WHEREAS, the Municipal Enterprise Management Board (MEMB), submitted to the Sangguniang Bayan, their resolution no. 2026-07-04, Series of 2026, entitled: **"RESOLUTION RECOMMENDING THE TEMPORARY SUSPENSION OF THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE PROVISION OF COLLECTION OF MINIMUM CHARGE/PAYMENT FOR WATER CONSUMPTION AS STATED IN SECTION 24 OF MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 05, SERIES OF 2022"**;

WHEREAS, Municipal Enterprise Management Board (MEMB) chaired by the Municipal Mayor is authorized to coordinate with the management and employees of the municipal enterprises to seek ways and means to improve, enhance, expand and maximize the operations of the municipal enterprises as stated in Section 11, par (C) no. 4, of Municipal Ordinance no. 05, Series of 2025;

WHEREAS, the Resolution of MEMB is prompted by the current condition of the main water sources of the Marihatag Water System, particularly the water source in Pinagdayunan, which has reached a critically low level, resulting in a significant reduction in available water volume and rendering the system unable to supply the full water requirements of its consumers, thereby causing intermittent water supply and service interruptions in certain areas of the Municipality;

WHEREAS, the MEMB has recommended to temporarily suspend the collection of such fees to avoid unduly burdening consumers with charges that are not commensurate with the present services while awaiting the drilling and development of additional reliable water sources;

WHEREAS, the Sanggunian bayan after thorough discussion, has seen the necessity to suspend as the intention is not to raise revenue but provide equitable relief to consumer of the water system experiencing critically reduces water availability.

NOW THEREFORE

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Sangguniang Bayan in a session duly assembled, that :

SECTION 1. SUSPENSION OF SECTION 24 OF MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 05, SERIES OF 2025 ON WATER CONSUMPTION RATE. Section 24 of Municipal Ordinance no. 05, Series of 2022, on minimum charge to every water consumer/concessionaire, is hereby temporarily suspended, specifically as follows:

SECTION 2. NEW BILLING RATE. There shall be a new billing rate that will be imposed based on the actual water consumption, rates are as follows:

SECTION 3. COVERAGE OF APPLICATION – Suspension of the payment of minimum charge shall include all consumers within the municipality of Marihatag who are unable to reach the minimum rate as provided in Section 24, may it be, residential households, commercial/industrial and government institution.

SECTION 4. DURATION OF SUSPENSION. – This ordinance shall take effect until another ordinance will be enacted expressly lifting the suspension.

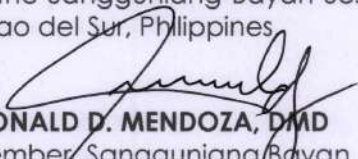
Provided That, the MEMB through its resolution will recommend the specific date of lifting of suspension.

SECTION 5. MONITORING AND EVALUATION. The Municipal Water System Supervisor/Section Chief if warranted and necessary shall conduct evaluation and assessment on water connections and readings to determine the propriety of charges/billings and may recommend appropriate actions to the MEMB.

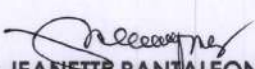
SECTION 6. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. If any part of this Ordinance is declared invalid or unconstitutional, the remaining provisions shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 7. EFFECTIVITY. This Ordinance shall take effect upon approval and compliance with posting and publication requirements.

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE MARIHATAG WATER SYSTEM, ITS MANAGEMENT, IMPOSITIONS OF THE CORRESPONDING FEES AND CHARGES, PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

ARTICLE I – TITLE, COVERAGE AND DEFINITION OF TERMS

SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE – This Ordinance shall be known as the “**THE MARIHATAG WATER SYSTEM ORDINANCE OF 2022**” of the Municipality of Marihatag, Surigao del Sur.

SECTION 2. COVERAGE – This ordinance shall cover the creation of the Marihatag Water System (MWS) and all rules and policies stated herein shall apply to all water consumers and those who desire to avail the services rendered specifically by the Marihatag Water System Level III, through its management.

SECTION 3. DEFINITION OF TERMS – Any interpretations to the contrary notwithstanding, the terms hereof shall mean:

- a) **Water System** – a system of the entire water works components which provides water supply from the water source to the distribution, maintenance, and the administration of the Marihatag Water System within the territorial coverage of the Municipality.
- b) **MWS** – acronym for “Marihatag Water System”.
- c) **Management** – this refers to the Municipal Enterprises Development and Management Office (MEDMO), under the Marihatag Water System Division that will directly look after the operations of Marihatag Municipal Water System;
- d) **Water Consumption** – a quantitative portion of water, utilized by consumer/concessionaire, generated from the standardized water meter that is subject for the computation of account for the water monthly bills.
- e) **Water Rate** – the charges made for the use of water from the water supply.
- f) **Consumer/Concessionaire** – person, natural or juridical who has water service connection and/or concession from the water supply, either classified as residential, government/institutional, commercial/industrial.
- g) **Service Connection** – the tapping of the water mains and the laying of pipes from the mainline to the curb line to the setting of water including the installation of the faucet.
- h) **Residential Connection** – service water connection intended for domestic or family use.
- i) **Commercial/Industrial Connection** – service water connection intended for business establishments’ day-to-day operation use.
- j) **Institutional/Government Connection** – service water connection intended for religious, educational, social or for similar purpose.

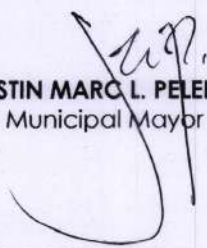

- k) **Discount** – a twenty percent (20%) deduction from the water monthly bills given to senior citizens, persons with disability and solo parents.
- l) **Transfer** – the process of water service connection wherein the consumer/concessionaire relocates or repositions the water service connection to another place or dwelling.
- m) **Disconnection** – severance of water service connection from the MWS either temporarily or permanent whenever the water monthly bill is not settled.
- n) **Reconnection** – restoration of water service connection by the MWS whenever the water monthly bill is settled.
- o) **Senior Citizens** – residents of the Municipality of Marihatag, who aged 60 years and up, as certified by the Office of the Municipal Social Welfare and Development through the Office of the Senior Citizens Affairs.
- p) **Persons with Disability** – residents of the Municipality of Marihatag, who are physically or mentally impaired that has a substantial and long-term adverse effect on their ability to carry out normal day-to-day activities, as certified by the Office of the Municipal Social Welfare and Development through the PWD focal person.
- q) **Solo Parent** – those mother or father of the Municipality of Marihatag whether married or not, who are left solo or alone with the responsibility of raising his/her child/children, as certified by the Office of the Municipal Social Welfare and Development through the Solo Parent focal person.
- r) **MWS Supervisor** – a permanent employee of LGU Marihatag, who is accountable and responsible in the operation, management, and administration of the Marihatag Water System.
- s) **Municipal Enterprises Management Board (MEMB)** – governing body of the Marihatag Municipal Water System.
- t) **Municipal Water Shed Board** – Organized members in-charged in the protection, preservation and conservation of the water shed areas in the Municipality of Marihatag, Surigao del Sur.

SECTION 4. WATER POTABILITY – The Management of the MWS, shall ensure the safety of the consumers, in that, the water it delivers must regularly pass a Bacterial Testing and Chlorination, on a regular basis, as monitored and implemented by the Sanitary Inspector, through the Municipal Health Office.

The labor of the installation of the pipes (SDR 11 required, irregardless of the size and length) connecting only one (1) faucet, shall be free of charge. All other necessary materials to be utilized for such installation shall be shouldered by the service consumer.

SECTION 23. WARRANTY OF WORKMANSHIP. A one (1) month warranty will be offered by the Management on various plumbing services extended by its Accredited Plumbers in case of leakage and poor workmanship.

SECTION 24. WATER CONSUMPTION RATE - There shall be a Minimum charge to be collected by the Marihatag Water System to every water consumer/concessionaire, in the following rates:

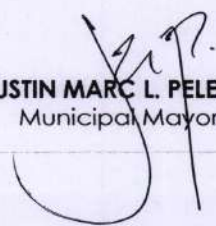

SECTION 25. METER TESTING. When the accuracy of the water meter is questioned, the Management upon the request will cause an official test to be made, which will be as follows:

- The consumer shall be duly notified of the time and place for the conduct of such test and may be present during the test.
- The water meter must be tested on variable rates of delivery and if the average rate of registration is more than two (2) percent in excess of the total quantity of water passing through the meter, the Management shall adjust the water bill base on the provisions on **Section 26.**
- If the water meter is within the two (2) percent of accuracy, the requesting consumer has to pay a service charge of Fifty Pesos only (P50.00) which will be included in the next month's bill.

Any provisions held to be invalid, shall not affect the operability of the provisions contained in this Ordinance.

SECTION 74 – REPEALING CLAUSE – Any provision inconsistent or in conflict with the provision of this Ordinance are considered repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 75 – EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE – This ordinance shall take effect ten (10) days after it has been posted in two (2) conspicuous places and publication in general circulation.

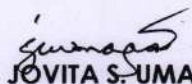
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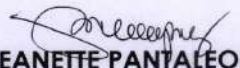
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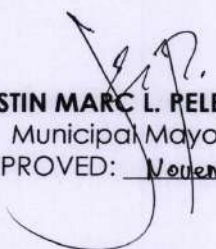

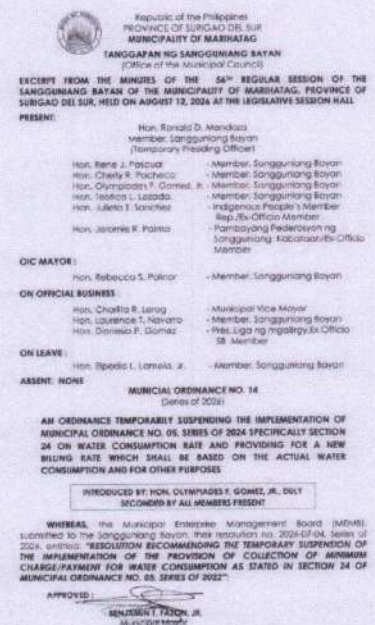
