaches, and Trainers Benefits and Incentives Act of 2001;

WHEREAS, the state promotes excellence in sports by looking after the welfare of athletes competing for the country and by providing benefits and incentives for athletes who win in competitions and bring honor to the country pursuant to R.A. 10699, "An Act Expanding the Coverage of Incentives Granted to National Athletes and Coaches and Appropriating Funds Therefor.";

WHEREAS, the Local Government Unit of Bislig recognizes the pride and honor that winners of sports, skills, talents, and academic competitions bring to the city that shall serve as an inspiration and a good role model to the citizens of this city, especially to the youth;

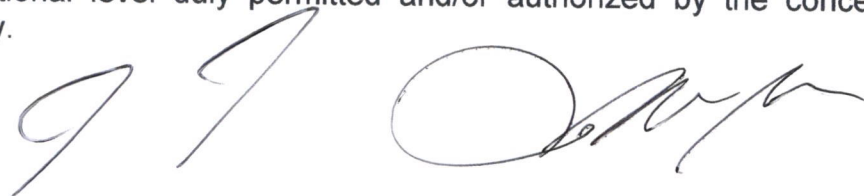
WHEREAS, such an incentive program shall further inspire the athletes to continue to improve in order to reach their dreams and aspirations to help uplift their own families and the community and serve as a guide to success for others taking the same path;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, as it is hereby ordained by the Sangguniang Panlungsod of the City of Bislig, Surigao del Sur in session duly assembled, that:

SECTION 1. Title — This City Ordinance shall be known as "*The Bislig City Sports and Academic and other Talent Competition Awards Program*".

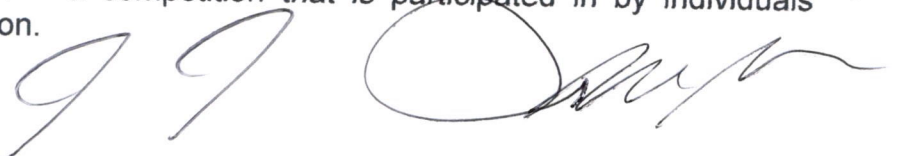
SECTION 2. Declaration of Policy — It is hereby declared a policy of the City of Bislig to grant financial incentives to deserving individuals for having given honor to this city in various legitimate competitions in the fields of Sports and Academics and Other Talent Competitions. This program shall be known as the *Bislig City Sports and Academic and Other Talent Competitions Awards Program*.

SECTION 3. Scope of Coverage — This ordinance includes only those various competitions in the provincial, regional, and national and levels duly organized, accredited, or sanctioned by the Department of Education (DepEd) and in the international level duly permitted and/or authorized by the concerned government agency.



SECTION 4. Definition of Terms —

- a. Sports Competition — refer to various sports competitions in the local, national, international or worldwide levels and are duly organized, accredited or sanctioned by government agencies for competitions conducted within the country. Participation in International and Worldwide competitions must have been permitted and/or authorized by the concerned national government agency.
- b. Academic Competition — refer to the academic-related competitions at the local, national, international or worldwide levels and are duly organized by national government agencies for competitions conducted within the country. Participation in International and Worldwide competitions must have been permitted and/or authorized by the concerned national government agency.
- c. Skills Competition — refer to the multi-level skills competitions that aim to recognize the skills excellence of young skilled workers and graduates of technical vocational schools and training centers. Skill Competitions must have been duly organized.
- a. Talent Competition — refers to a contest intended to showcase and recognize the artistic, creative, or performance abilities of participants mentioned in the DepEd Festival of Talents. It focuses on individual or group expression through music, dance, visual arts, acting, or other forms of creative performance.
- b. Government Agencies — local government agencies or units such as a municipal government, provincial government, and national government agencies such as the Department of Education, Philippine Olympic Committee, Philippine Sports Competition, Department of the Interior and Local Government, Commission on Higher Education, and others.
- c. International Competition — a competition that is participated in by other nations and is sanctioned by an international sanctioning body, for example, the International Olympic Committee. It can be held in other countries or can be hosted in the Philippines. These competitions include but are not limited to the Summer Olympics (every four (4) years), Winter Olympics (every four (4) years), Asian Games (every four (4) years), World Championships of respective sports, Asian Championships of respective sports, Southeast Asian (SEA) Games (every two (2) years), ASEAN Championships of respective sports, and Special Olympics.
- d. National Competition — a competition that is participated in by individuals or teams from the different regions of the country such as, but not limited to, Palarong Pambansa, Philippine National Youth Games (Batang Pinoy), National Open, National Games, and Special Olympics.
- e. Regional Competition — a competition that is participated in by individuals or teams from a Region.



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- f. Provincial Competition — a competition that is participated in by individuals or teams from Surigao del Sur such as, but not limited to, Surigao del Sur Provincial Meet.
- g. Athlete/Contestant — the individual who participated in the competition and has won the award.
- h. Coach — a person registered or authorized to train an athlete/contestant or a team of athletes/contestants before and during the competition.
- i. Individual Category — a type of competition that is participated in by only one (1) participant as indicated in the rules of the competition.
- j. Paired/Team Category — a type of competition that is participated in by two (2) or more participants as indicated in the rules of the competition.

SECTION 5. Bislig City Sports and Academic Competition Excellence Awards Program Committee (BCSACEAPC) — The Bislig City Sports and Academic Competitions Excellence Awards Program Committee (BCSACEAPC) are hereby created with the following composition and functions:

The Committee is composed of the following:

Chairman: City Mayor

Vice-Chairman: City Vice-Mayor

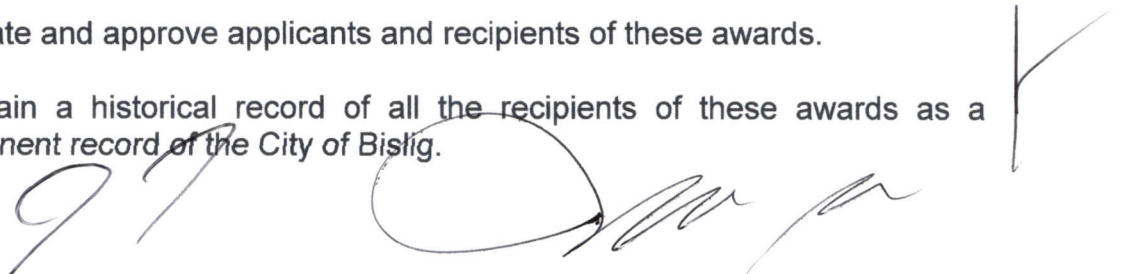
Members:

Chairman, Committee on Youth and Sports
Chairman, Committee on Education
Chairman, Committee on Budget and Appropriations
City Budget Officer
City Treasurer
City Planning & Development Coordinator
City Tourism Officer
Local Youth Development Officer

Department of Education to act as Secretariat of the BCSACEAPC.

The Committee shall have the following functions and duties:

1. Formulate the necessary rules and regulations to implement the provisions of this ordinance.
2. Evaluate and approve applicants and recipients of these awards.
3. Maintain a historical record of all the recipients of these awards as a permanent record of the City of Bislig.

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4. Evaluate the effectiveness of Bislig City Sports and Academic Competitions Excellence Awards Program.
5. Shall convene at least twice a year or as often as maybe necessary, with the majority of the Board to constitute quorum, to (1) evaluate the effectiveness of the program; and (2) Evaluate and approve the applicants of these awards.

SECTION 6. Qualification of Grantees — The qualifications of the participants and coaches/trainers must satisfactorily meet the criteria stated below.

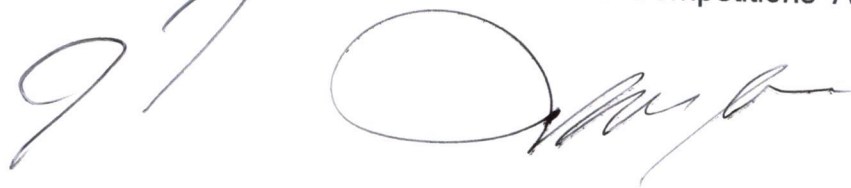
For Athletes/Participating Youth, they must:

1. Be a bona-fide resident of the City of Bislig as certified by the respective Punong Barangay.
2. A non-resident of the city representing a school or any other institution located within the City of Bislig.
3. With good moral standing as certified by the respective Punong Barangay in their place of residence.
4. Has filed a formal application for the cash incentives with the BCSACEAPC of the award within a period of one (1) year from the date of competition; otherwise, their incentives shall be deemed forfeited.
5. Submitted original and/or certified true copy of certification and appropriate documentation that he/she has participated and won first, second, or third place or gold, silver, or bronze medals accordingly in a duly accredited sports or academic competition at a particular level (international, national, regional, provincial, or area; and
6. Duly certified by the Awards Committee that the grantee has satisfactorily submitted and passed the basic requirements set forth in this ordinance through an appropriate resolution of the Committee.

For Coaches/Trainers, they must:

1. For National Competitions — must be a Filipino citizen and must submit authentic certification from the appropriate authority/agency and the grantee that he/she had been the official coach/trainer of the grantee.
2. For International or Worldwide Competitions — the coach or trainer must be a Filipino citizen, duly recognized and accredited by the appropriate national sports governing body or agency, and must have officially represented the country or served as the official coach/trainer of the participating athlete or team.

SECTION 7. Categories and Schedule of Cash Incentives — The following are the categories of the Bislig City Sports and Academic Competitions Awards Program.



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A. International Competitions

- **Individual Category**

First Prize (Gold Medal)	Php150,000.00
Second Prize (Silver Medal)	Php100,000.00
Third Price (Bronze Medal)	Php 75,000.00
- **Pair/Team Category** — The team shall receive twice the amount of the corresponding award in the Individual Category. The team shall divide the amount among the team members.

B. National Competitions

- **Individual Category**

First Prize (Gold Medal)	Php100,000.00
Second Prize (Silver Medal)	Php 50,000.00
Third Price (Bronze Medal)	Php 30,000.00
- **Pair/Team Category** — The team shall receive twice the amount of the corresponding award in the Individual Category. The team shall divide the amount among the team members.

C. Regional Competitions

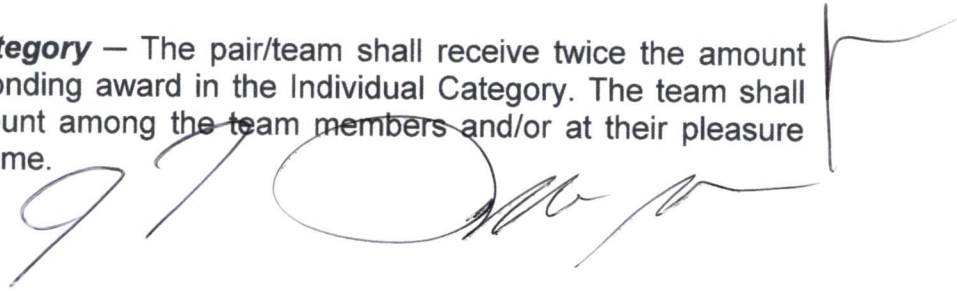
- **Individual Category**

First Prize (Gold Medal)	Php15,000.00
Second Prize (Silver Medal)	Php10,000.00
Third Price (Bronze Medal)	Php 5,000.00
- **Pair/Double Category** — The pair/double category shall receive twice the amount of the corresponding award in the Individual Category. The team shall divide the amount among the team members and/or at their pleasure of sharing scheme.
- **Team Category (5-15 players)** — The team category shall receive thrice the amount of the corresponding award in the Individual Category. The team shall divide the amount among the team members and/or at their pleasure of sharing scheme.

D. Provincial Competitions

- **Individual Category**

First Prize (Gold Medal)	Php5,000.00
Second Prize (Silver Medal)	Php3,000.00
Third Price (Bronze Medal)	Php2,000.00
- **Pair/Team Category** — The pair/team shall receive twice the amount of the corresponding award in the Individual Category. The team shall divide the amount among the team members and/or at their pleasure of sharing scheme.



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E. For Coaches/Trainers

The coaches or trainers shall receive cash incentives only once as provided in this ordinance. The amount shall be equivalent to one half (1/2) of the amount of the individual category of the highest award garnered by the awardees or team he/she handled, both in the individual or team category.

F. Other Awards

The grantees shall also be awarded the following:

- a. A framed certificate of recognition; and
- b. A simple token or souvenir, subject to the availability of funds.

G. Limitation Clause

- a. In case of multiple awards of an individual player, he/she will only be awarded with the highest award garnered.
- b. The incentive amounts provided herein shall be subject to the availability of funds and may be adjusted annually upon recommendation of the Bislig City Sports and Academic Competitions Excellence Awards Program Committee (BCSACEAPC).

SECTION 8. Awarding Ceremony — The recipients of the awards shall be presented of their cash incentives during the Flag Raising Ceremony. Furthermore, the committee shall have the authority to set additional awarding ceremony in times during the nearest major event of the city when deemed necessary.

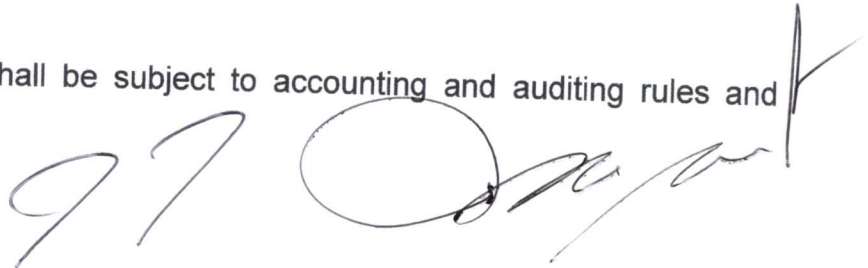
SECTION 9. Source of Fund — The budgetary requirements necessary for the implementation of this Ordinance shall be allocated in the Annual Budget of the City of Bislig.

a. A minimum amount of Php2,450,000.00 shall be appropriated annually for the implementation of this Ordinance, to cover cash incentives for all qualified awardees and their coaches/trainers and for operational expenses, including certificates, plaques, and a simple token or souvenir.

b. The City Government may augment the fund through:

- Donations or sponsorships from the private sector, civic groups, or NGOs;
- Reprogramming or supplemental budgets upon recommendation of the Committee; and
- Other lawful funding sources as may be approved by the Sangguniang Panlungsod.

c. All disbursements shall be subject to accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

SECTION 10. Issuance of Rules and Regulations — The Bislig City Sports and Academic Competition Excellence Awards Program Committee (BCSACEAPC) shall formulate and issue the implementing rules and regulations as may be necessary to carry out the provisions of this ordinance.

SECTION 11. Separability Clause — If, for any reason or reasons, any part or provision of this ordinance is held to be unconstitutional or invalid, other parts or provisions hereof that are not affected shall continue to be in full force and effect.

SECTION 12. Repealing Clause — All ordinances, rules and regulations, or parts thereof, in conflict with or inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 13. Effectivity — This ordinance shall take effect immediately after its approval and after its posting in all barangays of the City of Bislig.
